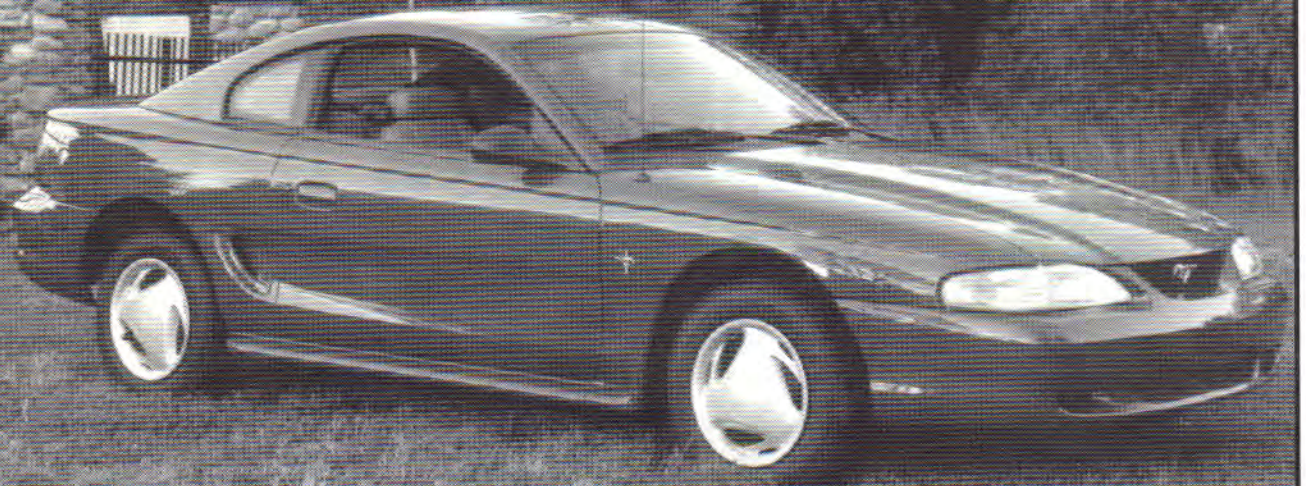

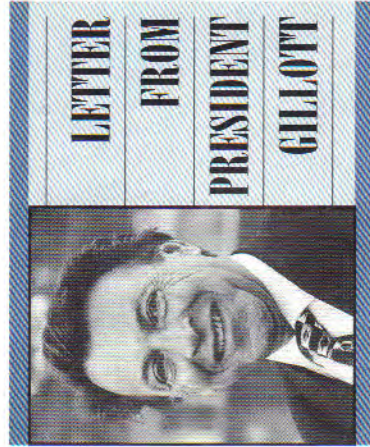

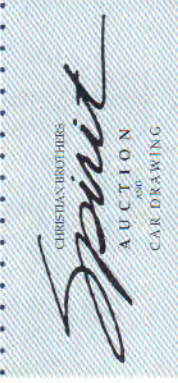

to ensure that this school will continue to be extremely strong as we move into the twenty-first century.

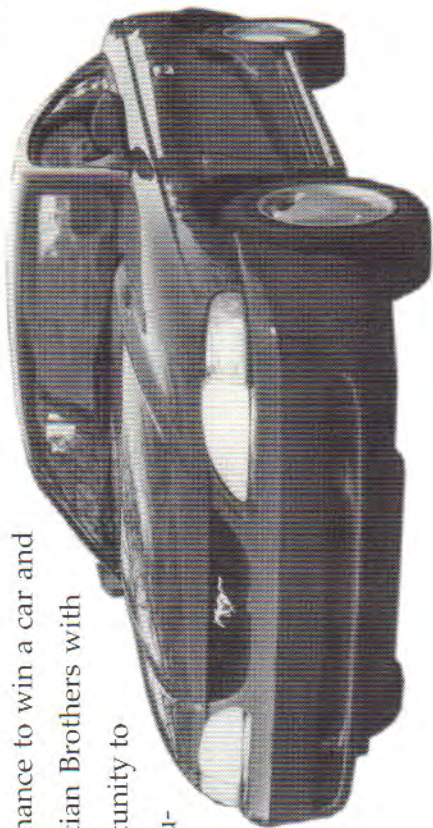

As reported in an earlier issue of the Connection, Christian Brothers High School was visited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) in April 1995. I had hoped that a permanent president would be in place prior to that visit, however, that was not the case. In all honesty, I expected the visiting team to conclude that the accreditation time period should be shortened to give WASC an opportunity to examine the impact of change in leadership on the School's future. To my pleasure, the School's accreditation was renewed for the maximum period permitted. I feel confident that the visiting team recognized the quality and strength of our academic programs, the competence and dedication of our faculty and staff, and the effective leadership provided by the administration. It was clear that the temporary nature of my appointment did not raise concern and that the situation of the presidency posed no problem for the team. I appreciate the confidence the team placed in my leadership and that of the entire faculty, administration, and staff.

