Brother Timothy Diener, FSC

Born in 1910, Brother Timothy entered the Brothers novitiate in 1928 at Martinez, California. His first teaching assignment was at Christian Brothers High School in Sacramento in 1931. While teaching chemistry at Saint Mary's College High School in Berkeley, he was assigned to Mont La Salle Vineyards in July of 1935.

In his more than fifty years of service to the Christian Brothers in their winery, he has filled a variety of positions. Perhaps he is most remembered by those advertisements featuring him as Cellar Master of Mont La Salle Vineyards.

For a number of years he was involved in public relations answering letters that requested information or fielding complaints. In this role, the careful school teacher made his ideas crystal clear to his correspondent.

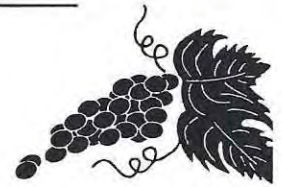
There were years when he was much in demand as a speaker at various wine events. His invocations at these events were given not only with great flair, but with deep religious insight.

In 1977, on being chosen Man of the Year by the American Society of Enologists, Brother remarked, "Wine growing is a fascinating business. Everything changes. Grape varieties and wine technology change. We are making a better wine every year. There is a constant effort toward improvement."

He is a founding member of the International Correspondence of Corkscrew Addicts. His collection of corkscrews is currently on display at the Culinary Institute of America, located at Greystone in St. Helena, formerly owned by Christian Brothers winery.

While he retired as Cellar Master in 1984, he continued working out of the Public Relations office until the Mont La Salle Vineyards sold its assets to Heublin, Inc. in 1989.

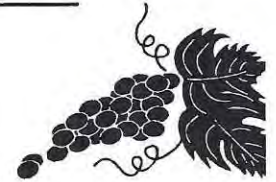

Notes on Wine Tasting



The wines presented for your tasting this evening are from America's most distinguished wineries. In sampling each of the wines which are offered, we suggest you try the following method as used by experienced wine tasters:

- ✓ Examine the wine for color and clarity.
- ✓ Perceive the fragrances of the wine: the aroma (fragrance derived from the grape), and the bouquet (fragrance derived from vinification and aging.)
- ✓ Taste the wine - rolling it in the mouth - so as to savor the flavor, body and texture.
- ✓ Swallow the wine and note its aftertaste (the lingering fragrance and sensations remaining in the mouth after the wine is swallowed).

We believe this method will enhance your enjoyment of the wines. But use any method you prefer and don't be governed solely by the opinions of others. Should you overindulge in the spirits of the evening, PLEASE contact one of the volunteers to assist you in arranging for safe transportation home.

Remember, in wine tasting, there is only one rule...Drink the wine that YOU enjoy!
