It was more of the same Tuesday when Granite Bay won the Sac-Joaquin Section Division II tournament at Rancho Murieta by four strokes over its Sierra Foothill League rival.

The schools are two of 14 advancing to Masters next week from section tournaments Monday and Tuesday. They will be favored to be among the three that advance to the Northern California championships.

"It's always a battle and the scores are always low" when the two teams meet, said Granite Bay coach **Terry Stafford**.

Sacramento State-bound **Alex Gibbs** shot a 75 and **Brandon Baumgarten** a 76 from the championship tees at Murieta's South course to pace Granite Bay. Gibbs is the only senior in the top eight on a deep Grizzlies team that figures to be tough for years.

Austin Smotherman shot a 72 and **Justin Raskin** a 76 on a Del Oro team strong at the top of its lineup.

"If one guy hiccups, the other team is going to take advantage," said Del Oro coach **Hal Steinback**. "That's the way it's been going for two years."

Last year, Del Oro won the league title, Granite Bay won the section, Del Oro won the Masters and Granite Bay was better at the NorCals.

This year, Granite Bay won the first league tournament by one shot and Del Oro the second league tournament by three shots. The schools split their head-to-head matches before tying at the top of last week's Cal Invitational at Plumas Pines in Graeagle. (Granite Bay was declared the winner via a scorecard tiebreaker.)

Smotherman, headed to SMU in the fall, isn't looking past next week.

"There's some tension there already," he said. "The players know each other pretty well, and they know that every shot counts."

Granite Bay wins Masters title

GRIZZLIES' SCORE IS ONE OF BEST EVER IN SECTION CHAMPIONSHIP

STOCKTON — Brandon Baumgarten was 3 over par after four holes in Monday's Sac-Joaquin Section Masters boys golf championships at the Reserve at Spinos Park after going double bogey, bogey, bogey.

Bryan Wise was 2 over four holes into his round after the shotgun start.

It was early, but Granite Bay's chances of advancing in the 2012 postseason were headed in the direction of a recent Tiger Woods tee shot — sideways — with its Nos. 2 and 3 players struggling.

"I was a little frustrated," Baumgarten said.

Since Granite Bay's six golfers were in different groups throughout the course and unaware of how each was faring, there was no collective panic. Good thing, because Baumgarten and Wise, baby-faced juniors poised beyond their

years, rallied impressively over their final 14 holes to post 1-under 71s and lead the Grizzlies to the Masters title.

Granite Bay posted a team score of 3-over 363 to beat Christian Brothers (367) and Del Oro (372). The three teams advance to next Monday's Northern California Regional championships at Butte Creek in Chico.

Jesuit (376) finished fourth.

Granite Bay's team total was the lowest in Masters (which began in 2007) history and second-lowest in section championship history.

"We have the potential to get better," Wise said.

Alex Gibbs and Chuck Pedrone shot 73s, while Jeff Inouye-Wong shot a 75 for Granite Bay, which won the Division II section title last week.

Christian Brothers, 13 shots behind Granite Bay last week and largely in the wake of the area's top teams this season, was led by Andrej Bevins and Kit Carson, each with 67s. Hunter Rappleye shot a 74 for the Falcons.

"We have not had our top three play well on the same day all season — until today," said Christian Brothers coach

Kirk Purdy. "Other teams might be surprised (by what we accomplished today), but I'm not."

Del Oro, which has been duking it out with Granite Bay in the Sierra Foothill League all season, secured the final Nor-Cal berth on the strength of a Section/Masters record (dating to 1944) 65 from Austin Smotherman. Justin Raskin shot a 72 for the Eagles.

Smotherman, a senior headed to SMU, had eight birdies and one bogey — a three-putt that came after three straight birdies.

Granite Bay and Del Oro represented the Sac-Joaquin Section at last year's Nor-Cals but failed to advance to state.

McClatchy's Julian Woodfork shot a 67 to lead four individuals advancing to Nor-Cals. On a largely windless day, Ponderosa's Corey Pereira, Armijo's Aaron Beverly and Oakdale's Ryan Jones shot 70s.

Woodfork, a late-blooming senior who hasn't decided on a college, had a double-eagle 2 on the par-5 16th hole after sinking a 5-iron from 200 yards.

Granite Bay won't fold with stakes high against rival

You don't want to play golf - or cards - for money against members of the Granite Bay High School boys golf team.

When the chips are down, they don't blink.

After spending three hours Sunday night playing poker in their Chico motel room, the Grizzlies on Monday showed they weren't bluffing by fending off rival Del Oro to qualify for the state golf championship.

