Five Hitter

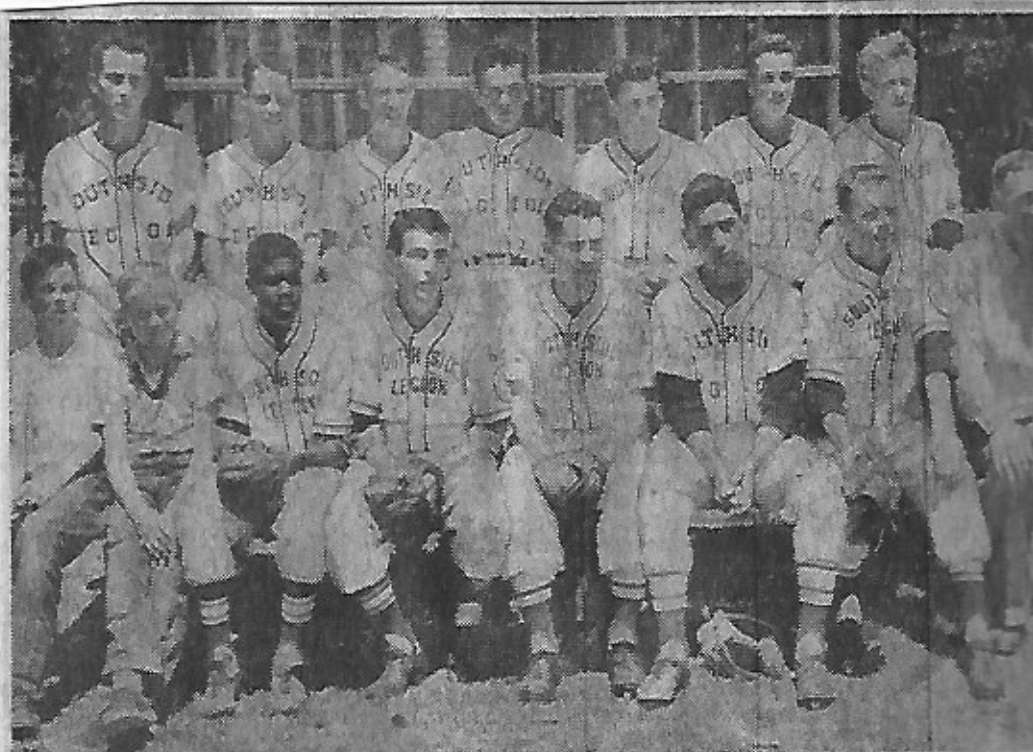
