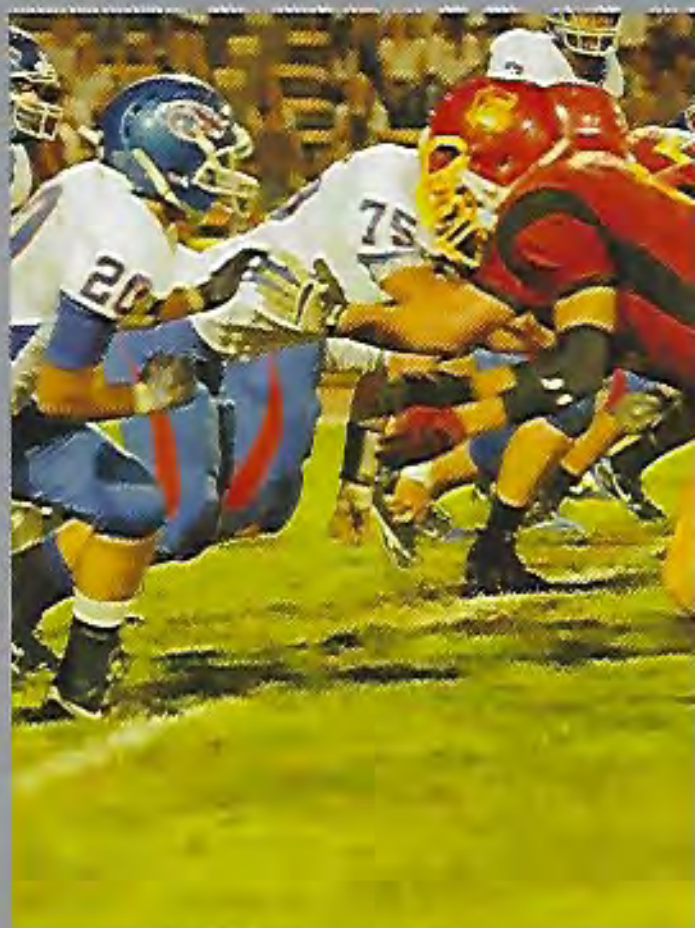

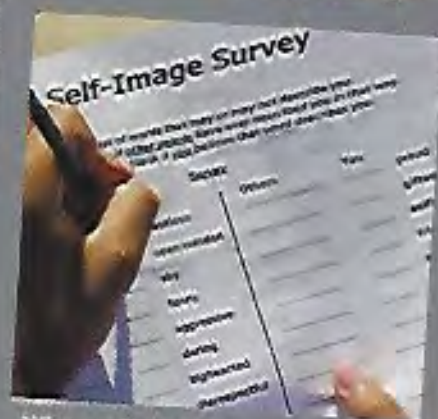

TRAGEDY STRIKES JAPAN

A 9.0 magnitude earthquake struck off the coast of northern Japan which caused a massive tsunami. The disaster damaged several nuclear reactors and left thousands of people missing or dead. Months later, the effects remained evident as waste and debris made its way to the western U.S. coastline.



HURRICANE IRENE

Hurricane Irene hit many states along the East Coast in late summer and caused the closing of airports and subways, home evacuations, massive power outages and flooding.



Millions of people were affected by the storm.

TAKING IT TO THE STREETS

Occupy Wall Street was a protest started in Manhattan's financial district. The protesters' purpose was to call attention to its perspective on Wall Street's role in the economic recession. Within a month, the event grew to a global movement spanning 1,500 cities worldwide.



REMEMBERING 9/11

September 11, 2011, marked the 10-year anniversary of the 9/11 attacks. In observance, The National 9/11 Memorial & Museum opened in New York to honor the 2,977 people who lost their lives in the tragedy. The monument includes 2 waterfall pools that occupy the area where the World Trade Center towers stood.



