

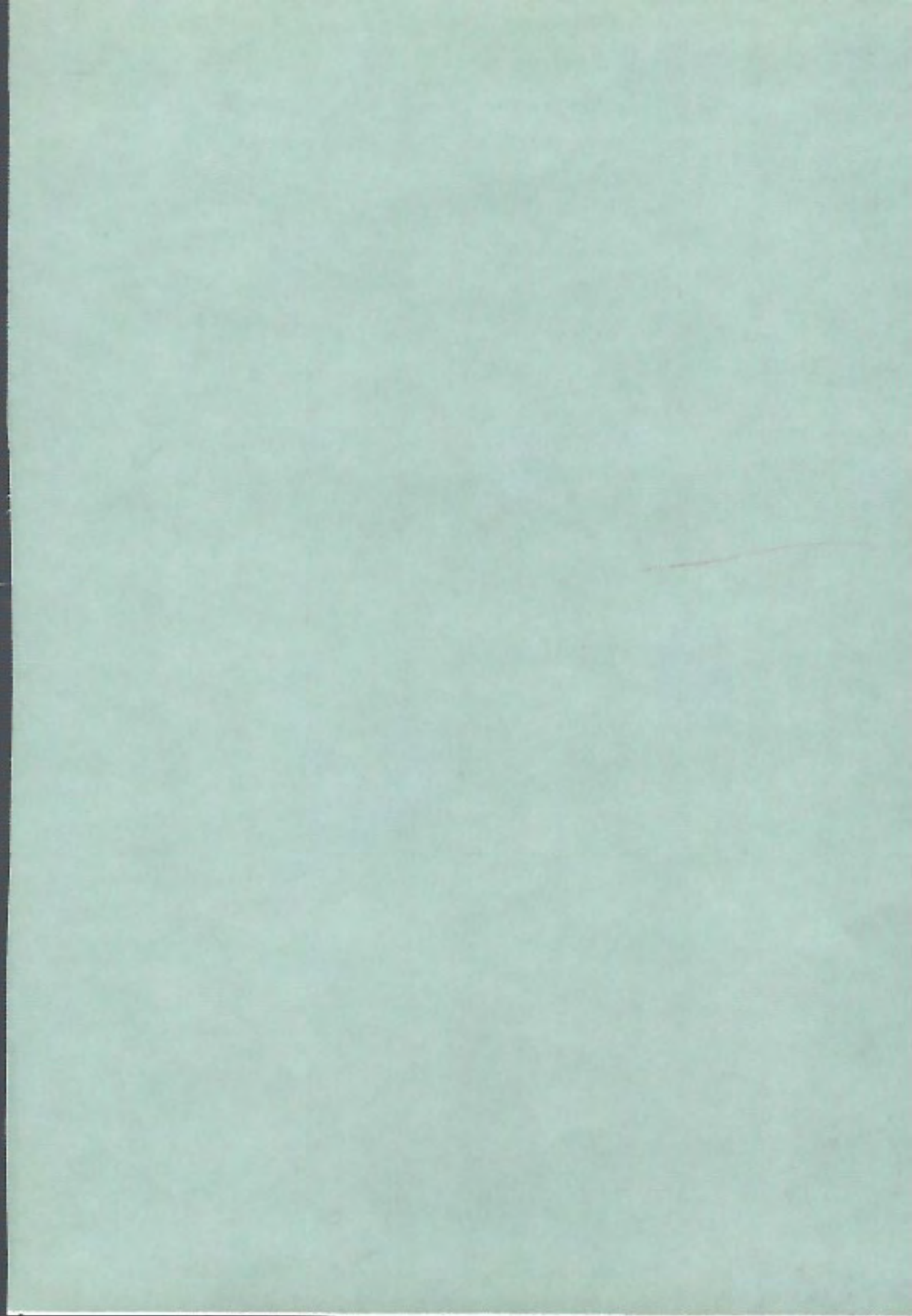

## THE MYSTERY LADY . . .

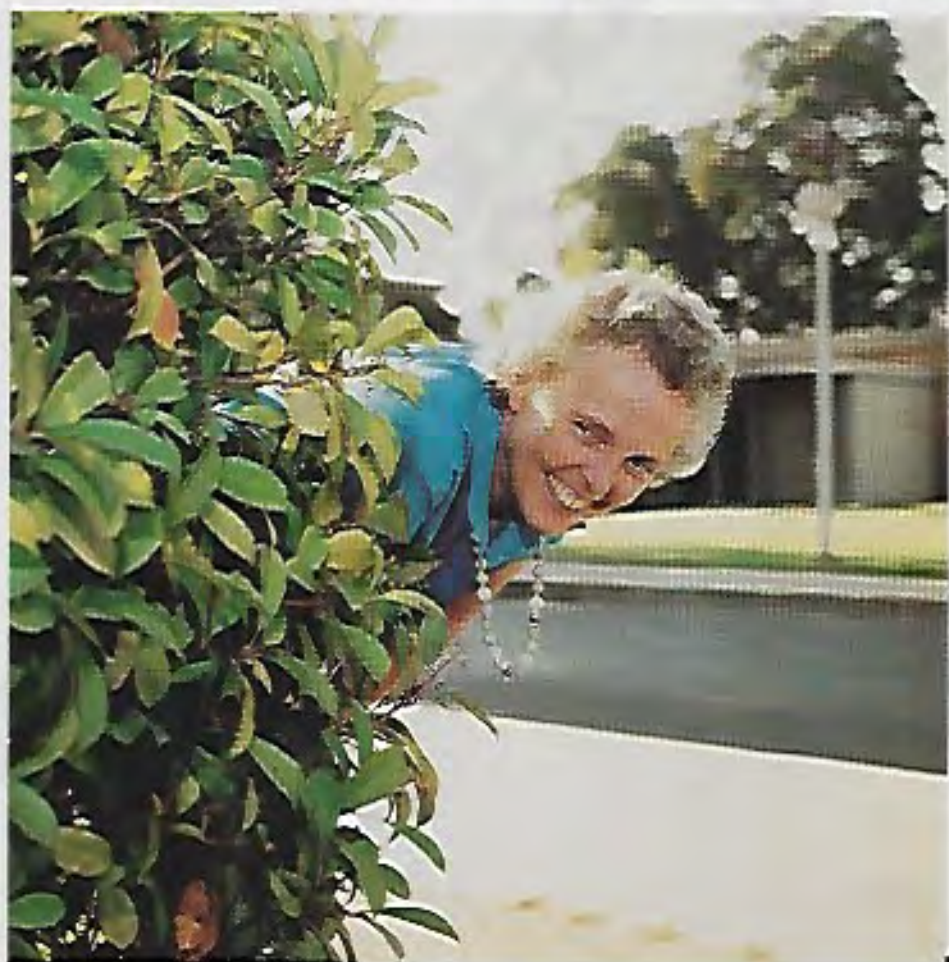

There were games, food, and