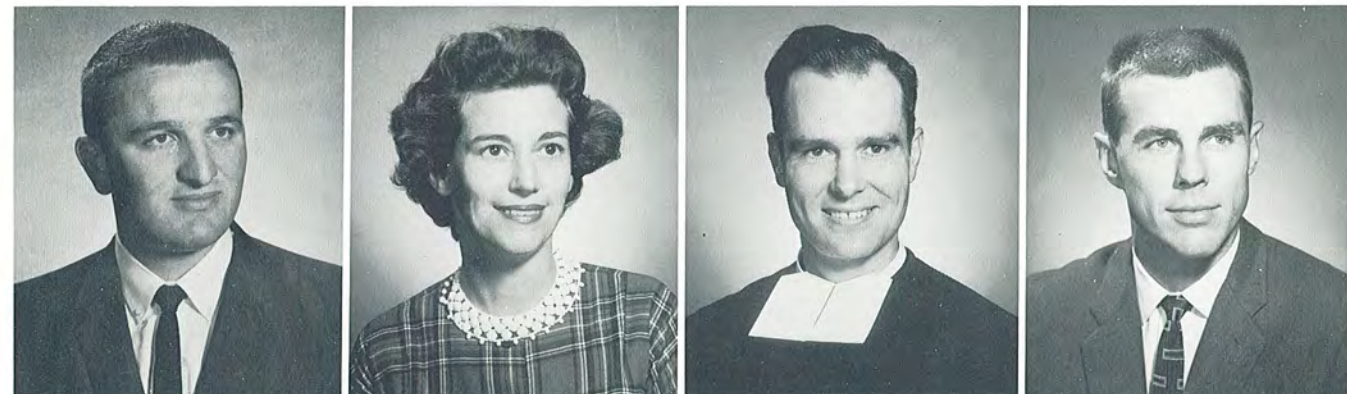

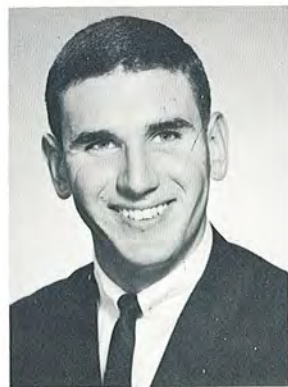

My dear Seniors:



