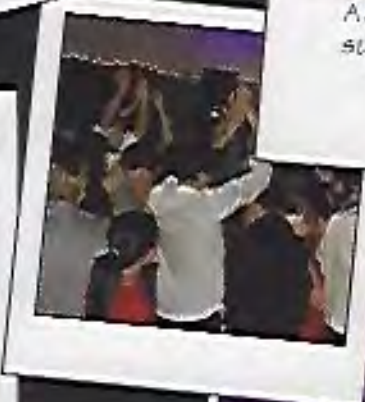

For the first time in recent memory, Christian Brothers High School competed in the Sacramento Region Academic Decathlon. This annual event tests students on a wide range of subject and skill areas within a given theme. This year's topic was Russia, and our 17 member team worked from the beginning of the school year until early February to prepare for exams in Mathematics, Economics, Science, Art, Music, Social Science and Literature. This preparation included reading a massive binder of information and the novel Dr. Zhivago as well as attending lectures by CB teachers, an off-campus concert and lecture series, a multi-school scrimmage at CSU Sacramento, and weekly study sessions. In addition to the graded subject tests, each student also had to write a timed essay, give prepared and impromptu speeches and be interviewed by a group of judges. Head Coach Holly Keller and Assistant Coach Mary Bowers selected the team and guided them through the process as they themselves learned the Aca Deca ropes for the first time too. On the morning of competition, the CB team showed up ready for action and then dove into the grueling test of academic excellence. The day ended with the Superquiz, which had all teams competing in front of a cheering audience. CB started strong and ended up in the middle of the field for this event. The final results were not announced until the Awards Banquet four days later. Despite being "first-timers", CB placed an impressive 9th out of 21 teams. Three team members also won individual event medals: Dana Kimball took a gold medal in Mathematics and received a \$100 scholarship as the team's high scorer. Ted Datanagan won a silver medal in the Interview, and Kevin Camacho won silver for Art. Kevin was also given the CBIHS Team Leadership Award.