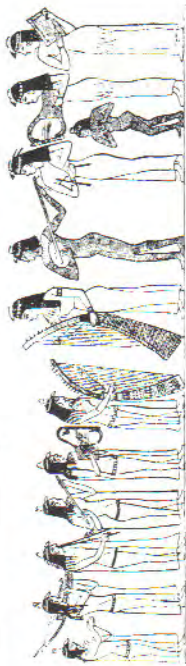

# The State of the Campus

Since becoming a coeducational school, the Christian Brothers campus has been expanded and improved tremendously. With the construction projects completed over the last year, we have added a total of 14 classrooms and three parking lots within the last six years. We have re-roofed all of the buildings, replaced all of the old classroom lighting with high efficiency fixtures, expanded athletic facilities, upgraded the fire alarm and phone systems, and installed several additional student and handicap access walkways. We also installed a dedicated networked computer lab and Internet access computer workstations in the library. For those who remember wading through the parking lot to attend winter events, we redesigned the drainage system too.

Increasing the instructional space within the limits of our 22-acre campus is challenging. In order to maximize use of available space and facilities, we have redesigned facilities and moved departments around.

The residence building, now Bertram Hall, was less than half occupied for the past several years. Its renovation created full utilization, allowing more space for direct student services. In a project jointly financed by the school and De La Salle Institute, the south wing, living room, dining room and kitchen areas were renovated for the private living quar-

