Ron Limeberger Coach of the Year

Danny Delgado's love of running took off when he began competing in track meets at nine-years-old. "The thing I love most is that you can do it anywhere," says Delgado. "All you need are running shoes and shorts."

As a student, he competed in track & field events for three of his four years at CB. Delgado brought that love of running back to the school as a cross country and track & field coach for seven years during his first stint at CB, and again, since his return in 2002. Since then, he has taken cross country runners to the State Finals seven times and members of both the men's and women's teams in 2006 and 2007. In 2006, the Sacramento Bee named him the Sierra Valley Conference Coach of the Year. In 2007, CB named him Lasallian Educator of the Year.

Despite all of the athletic successes, Delgado says that he is most proud of how much the program has grown. "When I came back to CB in 2002, we had 11 students running cross country," explains Delgado. "This year we have grown to 62 runners. I've developed lifelong friendships with some of the runners and hopefully, I've helped them discover a lifelong love of running."

As for receiving the Ron Limeberger Coach of the Year award, Delgado humbly says, "This is a big surprise and such an honor. It means even more because it comes from an organization that has meant so much to the school and because it is given by men and women who truly understand the role of coaches."




# Thanks to you....
