The Christian Brothers' Tri-Centennial

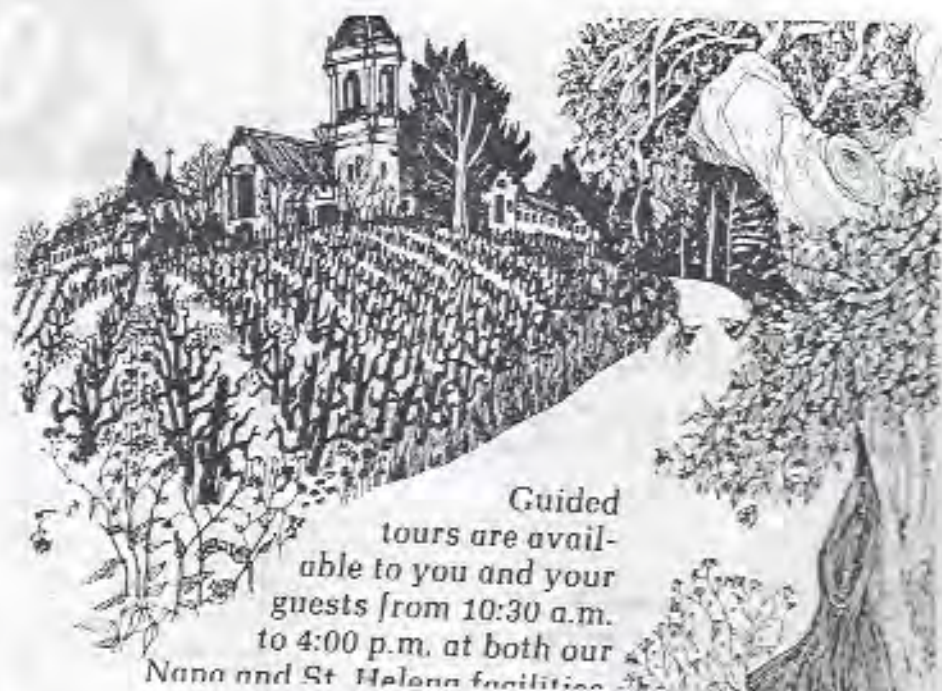
In the late 1600's in Rheims, France, Jean Baptiste de La Salle opened his home to a devoted group of followers who believed as he did, that education was the birthright of all, rather than a privilege of the wealthy. He formalized his then revolutionary ideal of free schools in 1680 by founding "Brothers of the Christian Schools," a religious teaching order which has become the church's largest body of men devoted exclusively to education. Saint Jean Baptiste de La Salle was canonized in 1900 and honored again in 1950 by Pope Plus XII when he was named "Patron of all Teachers."

The Christian Brothers came to the United States in 1845, and today operate 125 primary schools, high schools and colleges throughout the country. Mont La Salle, The Christian Brothers Novitiate for California and the Western States, is located near Napa, California. Since 1882, in addition to their 300 year old heritage as teachers, The Christian Brothers of California have also followed another tradition, the growing of grapes and making of fine wines. Proceeds from this work are used to support their schools in the Western Province.

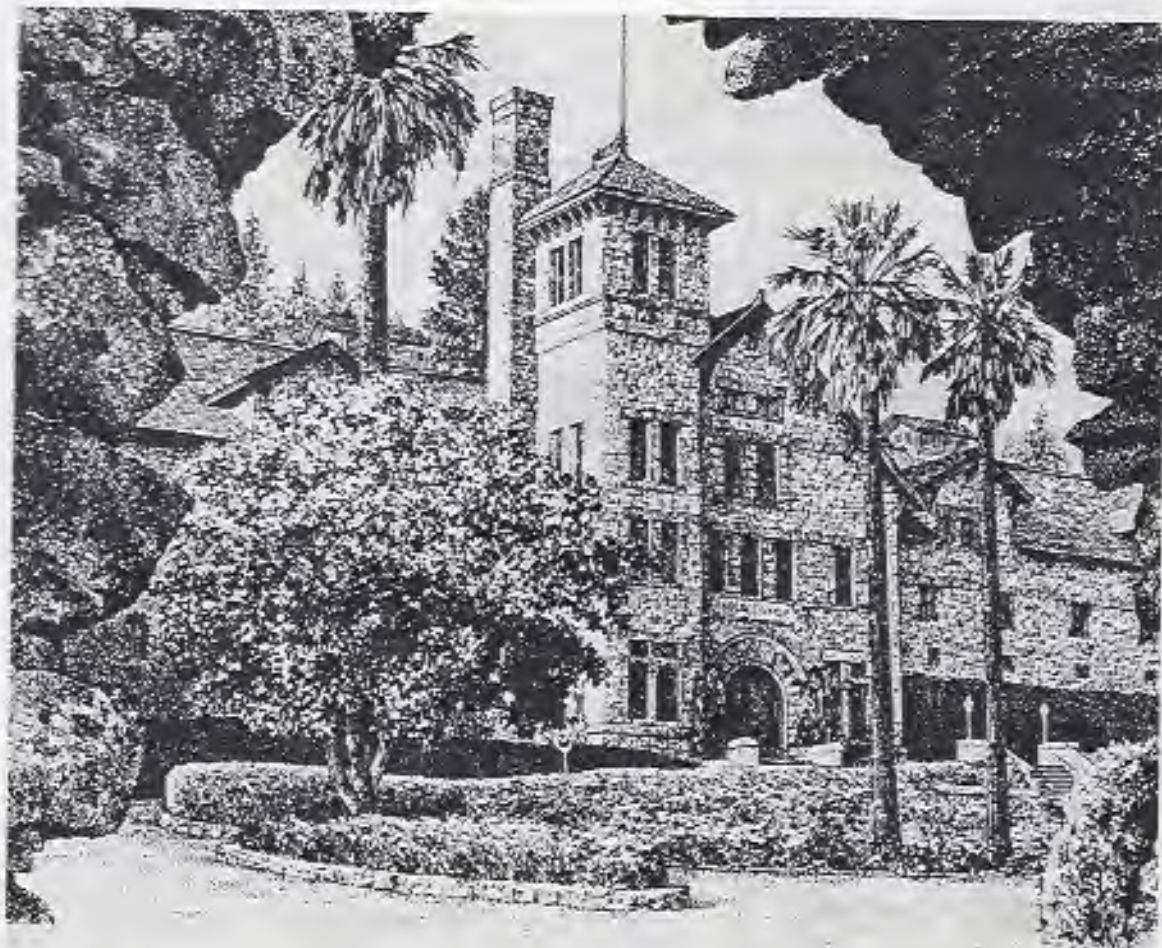
We have chosen to bottle this 1975 Cabernet Sauvignon in honor of the 300th Anniversary of our Order. This wine, combines Cabernet Sauvignon grapes from all three of Napa Valley's climatic zones with 13% Cabernet Franc grapes to enhance its complexity. The wine was matured in oak casks and bottled in August, 1978. Total production was 4,500 cases.
