Here is her recipe for Sweet Fried Plantains.

### **Sweet Fried Plantains**

**INGREDIENTS** 

1 Large Plantain (very ripe)

2 Tablespoons Butter

2 Teaspoons Cinnamon

2 Tablespoons Olive Oil

2 Tablespoons Brown Sugar

Cut the ends off the plantain, and slice all the way down the peel to remove it. Slice the plantain

on an angle into slices about  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch thick.

Heat olive oil and butter on medium high to a sizzle. Place the plantains on the skillet, cooking five minutes on one side. Flip and cook about three minutes on the other side.


While the plantains are cooking, sprinkle brown sugar and cinnamon on a plate. Transfer the plantain from the skillet onto the cinnamon mixture. Gently press the plantains with the back of the spoon into the cinnamon mixture. Flip to coat the other side and return to the skillet for one to two minutes per side. Enjoy!!

Let cool on a rack with paper towels for a moment before serving.
