#### Our Men's Locker Room needs a locker overhaul!

Existing lockers were designed for P.E. only, at a time when there were fewer varsity sports, and students didn't bring their own equipment. They are small, and won't fit even a large school backpack.

Bigger lockers are needed to meet the needs of our student athletes.

Baseball players have larger equipment bags, often with their own bats. The old lockers simply can't accommodate football bags. And with the advent of Men's Lacrosse this year, there is nowhere to put those lacrosse sticks! Even boys' shoes are bigger than they used to be! This project is estimated to cost \$45,000.
