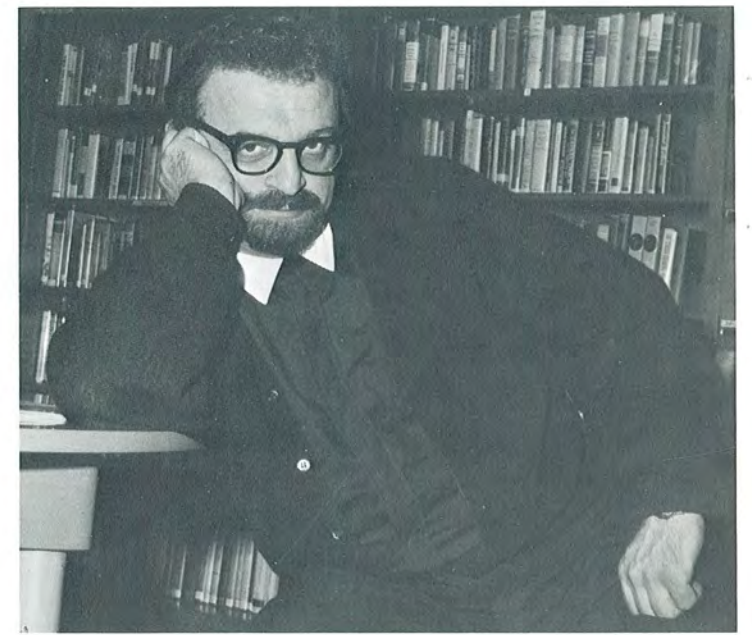
ADMINISTRATION

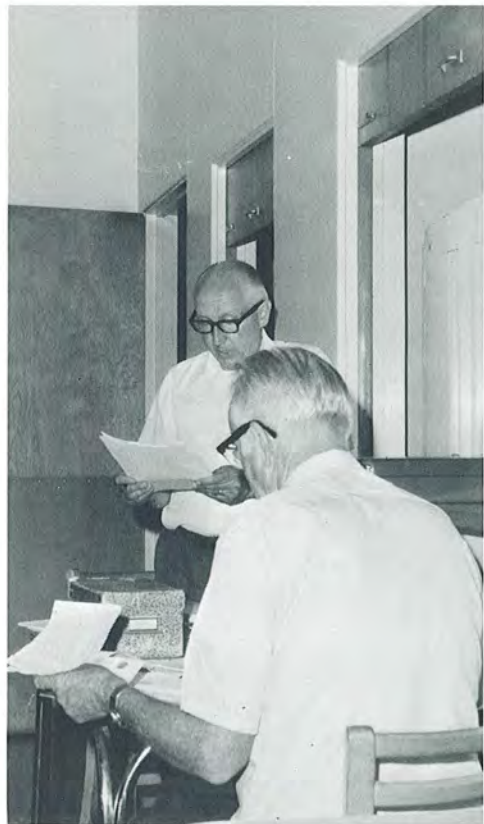
PARENTS GUILD