Granite Bay led Del Oro by one stroke with **Alex Gibbs**, the Grizzlies' No. 1 player, the only member of either team still on the course and with two holes to play. Del Oro held the tiebreaker edge, so there was no margin for error.

Gibbs finished birdie-birdie for a round of 2-under-par 70 in the Northern California Regional at Butte Creek, and Granite Bay was headed to its first state championship.

Granite Bay and Del Oro have traded punches for two years, so the tight finish wasn't unexpected.

"It came down to the last guy," Granite Bay coach **Terry Stafford** said. "It was another very stressful ending."

Granite Bay grabbed the NorCal's third and final qualifying berth behind Foothill-Pleasanton and Robert Louis Stevenson. The state tournament is June 6 in San Gabriel.

"You've got to hand it to Granite Bay. They've been our nemesis all year," Del Oro coach **Hal Steinback** said. "We played well under the circumstances. That's golf."

Brandon Baumgarten (72), **Jeff Inouye-Wong** (74), **Bryan Wise** (77), **Chuck Pedone** (80) and **Zack Kwan** (82) were Granite Bay's scorers. Even though the Grizzlies finished eight shots behind Foothill and seven behind Stevenson, Stafford conceded nothing regarding the state competition.

"We had two guys who shot six or seven strokes higher than they normally shoot," he said. "We haven't maximized by any means."

Del Oro will be represented in San Gabriel by individual qualifiers **Austin Smotherman** and **Justin Rankin**. Christian Brothers' **Andrej Bevins** and Ponderosa's **Corey Pereira** also qualified as individuals.

Granite Bay, Smotherman pull off rare feat

GRIZZLIES WIN TEAM TITLE IN SURPRISE; DEL ORO SENIOR IS INDIVIDUAL CHAMP

The Granite Bay High School boys golf team and Del Oro's Austin Smotherman did something Wednesday that's been done only once — and that was three decades ago.

They brought team and individual state golf titles to Sacramento.

Granite Bay, third in the Northern

California championship two weeks ago, pulled a major upset by beating Foothill-Pleasanton by two shots at San Gabriel Country Club. Robert Louis Stevenson of Pebble Beach was third — the first time NorCal schools swept the top three spots in the six-team field.

Smotherman shot a 4-under-par 67 to beat Beau Hossler Jr. of Santa Margarita by one shot.

The Grizzlies weren't spectacular — they didn't have a player in the top eight — but they were solid up and down their lineup. Freshman Jeffrey Inouye-Wong shot a 72 to lead Granite Bay. Junior Brandon Baumgarten (78), junior Chuck Pedrone (74), se-

Stafford said his players used the result as a challenge to get better.

No Granite Bay player has been better recently than Inouye-Wong.

"Every score of his has been better than the last for about a month," Stafford said.

Del Campo won the state title in 1977 during a six-year span from 1976 to 1981 when one team from the south and north played off. Granite Bay's win is the first for the Sacramento area since the six-team format was introduced in 2004.

Smotherman, fourth in the state tournament last year as a junior, made five birdies and one bogey. After getting word that his bogey on

his 16th hole (No. 7 since he started on the back nine) dropped him a shot behind, he responded by sticking his approach on the next hole within 18 inches.

"That shot won me the tournament," Smotherman said. His resulting birdie closed the deal.

Ponderosa junior Corey Pereira (71) tied for sixth, while Christian Brothers junior Andrej Bevins and Del Oro junior Justin Raskin shot 75 to tie for 26th.

Murray Stoltz of Jesuit won the individual state title in 1979.

High school pair threaten to win at Ancil Hoffman

No high school golfer has won the Memorial Amateur in its 14 years. The caliber of competition from college and veteran players has been too tough at one of the area's most prestigious amateur events.

Or, maybe, the right high school player hasn't come along.

Austin Smotherman and Andrej Bevins are poised to end the streak in today's final round at Ancil Hoffman. With defending champion John Catlin in the lead, the high school kids had better bring their "A" game.

Catlin shot a tournament-best 4-under-par 66 Sunday for a 36-hole total of 6-under 134. He leads Smotherman (68) by two shots, Bevins (69) by three and Niall Platt (70) by four. The four are the only players under par.

Catlin, 21, would rather be in Southern California preparing for this week's NCAA Division I Men's Golf Championship - his New Mexico team missed qualifying by a shot.

The senior-to-be, who was ranked as high as 13th in the country this season, is using the near miss as competitive fuel. He chipped in twice - on No. 9 (for birdie) and No. 18

(for par) in his five-birdie, one-bogey round.

"Everything was just kind of going my way today," Catlin said.

