THE CHRISTIAN BROTHERS TRADITION

The Institute of the Brothers of the Christian Schools, commonly called the Christian Brothers, was founded in 1680 in the city of Reims in France by St. John Baptist de La Salle. All of the members of the congregation are Brothers devoted exclusively to the work of Christian education. As Brothers, these men are not priests and do not engage in the ministries proper to the ordained clergy. The Brothers do take vows and try in every way to keep alive the spirit of brotherhood among themselves and in relationships with their students.

At the time of their foundation, the Brothers devoted themselves in a special way to the task of providing a sound education for the children of the artisans and the poor who otherwise would have been left without any formal education at all. De La Salle and the early Brothers pioneered in many educational practices that are taken for granted today: simultaneous instruction, instruction given in the vernacular rather than Latin, special attention to the skills of reading and writing, insistence on regular attendance, classroom discipline and sound habits of mental and physical hygiene.

Today the Brothers conduct secondary schools and universities in most of the major American cities and in over 80 countries around the world. They are still involved, as they always have been, in parish schools and welfare institutions, and they have associated themselves more and more with devoted and talented lay teachers who share their sense of mission and the Lasallian spirit. Christian Brothers High School has been operated by the Brothers in Sacramento since 1876. The present location on Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard is its third site in the city. Today marks the one hundred and thirty-third commencement for the school.

The variety of educational enterprises conducted by the Brothers, as well as the uniformity of standards and structures that characterizes American educational institutions, makes it difficult to isolate whatever it is that is distinctive about a school conducted by the Brothers. Nevertheless, it is possible to suggest six elements which, if taken together, constitute the concrete reality of a Brothers' school.

The first of these is sensitivity to social issues. That is the reason that brought the Institute of the Brothers into being in the first place. A second but not a secondary quality of the Brothers' school is the importance given to religious education that takes into account the varying needs and experiences of the student. Thirdly, the Brothers' school is committed in a special way to excellence in teaching. The Brothers bring to a school a sense of permanence, commitment and professional competence in the entire teaching staff. A fourth characteristic is an accent on quality education. As a fifth element, the education given in the Brothers' school emphasizes the practice of including religious values in education. The sixth characteristic is the most subtle of all, but something quite distinctive and very real. The Institute is a Papal congregation and is instinctively loyal to the Roman Catholic Church. The Brothers manage their schools with a certain independence but respect the jurisdiction of the local Church authority. Thus they can identify with their lay colleagues, students and parents and so understand better and support movements to give laymen and laywomen a greater role in the life of the Church.

The Brothers are well aware that many other schools manifest certain of the same characteristics listed above, but these six taken together seem to be the best way to describe the identity that the community recognizes as the Brothers' school.

CLASS OF 2009
SCHOLARSHIPS/AWARDS/GRANTS/HONORS:

Congratulations to the class of 2009. Our students have earned recognition for a variety of honors, awards, and scholarships. Several students have earned recognition in one or more of the following categories or organizations. A brief description of these will assist you in understanding the honors accorded our graduates.

National Merit Scholarship Award

Each year, Christian Brothers' eleventh graders take the Preliminary SAT or PSAT exam, along with 1.3 million high school juniors nationwide. Of these, the 50,000 students with the highest PSAT Selection Index scores qualify for recognition in the National Merit Scholarship Program as seniors. More than two-thirds or about 35,000 of the approximately 50,000 high scorers on the PSAT receive Letters of Commendation in recognition of their outstanding academic promise and are deemed National Merit Commended Students. Of the 50,000 high scorers, approximately 15,000 National Merit Semi-Finalists are selected on the basis of grade point average, rigor of courses taken, personal essays, letters of recommendation, and SAT scores. Finalists represent the top 1% of high school students nationwide. The class of 2009 includes 9 Commended Scholars and 3 Finalist Scholars.

Department Awards

Departmental Awards are given to the students who are most outstanding in their fields of study. Criteria include students who earn high grades, have chosen to take the most rigorous courses in a department, are active participants in class discussions, have a passion for the subject matter, and who exemplify Lasallian values.

Bank of America Awards

Bank of America Awards are given to students who have completed superior work in their fields of study. Twenty seniors are selected by faculty to receive certificates in various disciplines.

California Scholarship Federation

The California Scholarship Federation exists to promote and recognize high standards of scholarship, service, and citizenship on the part of students in California schools. Membership is based on scholarship, including grade point average, rigor of courses completed, and citizenship. Life Membership is achieved by qualifying for chapter membership for four or more semesters in the last three years of high school. 100% membership is achieved by qualifying for chapter membership for the last six semesters of high school.

National Honor Society

The National Honor Society is a national organization which recognizes students who possess the following characteristics: leadership, service, character, and academic achievement. Students must be nominated by faculty for membership in the National Honor Society.

Sierra Valley Conference Scholar-Athlete Award

The athletic teams of Christian Brothers belong to the Sierra Valley Conference League which recognizes scholar-athletes who possess a 3.7 or better grade point average and have earned two or more Varsity letters.

President's Award for Educational Excellence

The President's Education Awards Program, sponsored by the U. S. Department of Education, in partnership with the National Association of Secondary School Principals, was developed to help schools recognize and honor those students who have achieved high academic goals by their hard work and dedication to learning. The primary indicators of excellence are based on academic achievement. Students are eligible for the President's Award for Educational Excellence by achieving a grade point average of 3.75 or above, a qualifying score on the SAT or ACT, and criteria that include activities in which a student demonstrates high motivation, initiative, integrity, intellectual depth, leadership qualities, and/or exceptional judgment.

Campus Ministry Award

The Campus Ministry Award is given to those seniors who have taken on leadership roles in the faith formation of their peers. These students have stepped out in faith to share their faith with others as Eucharistic ministers and altar servers at our liturgies; as members of the Liturgy, Mass, and Prayer class who plan and present our liturgies; as members of the Senior Retreat Leadership Team who lead all the Frosh, Sophomore, and Junior retreats; and as student leaders on the Senior Kairos Retreat. Their witness to their faith is an inspiration for the entire CB community.

Christian Service Award

The motto on our cross tower states, "Enter to Learn, Leave to Serve." Students who receive Christian Service Awards have taken those words to heart and have done an outstanding number of Christian Service hours. The Christian Service Award goes to students who have completed at least 125 hours of service during their years at Christian Brothers. The Christian Service Award with Distinction goes to students who have completed at least 250 hours of service during their years at Christian Brothers.
