Bishop Armstrong High Will Graduate 238

Bishop Armstrong High School will climax a year of outstanding scholastic and athletic achievement on Thursday evening June 13, 1957, with Commencement ceremonies at 8 PM in the gymnasium at the school. This is the first class graduating from Bishop Armstrong High School. The \$1,350,000 co-educational high school was opened in September, 1956.

HOP MCGUCKEN will preside and present the diploma to 238 young men and women. Sister Mary Celestine, S.M.A., and Brother W. Gabriel, F.S.C., are principals, will present graduates to the Bishop.

Principal speaker at the commencement exercises will be James D. Poole, superintendent of Catholic schools. Robert W. Lemmon, Carmen Solerio will speak in the name of their class as valedictorians.

GENERAL Excellence medals and Religion Medals will be presented at graduation. Other awards will be made at special honors assembly at the school on June 12. The class of 1957 and the Glee Club directed by Anton Dorn will sing at the graduation.