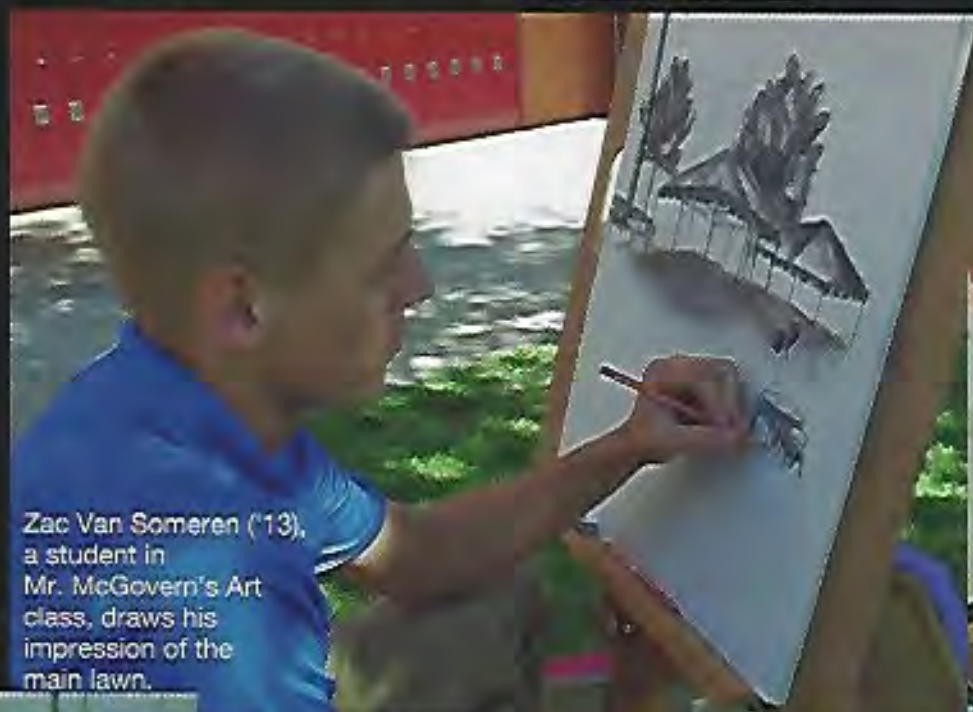

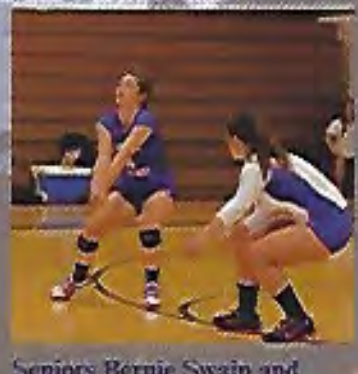

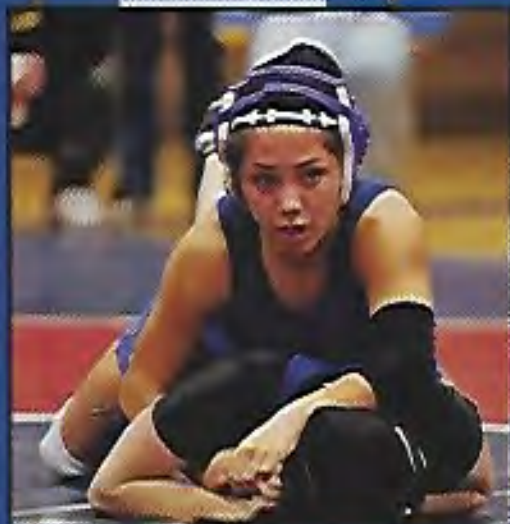

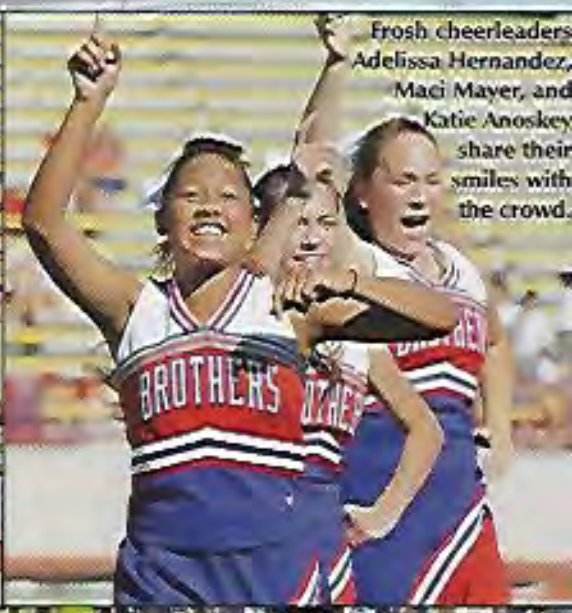

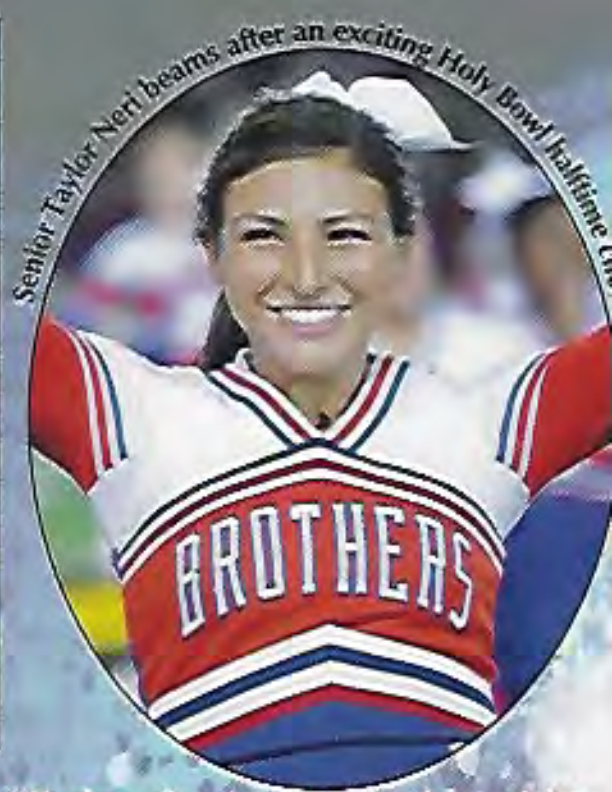

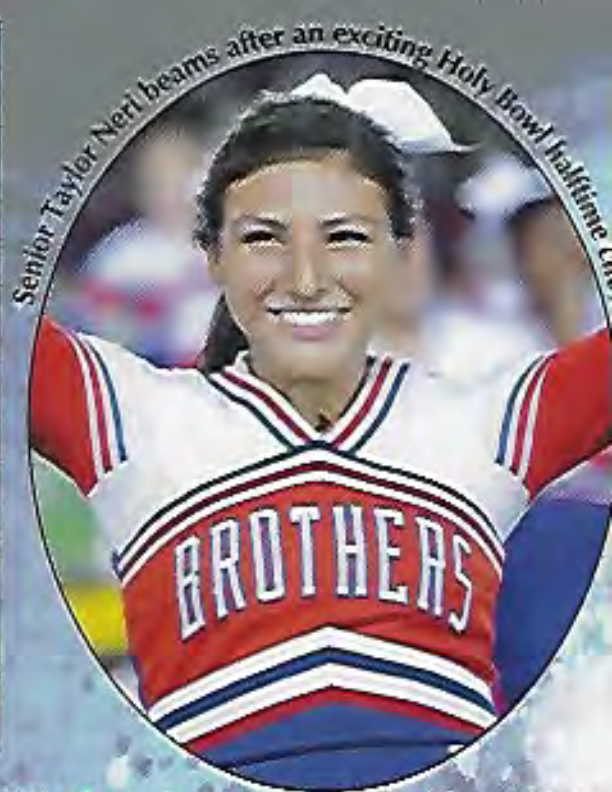