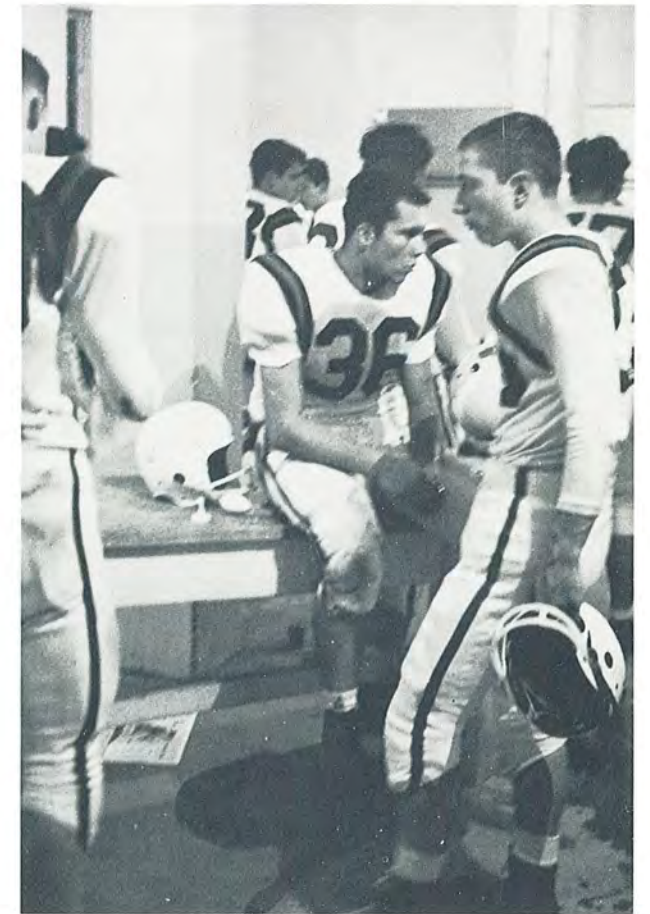

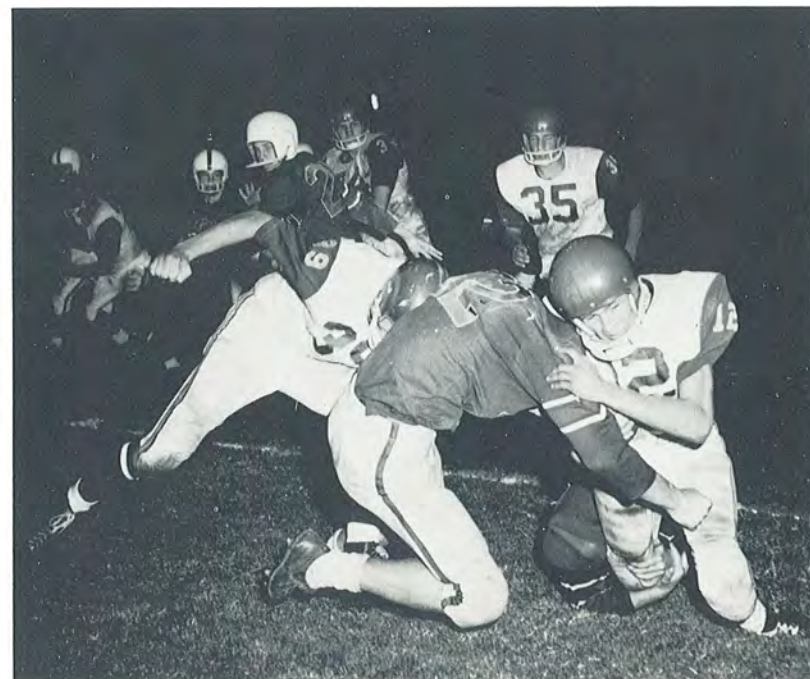

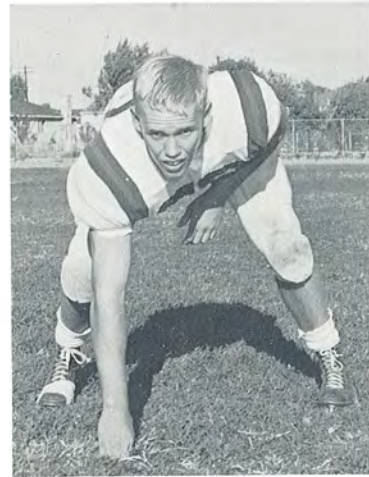

