NU senior tames the wind

Erik Flores' 72 is good for first; Yuba City takes the team title.

STOCKTON - Nevada Union High School senior Erik Flores shot a par 72 to win medalist honors, and Yuba City won the school's first Sac-Joaquin Section golf title at the Division I Championships at The Reserve at Spanos Park on Monday.

Playing in winds of 25 to 30 mph on the 6,550-yard course, the UCLA-bound Flores had five birdies, three bogeys and one double bogey.

"My goal was to play the course safely, shoot even-par and move on to NorCals," said Flores, who wasn't totally happy with his round, even though he accomplished his intention.

"I stayed patient and kept a good head on my shoulders," Flores said. "But I did leave an awful lot of shots out there on the course."

Flores moves on to the Northern California Championships on Monday at Elk Grove's Valley Hi Country Club, where he posted a 69 at the U.S. Amateur qualifying last year.

He has been the hottest player in the Sacramento area of late.

Flores placed second at the California State Fair Amateur last September, including a second-round, record-tying 64 on the Alister MacKenzie course at Haggitt Oaks. Last week, the All-

Metro Conference selection fired a 4-under 67 at The Ridge in Auburn to win the Central Sub-section.

Flores became the first Nevada Union player to win the section individual title outright. In 1995, the Miners' Matt Larson tied with Lincoln of Stockton's Andy Barnes with 71s at Lake Wildwood Country Club in Grass Valley.

Also advancing to the NorCals as individuals were Armijo's Victor Simionas (74), Oak Ridge's Allen Garner (75) and Casa Roble's Rob Budenbender (75).

Under adverse weather, Yuba City shot a quality 391 and was the only team to have four players break 80 - Nick Podesta (74), Casey Murphy (75), Kyle Moss (76) and Nic Durst (78).

"We've been playing in the wind all season," Yuba City coach Kent Myers said. "These guys are grinders and such good ball strikers. They don't let anything bother them."

Podesta, the senior anchor of the team, was pleased with his performance, particularly after struggling not long ago.

"I've been working on my game, and I'm coming on again," the left-hander said. "I kind of lost it there for a while. But I'd rather play badly all year and come on strong when it counts."

Podesta said the addition of transfer Casey Murphy made the Honkers a championship team. Murphy came to Yuba City from Lakeland High in Rathdrum, Idaho, and became the Metro Conference Player of the Year.

"Casey has meant so much to this team," Podesta said. "He's confident. It's a good feeling to know he's going to shoot around par every time out."

Myers said Murphy just fell into his lap.

"I didn't even know he existed until his dad called me in December and asked if he could come out," Myers said. "I told his dad sign-ups were in February. Boy, did I luck out. Talk about catching a break."

The section team title for Yuba City ends a 20-year sports drought. The last time the Honkers won a section title of any kind was the girls gymnastics team in the 1985-86 season. Monday's title was the school's first for boys athletics.

Second-place Granite Bay, behind Ryan Hallisey (76), Peter Gibbs (77) and Jack Allen (79), and third-place Lodi also advanced to the NorCals.

NU's Flores earns Bee's top honor

Sac-Joaquin Section champion Erik Flores is the 2005 Bee Player of the Year for high school boys golf.

Flores' brilliant career at Nevada Union is over, but he has plenty more to accomplish this summer before attending UCLA in the fall.

The 17-year-old, rated third nationally in the junior division by Golfweek/Titleist and second by Junior Golf Scoreboard, leaves Wednesday for Japan, where he is on a four-man United States team competing against 13 other countries in the Toyota Junior World Cup at Chukyo Golf Club in Tokyo.

The team members all will be college freshmen this fall and were selected by college coaches throughout the United States. The tournament is a 72-hole stroke-play event.

"It's a privilege and honor to represent our country," Flores said. "I'm pleased that the coaches who pick the collegiate All-Americans felt so highly of me."

In a tuneup for Tokyo two weeks ago, Flores shot a 6-under-par 210 to finish fifth at the American Junior Golf Association Thunderbird Invitational at Grayhawk Golf Club in Scottsdale, Ariz.

On the second day, Flores

fired a course-record 7-under-par 65, which included an eagle, seven birdies, eight pars and two bogeys.

The Thunderbird Invitational is just one of the top amateur tournaments Flores has played or plans to play this summer.

On March 26, Flores placed second behind Duke University's Nathan Smith at the Azalea Invitational in Charleston, S.C. He shot 67-68-67 for a 10-under-par 203.

Following Japan, Flores plans to play in the Porter Cup in Lewiston, N.Y., on June 20-23, the Sahalee Players Championship in Sammamish, Wash., on July 6-8,

the Pacific Coast Amateur in Bandon, Ore., on Aug. 2-5, the Scratch Players Amateur in Monterey on Aug. 7-10 and the State Fair Amateur at Haggan Oaks on Sept. 3-5.

Despite a loaded schedule, Flores is taking his success in stride.

"I've learned from playing so much tournament golf that you can't get too high or too low," he said. "You have to keep everything on an even keel and particularly not get all wound up about the bad times."

Coach of the Year honors for 2005 went to Yuba City's Kent Myers, who guided the Honkers to the Sac-Joaquin Section Division I title.