HONORED HERO

Marine Dakota Meyer was recognized with a Medal of Honor for saving 13 U.S. Marines and 23 Afghan soldiers. He made 5 heroic runs into enemy fire to rescue the soldiers. Meyer is the first living Marine to receive the award in nearly 4 decades.



A ROYAL AFFAIR

Prince William and Kate Middleton were married at Westminster Abbey. Millions around the world followed every detail of the day's events including Kate's lace wedding dress, designed by Sarah Burton.

HUNGER HITS THE BIG SCREEN

Megafans of Suzanne Collins' best-selling *The Hunger Games* book trilogy eagerly anticipated the release of *The Hunger Games* movie, starring Jennifer Lawrence as heroine Katniss, Josh Hutcherson as Peeta and Liam Hemsworth as Gale.



VICTORY OVER TERROR

After years of hiding, Al Qaeda leader Osama bin Laden, the mastermind behind the 9/11 terrorist attacks, was fatally wounded in an operation led by U.S. Navy military forces.



ARAB SPRING

Citizens of various nations across North Africa and the Middle East rallied against corrupt or oppressive leaders in a movement coined Arab Spring. The outcome for Libya was the overtaking and death of dictator Muammar Gaddafi. Nations such as Egypt, Syria and Yemen also set the stage for a political shift with revolutions of their own.



RACE FOR PRESIDENCY

The race for the Republican candidacy was in full swing for the November 2012 Presidential Election. The nominated candidate will compete against President Obama who seeks a second term.



LASTING IMPRESSION

Steve Jobs, the visionary behind the iPhone®, iPad®, iPod®, iMac® and iTunes®, passed away after years of battling cancer and just months after announcing his resignation from Apple®.



SOLDIERS LEAVE IRAQ

The last U.S. troops left Iraq which marked the end of a controversial war that cost nearly 4,500 American and 100,000 Iraqi lives.



FANTASTICAL FINALE

After a 12-year run, The Harry Potter book and film series came to a close. The final novel, Harry Potter and the Deathly Hallows, Part 2, was released in July, and 11 weeks later the government decided to allow the series to be shown in theaters.

NETFLIX BLUNDER

Netflix sparked controversy among members when it increased prices and separated video streaming from its by mail DVD service.

Members complained that they had to pay more for the same service. Netflix responded that it was necessary to raise prices to cover the cost of the new streaming service.

ANGRY BIRDS TAKE OFF

Angry Birds was the best-selling iPhone app of 2011, but it also made an appearance on toy shelves. The Angry Birds Knock on Wood game allows families to play a real life version of the game. Halloween costumes, clothing and plush toys also capitalized on the sensation.

HIKERS RELEASED

After more than 2 years, Iran released two American hikers who were charged with illegal entry into the country and spying.

TURNING A NEW LEAF

A team of MIT researchers developed an "artificial leaf" that could be used to soak up the sun's energy and store for later use. Leaves absorb, convert and store solar energy and this new man-made silicon leaf mimics those abilities. Given that the sun is our most renewable resource, scientists look to maximize it with new technologies like this.



LASER RAIN

A new method to create rain was researched by European scientists. By using lasers in the atmosphere, they were able to change moisture levels and create small water droplets. Although the drops weren't big enough to reach the ground, they may help promote natural rainfall.



YOUNG SCIENTISTS

Thirty middle school students gathered in Washington D.C. to showcase their scientific talent at the Broadcom MASTERS™ (Math, Applied Science, Technology, and Engineering for Rising Stars), a program of Society for Science & the Public. The finalists faced off in team challenges and shared individual research projects. First prize went to California's Daniel Feeny, 14, who proved that the force of waves doesn't affect the variety of plants and animals that live close to shore.



CREEPY CRAWLIES

The world's largest insect, a Giant Weta, was discovered in New Zealand, but has been around for a very long time and predates the dinosaurs. This particular insect weighed in at 2.5 ounces and measured over 7 inches in length, making it the biggest insect on record.

