The Wine Extravaganza is a labor of love for Michael. "I like this event because I am passionate about wine and have been for many years. I like the people I'm working with, and I have had such overwhelming support from wineries and their representatives that I almost feel compelled to keep it going." More than anything Michael takes pride in knowing that the proceeds from the event are reinvested directly into the school by the alumni association for computers, and much needed repairs. ♦

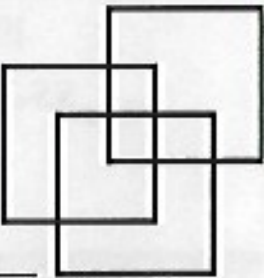
