



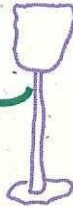

# Notes on Wine Tasting

The notes presented for your tasting this evening are from some of this region's most distinguished wineries. When sampling each of the wines offered, we recommend using the following method which will be demonstrated by representatives from *Entoria* of Sacramento:

∴ Examine the wine for color and clarity.

∴ Perceive the fragrances for the wine; the *aroma* (fragrance derived from the grape), the *bouquet* (fragrance derived from the vinification and aging).

∴ Taste the wine, rolling it in the mouth to savor the flavor, body, and texture.

∴ Swallow the wine and note its aftertaste (the lingering fragrance and sensations remaining in the mouth after the wine is swallowed).

We hope this method will enhance your enjoyment of the wines offered this evening. Still, use any procedure you prefer and don't be governed solely by the opinions of others. Should you overindulge in the spirit and/or spirits of the evening, PLEASE contact one of the volunteers to assist you in arranging for safe transportation home.

Remember, in wine tasting there is only one basic rule: drink the wine you enjoy!

*Entoria representatives will also be available to answer additional questions about the wines and beers featured this evening.*

# General Auction Rules

∴ Items are sold on an "as is" basis. The Alumni Association shall not be held responsible for the accuracy of the descriptions of the items.

∴ Each item has a bid sheet in front of it on the table. If you wish to bid on an item, simply write in your name, telephone number, and the amount of your bid.

∴ Minimum bids are posted for each item. The opening bid on each lot must equal or exceed that amount. Each new bid must be written on the next blank line available on the bid sheet.

∴ Bidding increments for each item are written on the bid sheet in front of the item. Bidding must be in the designated increments; incorrect increment bidding will be disallowed. Also if a bid sheet is removed from the auction table by a bidder, the item will be removed from sale.

∴ Auction items are not to be removed from the auction table by anyone other than a designated Wine Tasting Extravaganza volunteer assigned to that responsibility.

∴ The highest bid at the closing of the auction constitutes the winning bid. Payments of the successful bidders are to be made the evening of the auction. Payment may be made via cash, check, or credit card. A listing of the winners will be posted at approximately 8:30 P.M. Please report to the auction area for payment and pick-up of all auction items.

∴ All sales are final. Unless stated to the contrary, there will be no exchanges or refunds on items by the Alumni Association or donor.
