Ron Limeberger

Ron's goal was to give back to the Brothers what they had given him. No doubt that debt was marked "paid in full" long ago. From his student days at 21st & Broadway to the day in 1958 when he joined the faculty, Ron Limeberger gave it all he had in the classroom as student and teacher to the playing fields as athlete and coach to the CB Community as mentor and friend.

In his 42 year career Ron touched the lives of over 16,000 students....that's better than four generations of young CB men and women that benefitted from knowing and learning from him. He loved his students and treated them with a great amount of respect. I wonder, though, if he realized that he taught them more outside the classroom than inside. The way he lived his life, incorporating the Christian principles and values that we so strive to teach our children, was inspiring. He was an honest man. His energy, dedication and loyalty to Christian Brothers High School was legendary. He had courage in defending his beliefs. And he made it seem so easy!!

In the year since Ron has been gone we have had a chance to see what life will be like without him. But, more importantly, we have had a chance to reflect on what it was with him... just how much he gave to each of us in the course of daily life. Yes, we do say his debt to the Brothers is paid in full....and then some.

It is with great pleasure that we introduce our official photographer, now retired, Lee Winter. Lee is a native Californian. He saw service in Italy...23 bombing missions to be exact...before being shot down and captured. He later escaped. After the war he stayed in the Active Reserve and retired as a Major in the United States Air Force.

Lee's first love has always been baseball and, following his dreams, in 1947 he signed with the Sacramento Solons. Lee continued to play as catcher for various teams in the Western International League, the Central League and the Pioneer League. Finally, he was traded back to Sacramento.

After 7 years of baseball and a severe ankle injury Lee hung up his cleats and settled here in Sacramento with his wife and two children. He worked for the Sacramento Sheriff's Department for 21 years and retired as a Sergeant. He now spends time honing his golfing skills.

The Air Force's, Baseball's and Sheriff's loss was our gain when Lee volunteered to immortalize our events forever on celluloid. He has been doing that for the last 10 years. 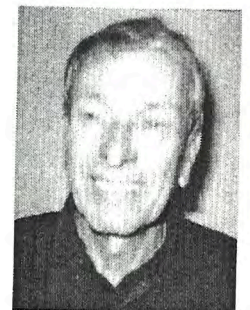

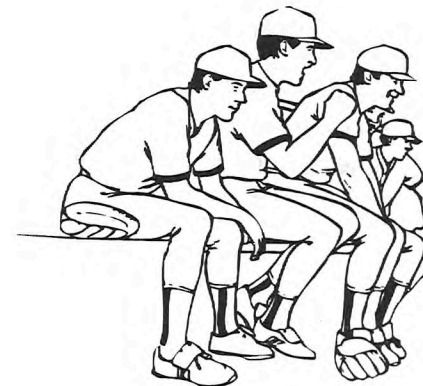