Smotherman, 18, a Del Oro High School senior, and Bevins, 17, a Christian Brothers junior, are trying to accomplish what Catlin didn't while at Jesuit. Don't be fooled by their fuzzy faces - both are individual qualifiers for next week's state high school championship and have the game. But they face a tall order in overtaking Catlin and holding off Platt, 21, all-Big East Conference this season as a Notre Dame sophomore.

Smotherman, an SMU signee, figures to be the crowd favorite - Sunday's 15-strong contingent of family and friends is expected to swell. For the second day in a row, he hit 14 greens in regulation and had 29 putts, his mother, Marla, reported.

If he had to pick, Smotherman said, he would rather win the state high school tournament than the Memorial, being a senior, but admitted, "I would prefer to win both."

Bevins, who has verbally committed to New Mexico, favored winning the Memorial because the competition is stiffer, he said. Either way,

he'd like his first name to be spelled correctly - it was Andrey on the Ancil scoreboard.

"People butcher it a lot," he said.

He gets the spelling from his Croatian heritage but little in the way of golf since there are only three courses in Croatia. Bevins likes Ancil Hoffman, though. He shot a 65 to win the Sacramento County Junior last year, and that was before improved fitness and new equipment have given him 30 more yards off the tee in the past three months.

The added distance with other clubs has helped his course management, he said. He's more likely to keep the driver in the bag and rely on a 240-yard "punch" 3-iron.

"It's a consistent weapon for me," he said of the 3-iron.

Sebastian Valquez, the top-ranked amateur in Mexico, was in the thick of things until a four-putt triple bogey on No. 18 dropped him into a tie for fifth, six shots off the pace.

The leaders tee off at 10 a.m. today.

Catlin's short game stands tall in repeat win

Experience trumped youth Monday in the Memorial Amateur.

Crushed it, actually.

Defending champion John Catlin put on a short-game clinic that had the Abell Hoffman crowd oohing and his teenage competitors reeling en route to a final-round 2-under-par 68 and a five-shot victory.

Catlin's three-round total of 8-under 202 was the lowest in the 15 years of the event.

"This is kind of getting old hat," said John Roehle, the tournament founder, while handing Catlin the trophy for the second year in a row.

The repeat win makes it time to start talking about Catlin, 21, a Carmichael resident and Jesuit High School graduate, as one of the best local amateurs ever. The New Mexico junior won the Ping Arizona Intercollegiate in January for his first college win and the past two Northern California Golf Association March Play Championships, arguably the most prestigious regional amateur title.

His college ranking reached a high of No. 13 this past season.

"It's all from experience," Catlin said. "All great players have experience to draw on."

Andrej Bervin, a Christian Brothers junior, fought back from a double bogey on No. 10 with three back-nine birdies to close with a 70 to finish second. It was an impressive finish for the 17-year-old, who overcame a partial shank on the first tee Sunday when a squirrel darted in front of his ball, causing him to flinch. He still made a par.

"I'm proud of how I stuck in there," Bervin said. "It shows I can stick in there against the best."

Austin Smotherman, a Del Oro senior who started the final round in second place two shots behind Catlin, four-putted Nos. 5 and 9 in a round of 75 to fall into a tie for fifth.

"I couldn't see the line, and I couldn't hit the line," Smotherman said of his struggle on the greens. "It was almost as if I was putting blind."

Bervin and Smotherman are off to the state high school championships next week.

Catlin will continue to work on his short game - he does so every day, he said. Those watching Monday would have no reason to doubt him.

With Smotherman within three shots of his lead and facing a 12-foot birdie putt on No. 8, Catlin was short and sank his chip shot for a birdie - it was his third chip-in in two days. Smotherman missed his putt.

On No. 9, with Smotherman on the back edge of the green on the 290-yard par-5, Catlin missed the green left and, with the pin tight to the left, had little green to work with. Facing an almost certain bogey, Catlin hit a feathery pitch that grazed the hole before stopping a foot away.

The crowd erupted. Smotherman took four putts, and the winner was all but determined. For good measure, Catlin got up-and-down for pars from short of the green on Nos. 16 and 17, and from a bunker on No. 18. "Having a good short game means

Kids relish big-time experience

Telling First Tee of Greater Sacramento members to pick one highlight from their experience at the Champions Tour First Tee Open last week was like telling them they get to play one hole at Pebble Beach.

Kelsey Ulep and **Craig Stadler** teamed to finish fifth, giving TFTGS members three of the top five places. Despite Stadler's dour appearance, Ulep said "the Walrus" helped her keep a positive attitude.

Ulep, 16, from Rocklin, was taken most, though, by a fellow First Tee member, **Jake Olson**, 15, of Huntington Beach, who plays despite fully losing his sight two years ago, spoke at one of the pre-tournament gatherings - and to Ulep.
