## Alumni Directory

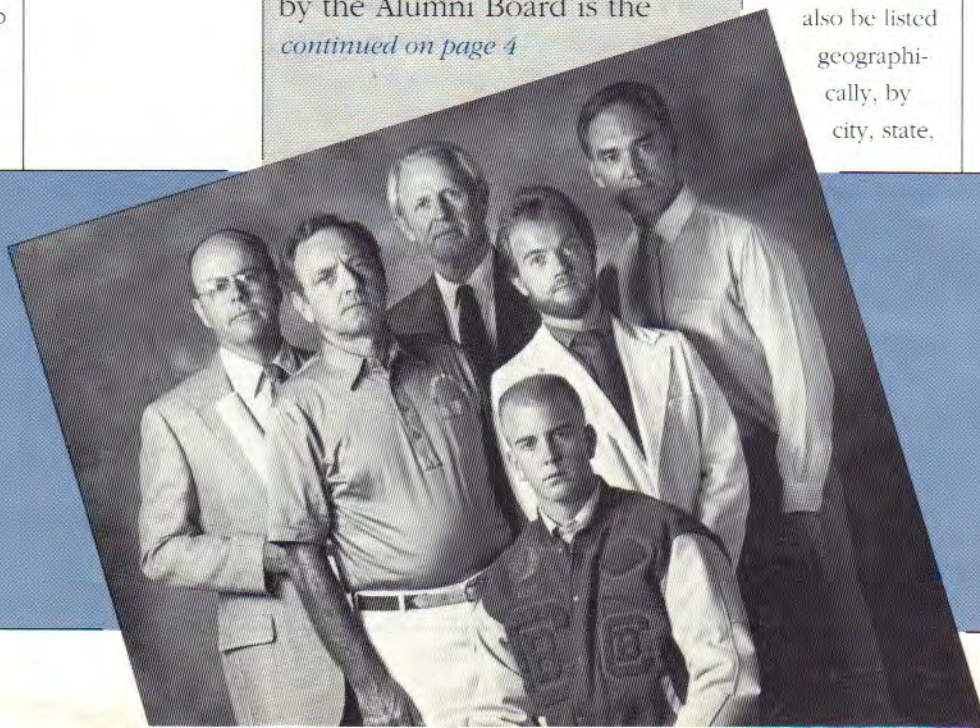
Questionnaires have recently been mailed to all alumni by Harris Publishing Company, which will publish a Christian Brothers High School Alumni Directory next spring.

Annual Alumni Appeal. By now you should have received a brochure from the CBA with a headline that reads: "You Are The Key To His Uncertain Future." The person in question is a Christian Brothers student, representing the student body.

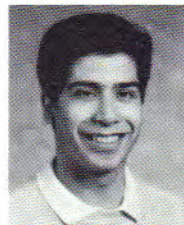
The thrust of this year's appeal has been that everyone participate by donating \$5 for every year since graduation. "This approach was chosen to broaden the base of alumni support for the school," said Rick Cabral, president of the Alumni Association Board.

As a follow-up to the brochure, the Alumni Board coordinated the Phonathon drive, which was held for eight nights beginning October 19, and again November 16-18. The Phonathon was directed at those who have not responded to the written appeal.

The goal for this year's Alumni Appeal Campaign was set at \$60,000, an increase of 30% over last year's campaign. Thus far, \$42,000 has been pledged by over 500 alumni. Another 500 alumni have pledged unspecified gifts.

### C.B. Seniors Participate In University Programs

Several Brothers seniors participated in various university programs this past summer. As part of the Leadership Education and Development program (LEAD), sponsored by private industry, Rico Gonzalez attended Northwestern University in Chicago, and Ruben Mejia attended UCLA. 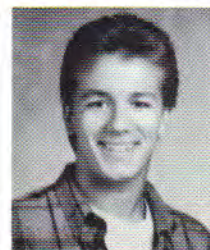
