Tournament Rules

- USGA Rules Govern Play
- Turn scorecard in immediately following round
- After choosing shot location (based on best drive), subsequent shots must be taken within one club length from original ball lay—no closer to hole
- Subsequent putts must be made from the original spot—no closer to the hole
- Record team score when the first team ball is in the cup
- Should there be any ties, the winner will be determined by a BLIND DRAW
- Hole-in-one rules: must tee off from 175 yards. Only one attempt per golfer. First person wins.

Fun and Games on the Course

- **Hole 1. Marshmallow Drive** – just for fun and bragging rights. Tee off with a marshmallow, then play your own ball for the tournament.
- **Hole 2. Longest Putt** – prize awarded for the longest putt.
- **Hole 3. Closest to the Pin** – Prize awarded to closest male and female player.
- **Hole 4. Accuracy Drive** – The ball must be in the fairway, closest to the line. Winner is based on accuracy not distance. Prize awarded to most accurate male and female player.

- **Hole 6. Eight Inch Hole** – We'll make it easy for you on this green! Putt into this oversized cup.

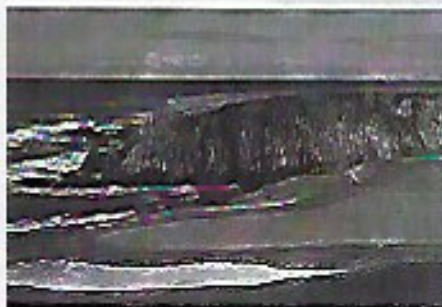

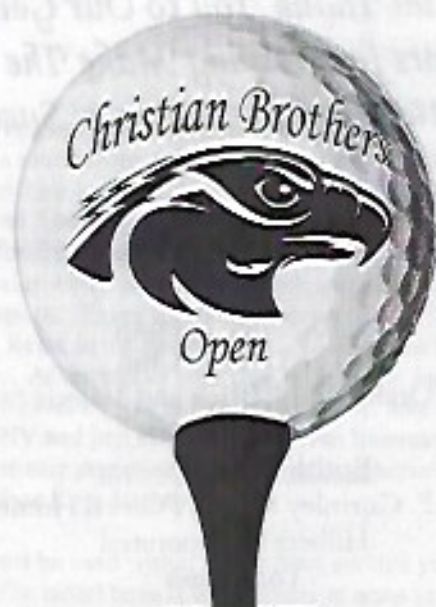

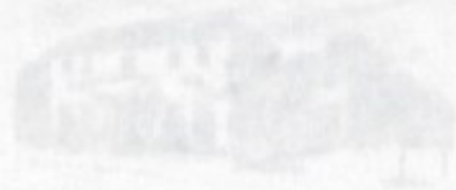
