A Note on the *Missa Lasann* (Lasallian Anniversary Mass)

The Brothers of the Christian Schools formed the District of San Francisco New Orleans in 2014. Today's celebration in San Francisco is the second of two events commemorating three significant anniversaries this school year. The first celebration took place in New Orleans, in July 2018. Br. Martin Yribarren composed a congregational mass setting for the liturgies held in the respective Cathedrals.

The three anniversaries suggested three musical themes: 100 years of the Brothers' continuous presence in Louisiana is represented by the jazz inflections found in the *Lamb of God*; 150 years of the Brothers in California inspired the Gregorian chant-like theme of the *Kyrie*; and 300 years since the entry into eternal life of the Institute's Founder, St. John Baptist de La Salle, led to borrowings from "Honneur à toi," a hymn praising the Founder, as found in the *Holy*. The *Gloria* uses all three themes.
