**Honorary Alumni Award***Jack Hargrove '36*


The Board of Directors of the Alumni Association is proud to present Jack Hargrove with an Honorary Diploma making him a member in standing of the class of 1936. Back in the 1930's Jack attended CB as a boarder student for three years and would have been a member of the Class of '36 if he had not had to leave just prior to his senior year. Sadly, his mother, a single parent, could no longer afford the \$35 annual tuition and board as she was only earning \$90 a year. And, although he went on to graduate from Reno High School, marry, run several successful businesses, and raise a loving family, Jack, on a recent visit to Sacramento with his granddaughter, from his home in Reno, returned to Christian Brothers for a tour of the school and to walk the halls of the alma mater that almost was. In remembering his experience and the young men he went to school with back then, it was clear that Jack still felt the sadness of leaving CB. On his visit Jack had brought a photo album with him. Inside the black leather cover, affixed to the thick black pages were dozens of pictures of friends, Brothers, the old campus at 21st and Y St. (Broadway today), each with its own caption and special memory of the years that he was a "Brothers Boy." It is indeed with great pleasure that the Alumni Association welcome Jack Hargrove back into its fold and honor him as a member of the class of 1936.

**Alumni Service Award*****The Brotherhoods***

The Board of Directors of the Alumni Association is proud to present the group known simply as the "Brotherhoods" this year's Alumni Service Award. This group of thirteen men have gathered monthly in the name of Christian Brothers for the purpose of fellowship and support of the institution that had come to mean so much for them. Begun by retired Marine Colonel Dave Simmons '36 following a lunch with fellow classmate Judge John Sapunor '36, the Brotherhoods have been meeting regularly for the past thirty six years. Originally comprised exclusively of members of the class of 1936, the Brotherhoods have evolved over the years to include members of other classes. In addition to the fellowship and shared stories of good 'ol days gone bye, the Brotherhoods fulfill a promise to help out the school and continue the role of alumni giving something back. Each meeting included a passing of the hat to collect funds that were turned over to Brother Bertram Coleman, a ritual that continues today, to help those who otherwise would not be able to complete their education at Christian Brothers. Over the past thirty six years the Brotherhoods have contributed through their monthly collections well over one hundred thousand dollars. The Alumni Association would like to congratulate the Brotherhoods for their long standing dedication to the school and commitment to helping others.


