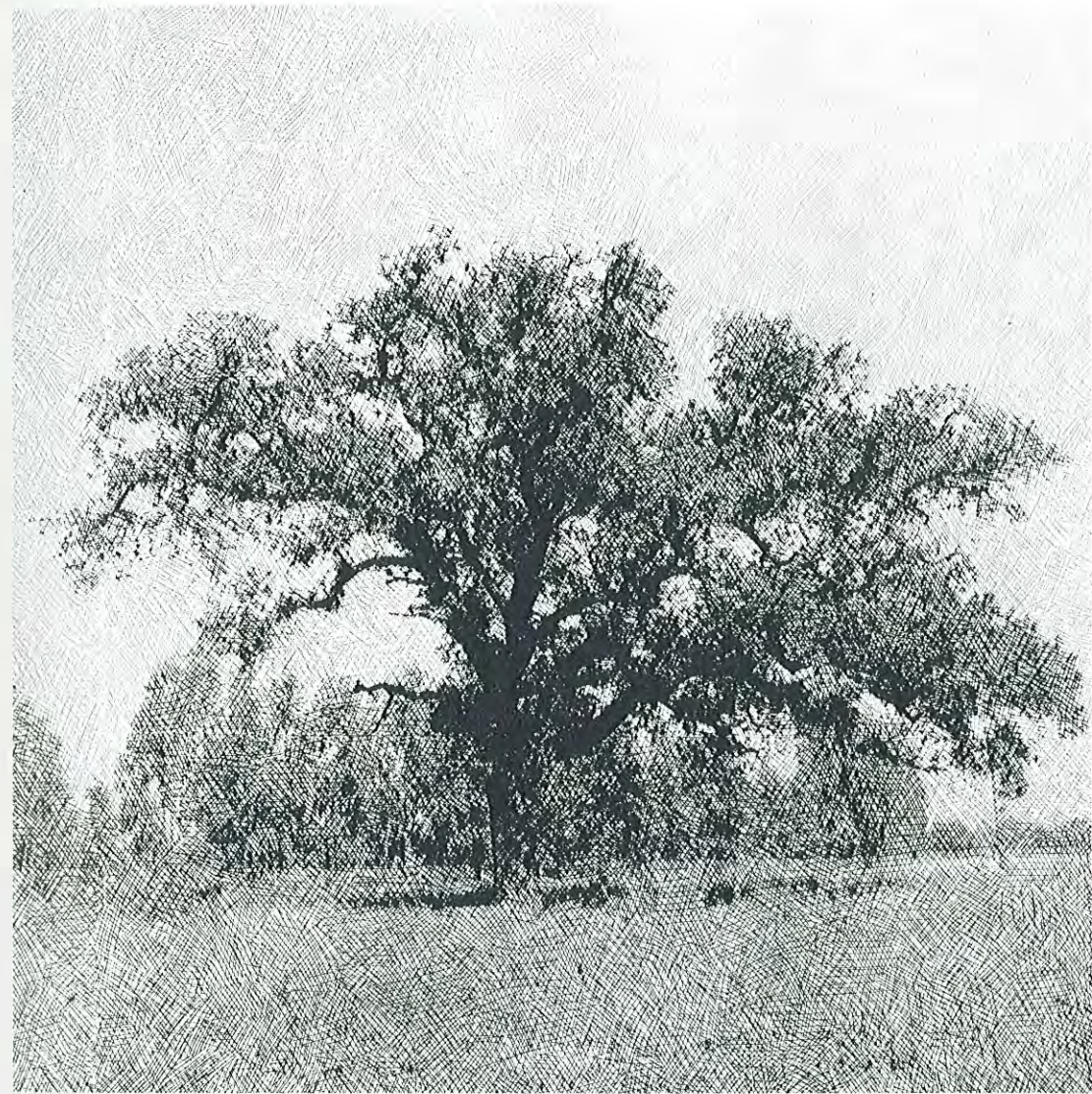

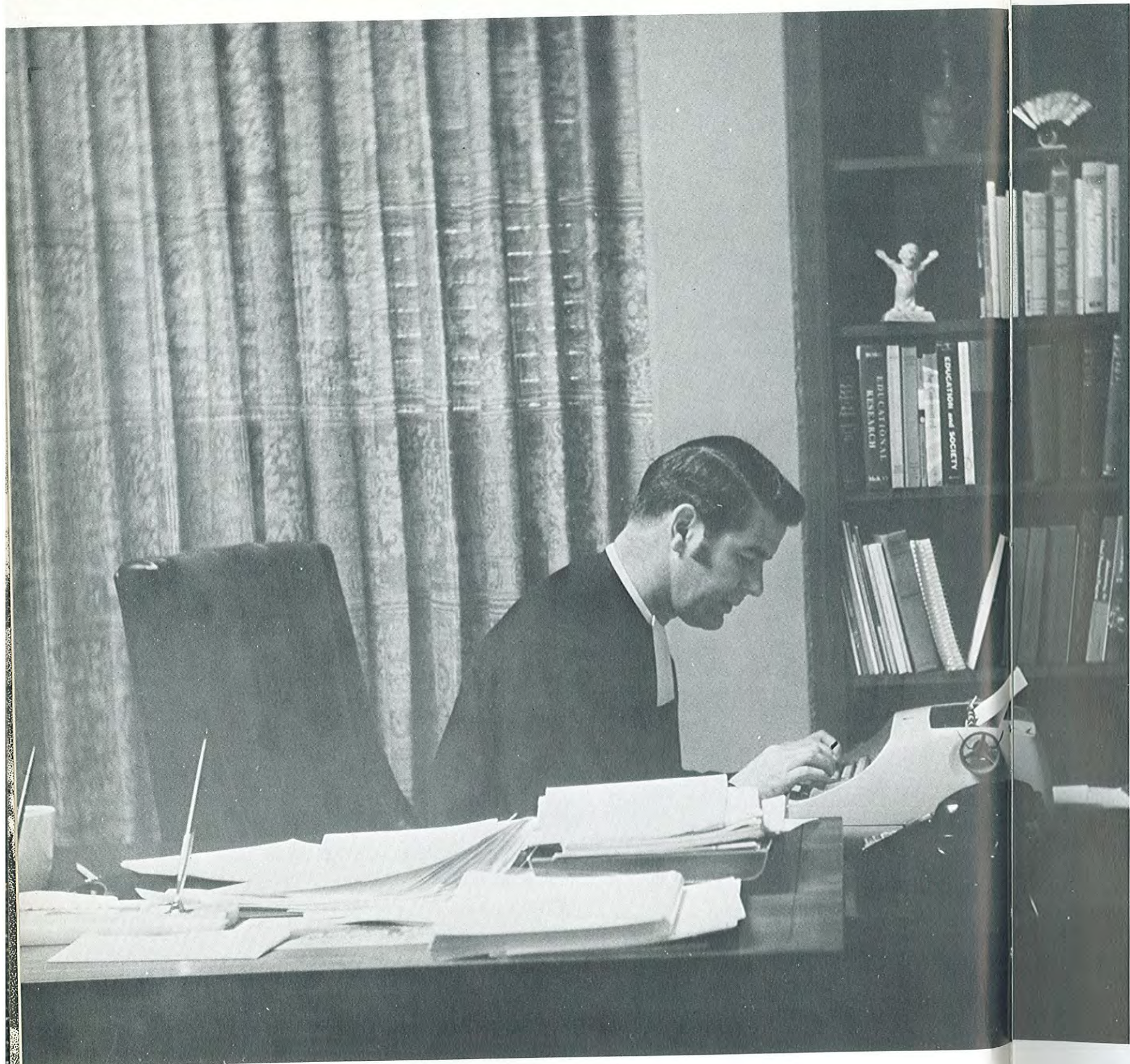

ADMINISTRATION