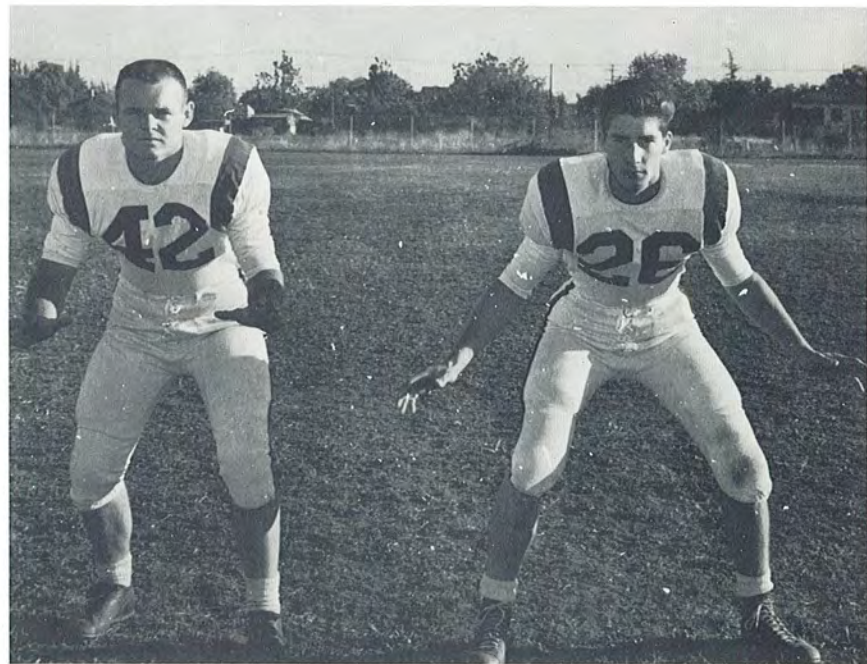

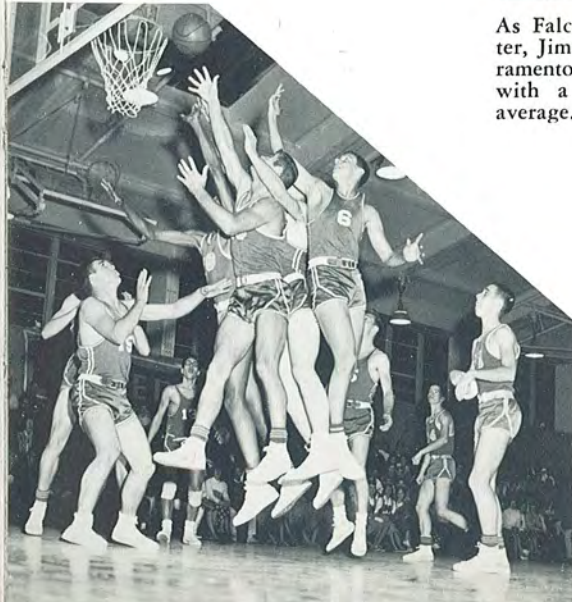

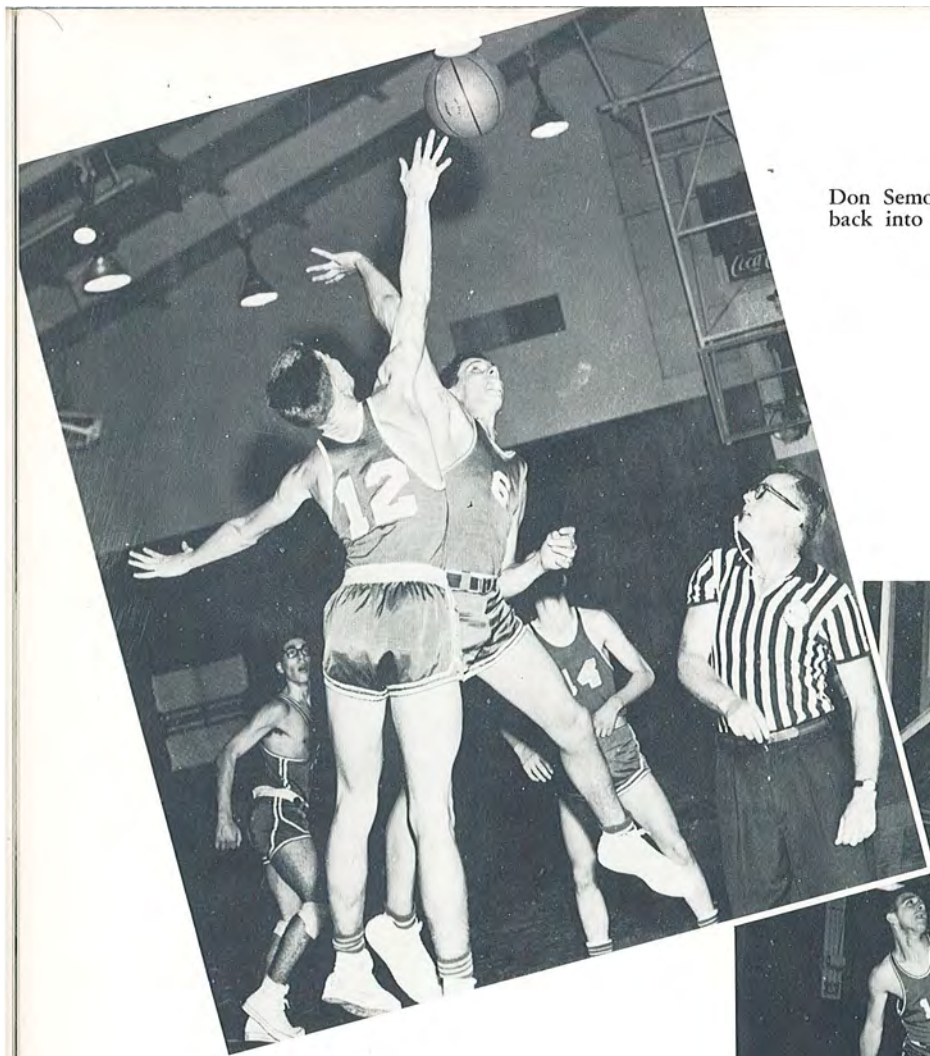

