# CBS golfers shooting for first section title

Everything fell into place Monday for Christian Brothers boys golf coach Kirk Purdy in the Sierra Valley Conference tournament.

Led by Cameron and Grant Rappleye, who shot a 3-under-par 69 and 1-under 71, respectively, the Falcons scored an amazing 364 for 18 holes at Sierra View Country Club in Roseville.

The Falcons beat league rival Oak Ridge by nine strokes, won the conference title for the second consecutive season and salvaged some of the pain of losing twice to the Trojans in nine-hole league dual matches.

"The conditions were perfect," Purdy said. "It was warm and calm. The course was in great shape. We had a good day, and we're starting to peak."

The Rappleyes may be the best area brother combination since CBS' Kevin and David Sutherland in the early 1980s. The juniors have been the team's top golfers since they were freshmen. But the Falcons aren't just about two talented players.

Junior Scott Hackney also is a three-year starter, and sophomores Conner Penfold and Jordan Swanson and senior Matt Jimenez have been consistent performers.

Jimenez shot a 74 Monday, and Penfold and Hackney 75s. Most coaches would have loved to have Swanson's "throw-out" score of 76.

With that kind of depth, this could be a breakthrough year for the Falcons.

They compiled a 12-2 dual-meet record, including two wins over Jesuit and won the prestigious Joe Barry Masters Tournament on March 24 at Ancil Hoffman, beating runner-up Los Altos by nine strokes. The Falcons also won a tournament in Redding and finished second by two strokes to Lodi in the St. Mary's tournament in Stockton.

Sull, CBS has never won a section golf championship. The Falcons will have a chance to do that Monday in the Sac-Joquim Section Division II finals at Sunset Whitney Country Club in Rocklin. This is the first year of a new format in which the section will crown seven divisional champions. In past years, schools either competed for a large school (Division I) or small-school (Division II) title after competing in subsection tournaments.

The subsections no longer exist. Instead, the top three teams from the D-I (North and South) and D-II section finals will compete in the inaugural Masters Tournament on May 14 at Sierra View. D-III will send two teams and D-IV through D-VI one each.

"It will give more schools a chance to win a section banner," Purdy said.

But winning the section isn't a given for Christian Brothers. Even advancing to the Masters Tournament could be a challenge because Granite Bay and Rocklin - last season's D-I section champion and runner-up, respectively - are entered with Oak Ridge in Monday's

18-hole tournament.

**Kosinski eyes record** - Even before Saturday's Sacramento Meet of Champions, Alex Kosinski had zoned in on the National Federation High School 1,600-meter record, which she set with a time of 4 minutes, 38.15 seconds.

But John Mansoor, an Oak Ridge assistant who helps train Kosinski, revealed a few weeks ago that the Oregon-bound senior also has within her sights high school's biggest distance prize - Polly Plumer's all-time American prep mile mark of 4:35.24 set in 1982 during a college meet that isn't recognized in the high school record book.

"There is no doubt that she's capable of running in the mid-30s," Mansoor said. "She won't say it ... but with her workouts and watching her run, it's possible."

# Depth keeps Rocklin golf team rolling along

Rocklin High School coach Dave Stewart figured his team was in big trouble when he took the turn after nine holes of the Sac-Joaquin Section Division II boys golf tournament May 7 at the

Stewart was told one of his top golfers, four-year varsity starter Bryan Trimble, was 5 over par after three holes. He also was monitoring a foursome in which standout Grant Rappleye of rival Christian Brothers was playing.

"I hear that, and I'm watching the Rappleye kid shooting even par," Stewart said. "I didn't have high hopes."

Stewart's worries turned out to be unfounded. The Thunder shot an impressive 368 to beat Christian Brothers by two strokes and Oak Ridge by seven.

Rocklin did it even though arguably its two top golfers, Trimble and sophomore Skylar Mills, shot rounds of 78 and 76, respectively. But junior Nick Brown shot a 2-under 70 - the best 18 holes of his prep career - and junior Kyle Chatelain and German exchange student Julian Ueberschaar had 72s.

But Stewart credited Trimble

for keeping a level head, saying the 78 wasn't too bad considering the poor start.

"He triple-bogeyed the first hole," Stewart said. "If he mails it in and doesn't grind it out, it's a different story."

As it turned out, every shot proved critical.

Under the section's new post-season format, only three D-II teams - Rocklin, Christian Brothers and Oak Ridge - advanced to today's Masters Tournament at Sierra View in Roseville.