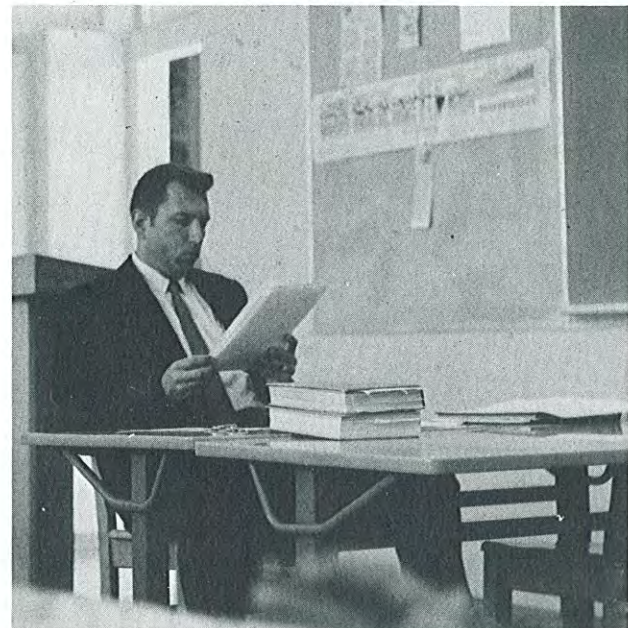

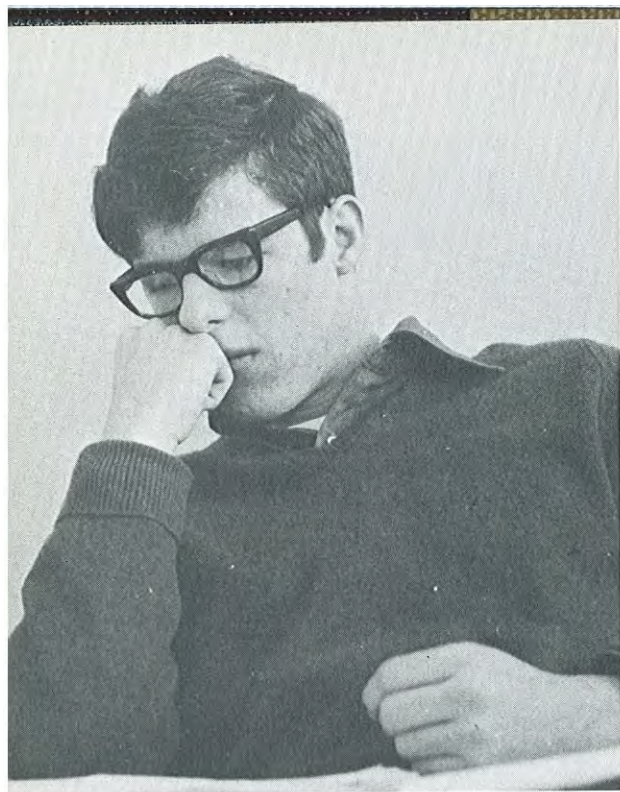
Intramural Volleyball

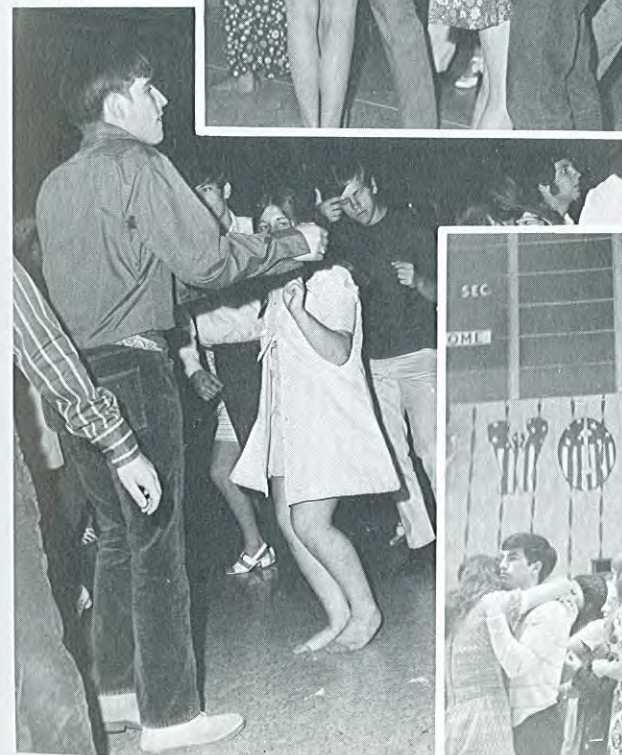