LIKE A DREAM

A study suggested that dreams can act as therapy for life's emotional events. When shown emotion-provoking pictures before sleep, the part of the brain that handles emotion "powered down" during the REM sleep stage. Also, individuals said they felt less emotionally charged when they awoke, which led researchers to believe they gained relief from their recent, painful memories.



AIR SURFING

The MagSurf brings dreams of levitation to life. University Paris Oiderot researchers built a skateboard-like platform that can float above a magnetic track with a person standing on it. The superconducting matter inside the skateboard is cooled by liquid nitrogen, which allows the board to hover above the magnetic track.



NICE ROCK

A new planet made of diamond crystals was discovered by a team of astronomers. The planet, which is 60,000 km in diameter, is 5 times larger than Earth and is part of the Milky Way.



In 1905, Albert Einstein was the first to claim that nothing traveled faster than the speed of light.

ONE FAST NEUTRINO

For over a century, it was believed that nothing traveled faster than the speed of light. That all may have changed when scientists detected a tiny particle called a neutrino traveling faster. The difference in speed was so slight that some scientists remained skeptical and continue to retest for accuracy.



POPULATION BOOM

The world's population reached 7 billion in 2011, growing at a faster rate than ever, due in part to longer lifespans.

NOBEL PRIZE WINNERS

Scientific advances were made in physics, chemistry and medicine. Topics such as the expansion of the universe, the structure of crystals and how the body's immune system fights infection earned scientists distinguished Nobel prizes this year.

SMART STAT

The introduction of the Nest Learning Thermostat delivered a new kind of "thinking" thermostat for home owners. Its design is compact and sleek, plus it learns from past behaviors to adjust temperature automatically. Over time, it could help people cut energy costs.

WARMING CLIMATE

The UN World Meteorological Organization announced that 2011 was shaping up to be the 10th warmest on record and that 13 of the past 15 years have also been among the warmest.



The WMO pointed to human activities as the cause of the continued global warming.

ANIMAL DISCOVERIES...



DOLPHINS SENSE ELECTRICITY

Biologists discovered that Guiana dolphins not only find food by listening to echo sounds, but by using dimples near their snouts to sense electric fields and locate their prey. Further research may be conducted to learn if other ocean creatures have the same ability.



NOCTURNAL FROGS

Scientists in India discovered 12 new frog species. The frogs were especially difficult to find because they only came out during the night.



TOUCHY TECHNOLOGY

Researchers at Microsoft and Carnegie Mellon University teamed up to create *OmniTouch*, a camera and projector device that tracks motion and allows any surface to become a touch screen. The new technology can be projected almost anywhere, such as on a wall, an arm or a sheet of paper.

eBOOKS ON LOAN

More than 11,000 libraries around the country allowed patrons to borrow eBooks to read on their Kindle devices or app.

Students at China's Zhejiang University created *Wu and Kong*, robots capable of playing table tennis. Cameras allow the robots to "see" and respond to the ball's location with their next hit. They can play against each other or even with humans.

TALK TO THE PHONE

Voice activation technology, made popular with the release of Apple's iPhone 4s, provides a feature named Siri that allows users to literally talk to their phones and get responses to questions.

INDY 500 WINNER REMEMBERED

Dan Wheldon prevailed with a 1st place finish in the 2011 Indianapolis 500. Sadly, only a few months later, Wheldon lost his life in a racing accident during the Las Vegas Indy 500.

LYNX PROWL THROUGH ATLANTA

For the first time in franchise history, the Minnesota Lynx claimed the WNBA championship title. With their eye on the prize, the Lynx won their last 6 games in the post season, including a victory clinching 3 game sweep against Atlanta.



TENNIS CHAMPS

Australian tennis player Samantha Stosur won the U.S. Open, her first major title, by beating 13-time Grand Slam Champion Serena Williams in 2 sets. Novak Djokovic also had quite a year—he beat Rafael Nadal in the U.S. Open and became the 6th man to win 3 Grand Slam titles in one year.

WOMEN OF THE WORLD