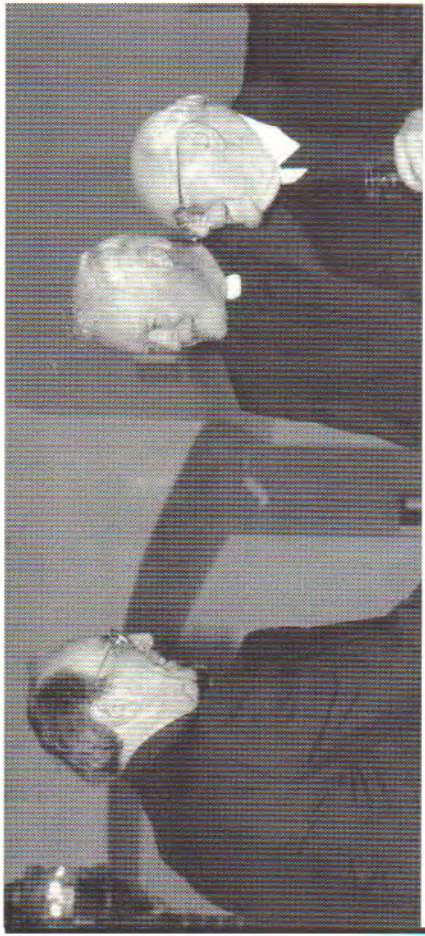

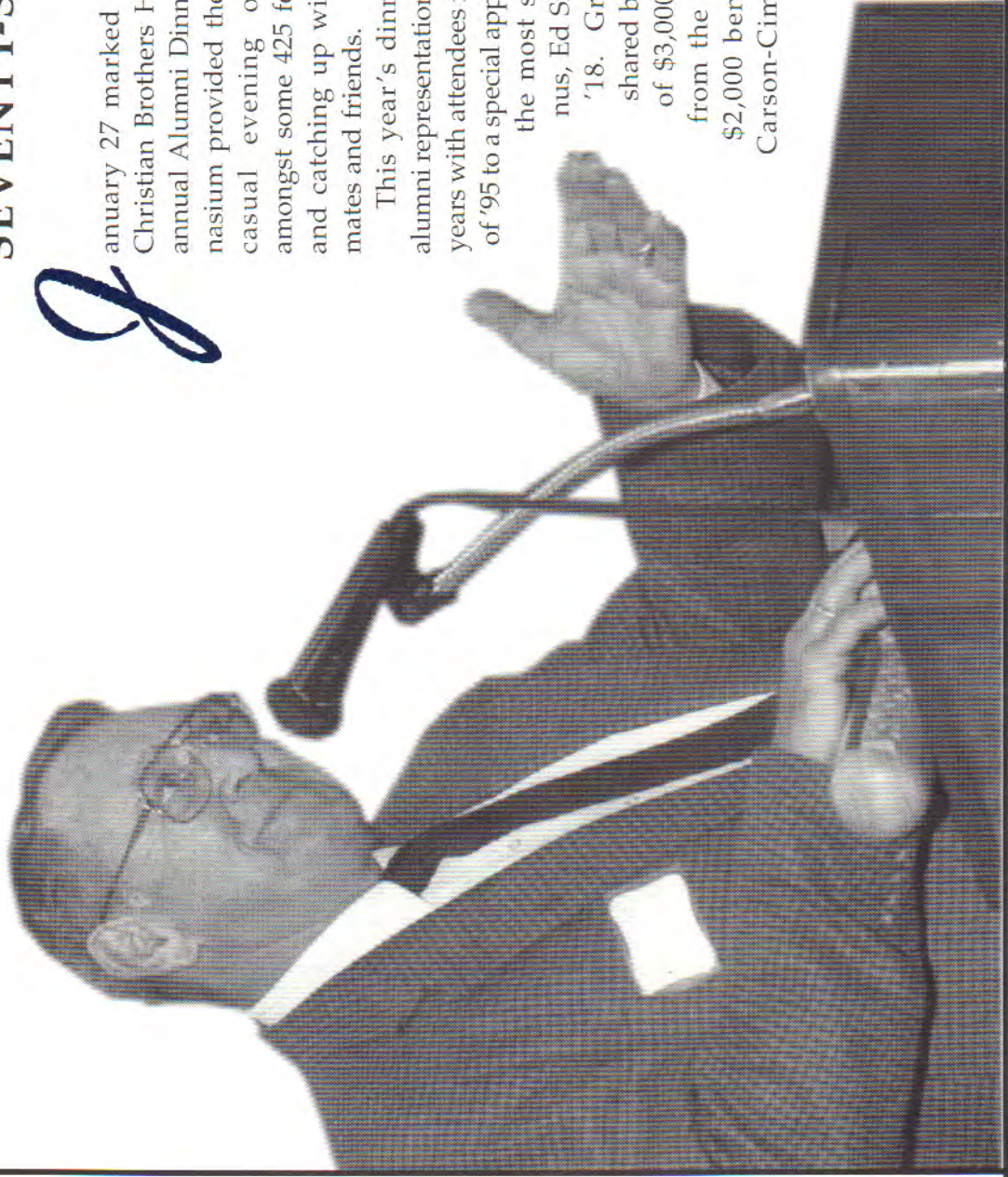

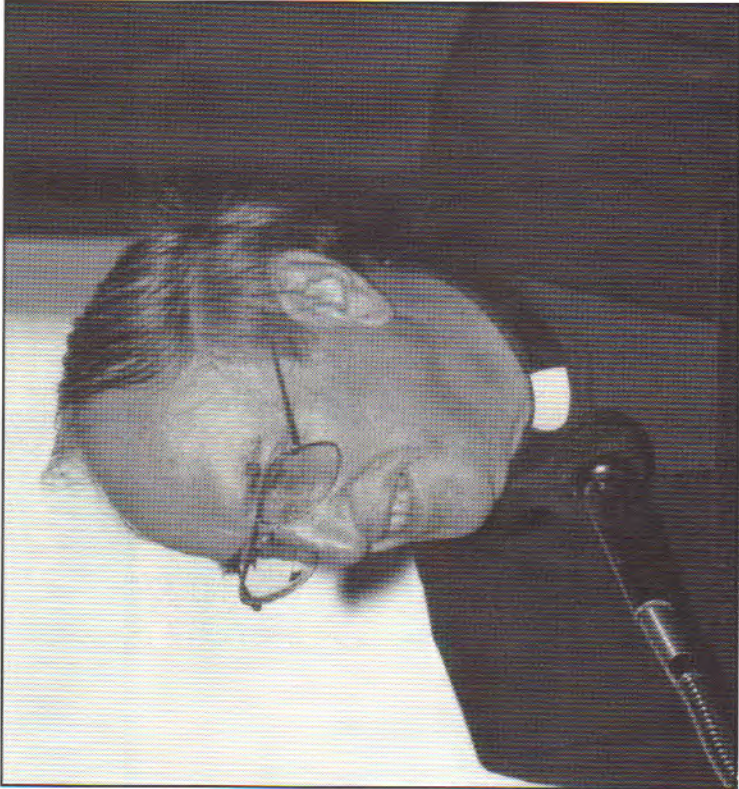

ters of the Brothers' community. The north wing was redesigned to relocate the offices of President, Finance, Development, and Systems Support, enabling us to convert the former Development Building into two rehearsal/instruction classrooms, with an area for instrument storage lockers and a department office for our growing music program. It also allowed us to move the Admissions Department to the front office and provide more space for the Campus Ministry program. At the same time, we added student walkways, three additional regular classrooms, and resurfaced the front driveway and parking lots. We also recently completed an unplanned renovation of the chapel, which was damaged in a fire a few months ago.

In all, more than \$1.5 million has been spent on campus improvements and major maintenance projects since 1989. This was accomplished while tuition remained at or below the median for comparable schools, scholarship and financial aid funds nearly doubled, faculty salaries increased from among the lowest to some of the highest of the De La Salle schools, and reasonable class sizes have been maintained. These improvements, along with

our outstanding academic program, were recognized last year when the Western Association of Schools and Colleges once again gave Christian Brothers the highest accreditation rating. None of this would have been possible without donor support.

Over the last few years there has been a great deal of discussion about whether the school would remain at the Oak Park campus or move to a new site. This issue was resolved in January 1995, when the Board of Trustees voted unanimously to remain at and reinvest in the current campus and pursue expansion to a second campus to handle the growing demand for a Christian Brothers education. Since then, we have been designing our facility's master plan with long-term tenancy at Martin Luther King Boulevard in mind. Significant future improvement plans include expansion and renovation of the library and the science labs, an additional gymnasium facility, expansion of the computer network with Internet access into the classrooms and the addition of a performing arts center. The Board recently contracted with a consulting firm to complete a feasibility study for a capital campaign. The study was completed in February 1996 and planning for the campaign is now underway.
