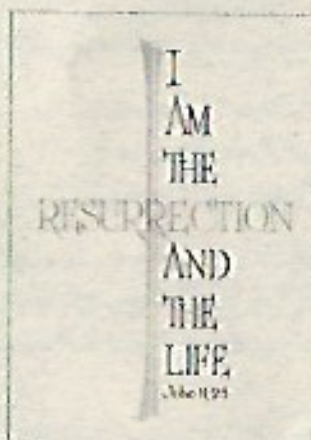

PRAYER FOR THE DEAD


*I*nto your hands, O Lord,