live entertainment, which added up to a good time for all!

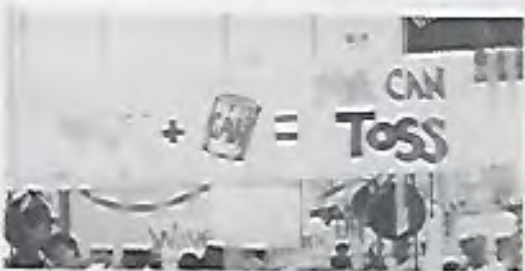
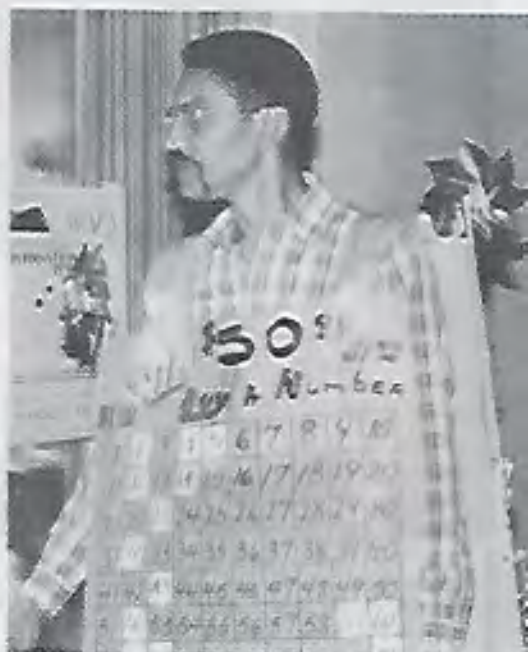