Defending Division I section champion Granite Bay shot a 382 and Woodcreek a school-record 383, and neither qualified. The Grizzlies' nonqualifying score was better than the champions of the six other section tournaments.

Nine golfers shot par or better, led by Richard Decker of Roseville's 3-under 69. He qualified for today's tournament as an individual, as did Union Mine's Tim Honeycutt and Granite Bay's Eric McIntosh.

"I think, based on the scores, Division II is arguably the best, so it's too bad that there were a lot of good golfers who didn't get to advance," Stewart said.

Rocklin finished three strokes behind Granite Bay in placing second in last year's D-I sectional. But to take the Masters banner to-

day, Rocklin again must finish ahead of Christian Brothers, which shot 364 at Sierra View two weeks ago in winning the Sierra Valley Conference championship.

"That number is unbelievable," Stewart said. "It's got to be one of the best in the state. It's going to be two hours of not breathing because golf is probably the one sport where the coach has the least impact."

**Upon further review** - San Juan boys golf coach Doug Fannin did some more digging, and with a big assist from school textbook clerk Carol Baker, learned the Spartans' recent Golden Empire League boys championship wasn't the school's first league title.

According to yearbook reports, San Juan won the Capital Valley Conference's first three golf championships from 1962 to '64 and, at one point, had a 58 dual-match win streak.

Tom Sekul, who started the San Juan boys golf program in 1957, said that sounds about right.

"That's so long ago I wasn't sure about the league titles," Sekul said. "But we had some great players, and we won a lot of matches."

# Davis' Raber, Christian Brothers team win

Davis High School junior Tyler Raber and Turlock sophomore Sam Smith shot 6-under-par 66s to share individual honors, and Christian Brothers earned the team championship in the Sac-Joaquin Section high school boys Masters golf tournament Monday at Sierra View Country Club in Roseville.

The 66s by Raber and Smith were the lowest scores in the history of the tournament, which began in 1944 under its former name, the section tournament.

Raber, who qualified with a 1-under 71 in the Division I North tournament at Wildhorse Golf Course in Davis last Monday, carded seven birdies and one bogey on the 6,481-yard Sierra View course.

Six of Raber's birdies came on putts inside 9 feet. His second shot on the 392-yard, par-4 seventh hole landed a foot and a half from the pin, and his tee shot on

the 183-yard par-3 eighth hole settled two feet from the pin. He also had a chip-in birdie on the 311-yard 14th hole.

"This exceeded my greatest expectations," said Raber, who won the Junior State Fair Championship at Haggis Oaks last summer. "I just wanted to break 70 and move on to the NorCals. I'm not totally blown away by this round, but I am surprised."

Smith, who fired a 66 in the Division I South tournament last Monday at Rancho Del Rey Golf Club in Atwater to earn his spot, played an error-free round, collecting six birdies and the rest pars.

Christian Brothers had a 373 score, followed by Colfax with 376, Rocklin with 380, Lodi with 382, and Casa Roble with 384.

Christian Brothers, Colfax and Rocklin advanced to the Northern California regionals at Brookside Country Club in Stockton

next Monday.

Six players broke par, and each qualified for the NorCals with his team or as an individual. Joining Raber and Smith as individuals were defending champion Tim Honeycutt of Union Mine and Justin Estrada of Yuba City.

Honeycutt, who won the American Junior Golf Association Medicius Preseason Invitational at Rancho Mirage Country Club in Palm Springs with a 5-under 139 Sunday, shot a 3-under 69. Estrada had a 1-under 71.

All six Christian Brothers players shot in the 70s, led by Cameron Rappleye with a 71. Scott Hackney shot a 73, Jordan Swanson a 75, Conner Penfold a 76, Matt Jimenez a 78 and Grant Rappleye a 79. Grant Rappleye's score was not used in the play-six, count-five scores format.

The championship for CBS, which finished second by two strokes to Rocklin in the Division I tournament at Sunset Whitney Country Club in Rocklin last Monday,

is the first in school history. Of the Falcons' six players, only Jimenez is a senior.

"This is beyond my wildest dreams," Christian Brothers coach Kirk Purdy said. "If anything, I thought we'd use this experience in pointing toward next year. These guys are fantastic golfers. They're always on the golf course. Just to show you how good they really are, we had to throw out our best player's score."

Colfax, winner of the D-IV tournament at the Yolo Fliers Club in Woodland last Monday, proved it could hang with the big boys from D-I and D-II.

"It's not so much a Cinderella story finishing second," said senior Patrick Bauer, who had a 69. "We're not a bunch of small-school kids who lucked out and shot a good round. The guys on this team can play golf."
