Dear Falcon Parent:

The La Salle Club of Christian Brothers High School is a support group for the school. Its only function is to assist the development and support of the physical education and athletic programs of the school.

For this purpose, the La Salle Club depends upon an active membership in the conducting of its various activities during the academic year.

In past years, the La Salle Club has contributed monies for the coaches' salaries, has developed the athletic fields (\$64,000) and generally subsidized the physical education and athletic programs. This year, the Club has as its projects: 1) construction of a "modesty wall" outside the south locker room, 2) installation of ventilation fans in the two locker rooms, 3) clearing the field area around the track, 4) repairing the baseball bleachers, and 5) installation of physical fitness apparatus for PE classes.


This Friday, the La Salle Club is holding its first activity: the Father-Son Barbeque. This is a very social, informal gathering of all fathers and their sons. For those paying for La Salle Club membership (\$5), the meal is free for father and son; for those not taking out membership, the cost is \$1 per person. The evening begins at 6:30 p.m. with no-host social hour; the barbeque dinner is to be served at 8:00 p.m. Last year, this affair hosted over 300 people. All CBS father-son combinations are invited and urged to be in attendance.

This year, the La Salle Club has re-organized itself in the following fashion: 1st Monday of each month - Executive Board meeting, 8 p.m., in the cafeteria interested fathers welcome; 3rd Monday of each month - OPEN MEETING, 8 p.m., in the cafeteria - ALL WELCOME for a short meeting, movies of games, comments from coaches or talks by guest speakers and refreshments.

We hope to see all CBS fathers and sons at the La Salle Club B-B-Q this Friday, the night after the El Camino football game. For those who can't make that occasion, the OPEN MEETING will be Monday, September 18, with movies from that same El Camino game available along with commentary by the coaches.
