



#### CALL ME MADAM DIRECTOR'S NOTES

Sally Adams, the central figure of *Call Me Madam*, is loosely based on the real-life Perle Mesta, a Washington, D.C. party-giver whose service to the Democrats was rewarded with a post as ambassador to a tiny European country. The show was written for Ethel Merman, whose frank, anything-but-tactful (though good-natured) persona was used to great comic effect as she took on the diplomatic set. Having composed a hit score for Merman in 1946 with *Annie Get Your Gun*, Irving Berlin was well-equipped to provide tailor-made material for the star.

The story, by Howard Lindsay and Russel Crouse (also responsible for *The Sound of Music* later in the decade), about how naive American power comes up against crafty European politics, was topical. Although the show is set in 1950 and we get references to Eisenhower and Harry Truman (in fact, Sally has several phone conversations with Truman, so he is kind of an extra cast member), the political jokes still work—Washington D.C. never seems to change much.

Although everything about Call Me Madam had the feeling of an obvious hit, the show opened out of town without a finished second act. It was Merman's idea to add the duet with Kenneth and Berlin came up with one of his signature quodlibets—two separate melodies performed successively and then simultaneously. Two songs were dropped and Berlin added "Something to Dance About," which gave the opening of Act Two the pop that it needed. A bouncy topical number, "They Like Ike," between three comic politicians was inserted to pep things up and keep the show anchored to its political theme. The Sally/Kenneth duet "You're Just in Love" turned out to be a real audience-pleaser and so, going back to a convention used to sell hit tunes in the 1930s, Sally and Kenneth came back on for an encore with an even brighter tempo. Call Me Madam came into New York as a solid smash hit, running a year and a half with a profitable national tour featuring Elaine Stritch as Sally, a hit London production and a Hollywood film with Merman and Donald O'Connor taking on the role of Kenneth.

#### DIRECTOR'S NOTES CONT'D

Call Me Madam's brand of political commentary might have little to do with our volatile past several years of American politics and it never aimed to change the world or shine a light on a particular issue, but there is a kind of self-reflection happening that both criticizes and celebrates the American ideal. This most traditional musical comedy, made by veterans who knew their craft well, only aimed at creating a successful piece of commercial theatre. The fact that they also happened to say something revealing about our American character was a bonus to an already enchanting entertainment, but outside of the score, it is the ingredient that makes Call Me Madam continue to register through the years.
