Brother Joseph is a native New Yorker who has spent the past two years at Christian Brothers as Director of Development. Brother will be returning to his own Province this summer. Brother Bertram, former principal of Christian Brothers will return to Sacramento as Director of Development. Brother Joseph who is celebrating his fiftieth year as a Christian Brother has had a long and successful tenure as a Development Director. He was the Director of Development for his Province and raised almost \$3,000,000 in four years. He later was assigned to St. Joseph College in western Canada and raised over \$1,000,000 in less than a year.