Woodstock

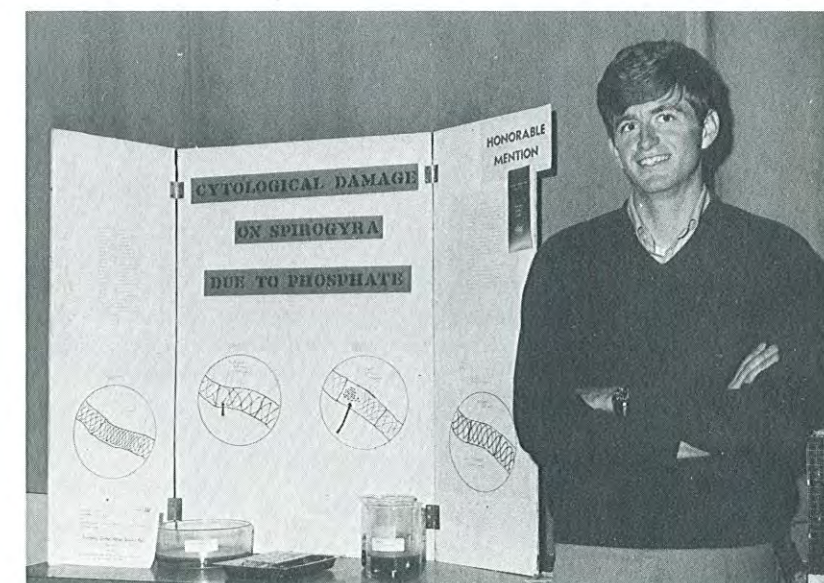


SCIENCE Fair

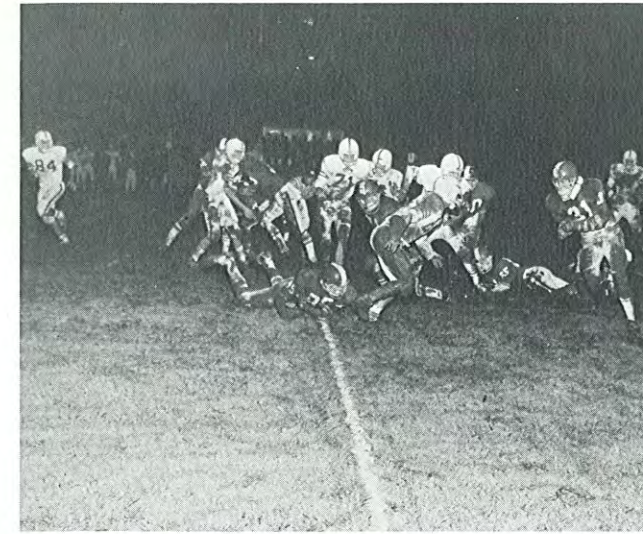
