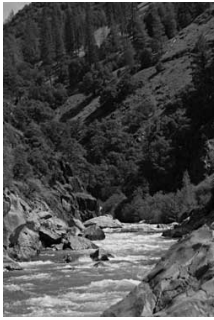


The 2005 Brother Timothy Mont La Salle Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon is a blend of 90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Malbec and 5% Petit Verdot. This blend displays sweet black cherry, plum and cassis. The wine is well integrated with subtle sandal wood and cedar box aromas. On the palate the wine starts with a soft entry of red raspberry and cherry. The mountain tannins are ripe and smooth that lead to a seamless but lingering finish. Enjoy this wine through 2018. This is the second release of this wine created to honor a grand icon of California's wine industry. The collectible wine is crafted by The Hess Collection Winery and for the first time, this wine was made from a tiny, single vineyard using the Mont La Salle Vineyard estate grapes grown at the site of the original Christian Brothers winery where Brother Timothy worked as cellar master for more than 50 years. It was aged for 18 months in French oak.

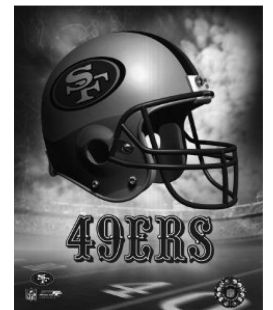

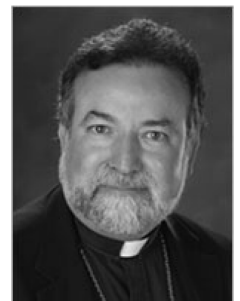

AUCTION RULES!

Absentee Bidding

Absentee Bids for items in the auction have been accepted from friends of Christian Brothers who are unable to attend. Absentee bids for Silent Auction items will be placed on the bid sheet as the opening bid. For Live Auction items, if an Absentee bid exceeds all others at the conclusion of the floor bidding, the auctioneer will announce the Absentee bid and the floor bidders will have the opportunity to raise the bid.

Live Auction Rules

1. The live auction will begin at approximately 7:30 pm. It will consist of the oral auctioning of items in the order they appear in this catalog.
2. All bidding at the auction will require a bid number. Your personal bid number is located on the separate bidder sheet placed inside this auction catalog. Since this number is required for all bidding and purchase of items, please remember your number and keep your catalog and bidder sheet with you during the auction.
3. During the live auction, when you want to bid on an item, raise your bidder sheet to attract the auctioneer's attention. The highest bidder acknowledged by the auctioneer shall be the purchaser. In the event of a dispute between bidders, the auctioneer shall have sole and final discretion to determine the successful bidder or to re-offer and resell the article in dispute. Silent Auction Rules

7.