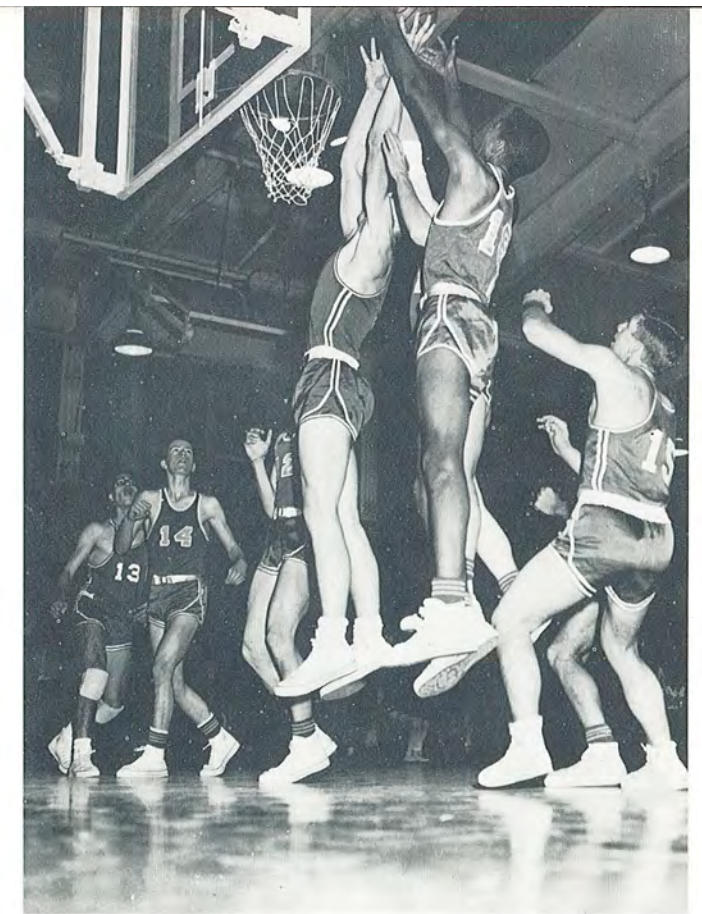

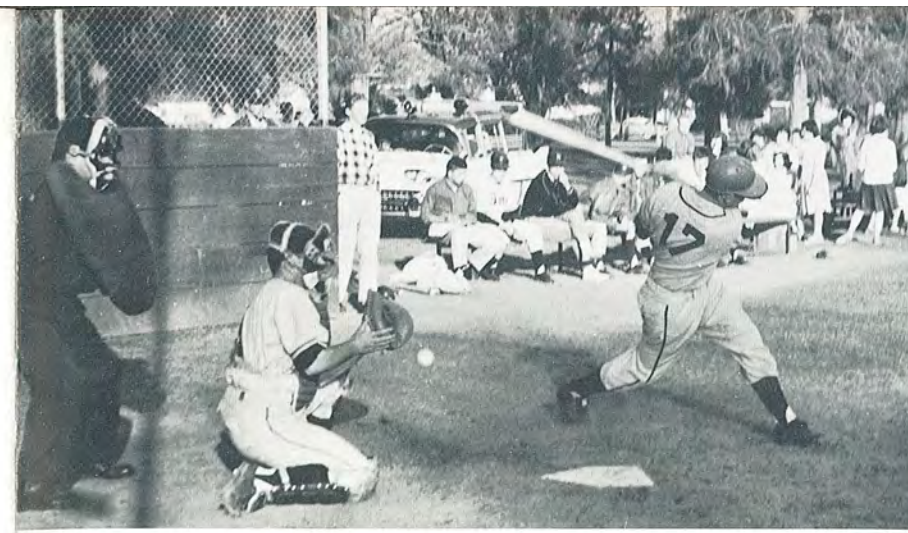

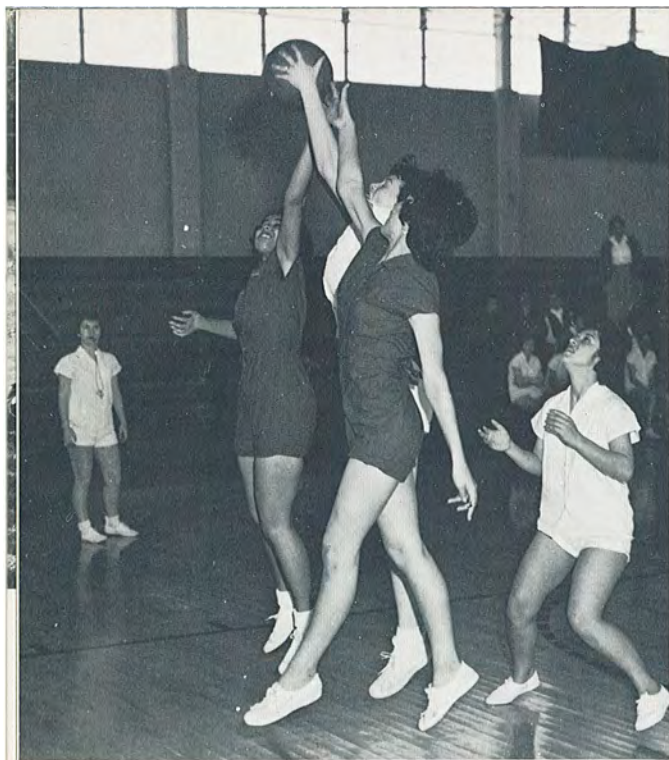
