The Frosh-Soph Team, strongest in school history, won two trophies at the Holden Relays and won the Del Oro Invitational and the Sac-San Joaquin Sub-Sections. At the Del Oro, Andy Garcia and Mike Reed received the Most Valuable Athlete awards. Team record was 6-3 for the season and 3-3 in League competition.

Soph runner Andy Garcia hit 10.2 in the 100, 22.3 in the 220, high jumped 5'-7 $\frac{3}{4}$ " and totaled 230 points for the year. Jess Silva pole vaulted 11'-2" and ran the 180 low hurdles in 21.2, while Fred Wikkeling took the 70 high hurdles in 9.2. All these times and distances are school records.

Frosh Steve Johnson was the most outstanding athlete in the Sacramento area and in the history of the school. He set the best mile (4:36.4) in Sacramento area history and the 2-mile record (10:16.7) in the Woodland Invitational. Mike Reed shattered the soph school record by 6 feet with a 50'-9 $\frac{3}{4}$ " shot put.

All who participated in track this year are Sub-Section Champs and deserve congratulations for turning in strong performances throughout the season.