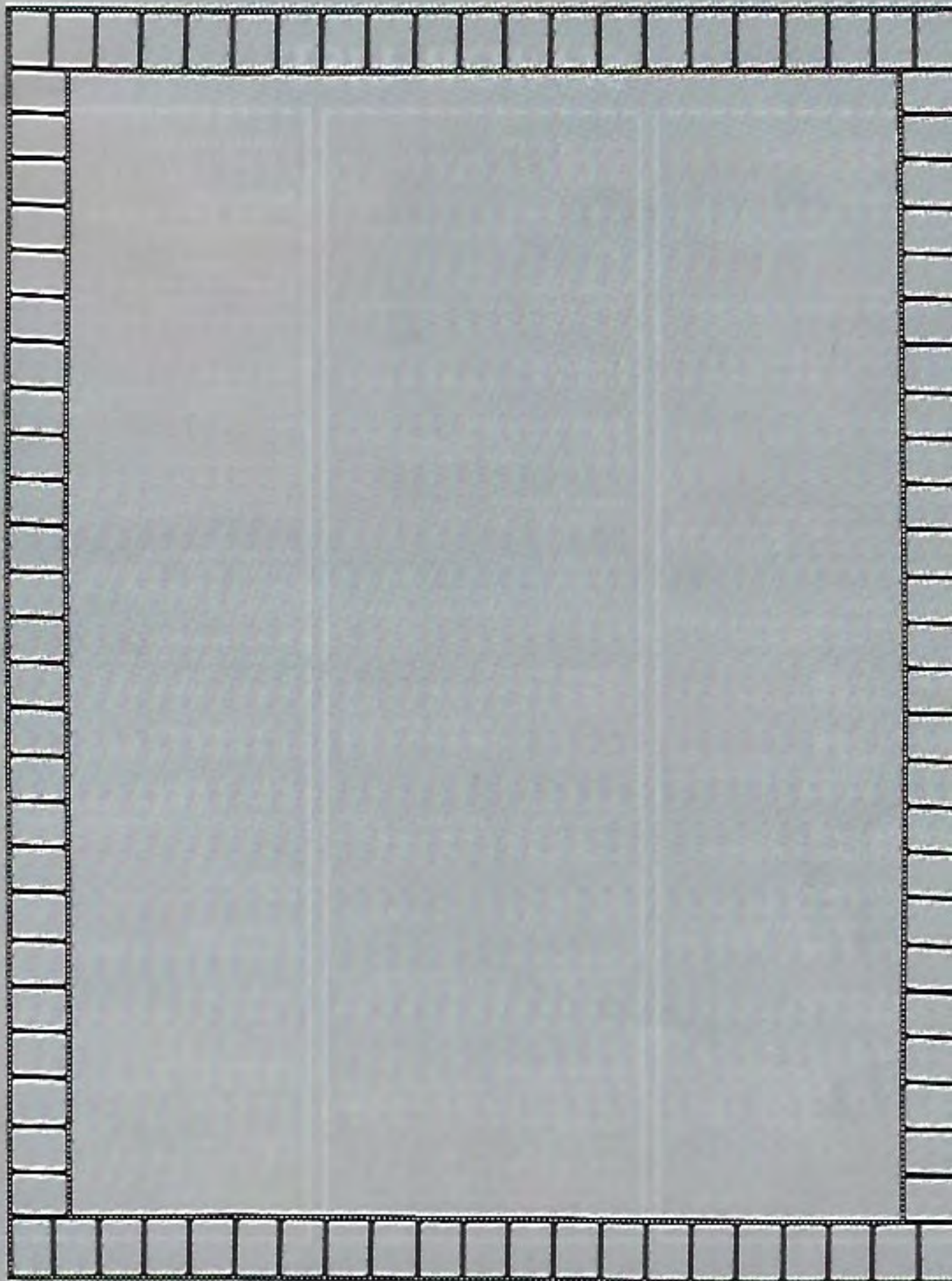
