Dear Alumni, Parents and Friends:

As a former student-athlete, coach and in 19 years of working in high school education, I have to say that Holy Bowl 2008 was definitely the most heartrending athletic loss I have ever experienced. Leading 19-7 with less than five minutes to go, and victory in sight, the defeat feels all the more disheartening. On Sunday, the heartache settled in like fog. By Monday morning, I have to admit I did not feel much better, until I arrived at Christian Brothers.

Football great, Vince Lombardi, once mused "It's not whether you get knocked down, it's whether you get up." Seeing those young men who gave their all at Hughes Stadium at school Monday, and later, on the field preparing for the next week's game, I was so proud of their perseverance and dedication to getting back up.

The CB athletics department motto is Integrity, Honor and Excellence. Never have those values been more apparent than on that Monday at school. Through their disappointment, these young men soldiered on and demonstrated the character and resolve that will serve them well as they move on to college and become leaders in their chosen fields. Although the scoreboard may not have reflected it for our varsity players, each of these young men is a winner.

Many of life's important lessons, yes, even the difficult ones, can be learned on the playing field, in the gym, in the pool or on the track. Through the years, CB's rich athletic program has grown. Today, more than 600 student athletes participate on one or more of CB's 54 athletics teams throughout the school year.

For their benefit, and the benefit of generations of students to come, I'm thrilled to report that CB's new field house will be open in early November. The 18,000 square-foot facility includes two practice courts, a 4,000 square-foot weight room, a snack bar, and restroom facilities for guests at outdoor athletic contests. I am so grateful to the benefactors whose generosity made this addition possible and by doing so ensure that our facilities continue to meet the needs and gifts of our students.

If you haven't been to Christian Brothers for awhile, I invite you to stop by, and see firsthand, all of the great things happening on campus.

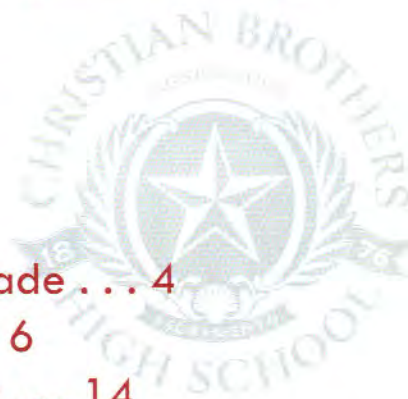

Class of '55 Takes Tuition Assistance to Heart

For years, members of the Class of '55 have talked about sponsoring a student at Christian Brothers. This year, Bob Granucci, Leo Granucci, Terry Dorsey, John Giordano, Dick Giusti and Jerry Williams decided to do something about it.

"We know that there are a number of students in our class who received a Christian Brothers education because of tuition assistance," explains Bob Granucci. "The Brothers no longer have the proceeds from the winery and the number of Brothers teaching in the school has gone down dramatically. We just feel strongly that in order for us to carry out the school's mission of providing an education to those who would otherwise not be able to afford it, we, as alumni, really need to step forward. It really comes down to us."

Granucci's group sent out a letter to their classmates asking that each member contribute to the fund. "It's not about how much they give, it's about showing that every member of our class supports the school," says Granucci. "In fact, we'd like to see every class take on this challenge. This is not something the school administration asked us to do, it is something that we really feel we need to do."

To date, they have collected more than \$8,000 in pledges and donations. "We are getting ready to send out a second letter and talk with the people we haven't heard from yet. We have a really great class," says Granucci. "We get together for lunch at least three times a year. The friends I made in high school continue to be my friends today. We want that experience for today's students."

When Ken Harris'54 learned about the Class of '55's efforts, he decided to take the same challenge to his class. "I heard about the idea from my brother-in-law, Bob, and I thought wow, that is not a bad idea," says Harris. So, I brought it to the class at one of our regular luncheons and Larry Lynch and Frank Silvey agreed to help me take it on. We are just at the very beginning stage of launching this and I am really hoping that it works, particularly since this coming May, the class of '54 will be celebrating the 55th anniversary of our graduation. This would be a really wonderful opportunity to show our appreciation to the school by reciprocating in providing tuition."

"From what I understand, Christian Brothers doesn't have a tremendous amount of alumni support," says Granucci. "I'd like to see every class get involved in sponsoring a student. Statistically, if every CB graduate just gave \$100 each year, I bet we could collectively fund tuition assistance for every student in need. We just all need to step forward and do our part."

Each day, approximately 50 students pass through the doors of Brother Edward Hall. Some are looking for help with college planning; some need assistance with course selection; some need guidance on personal issues and some just need a shoulder to cry on. Brother Edward Hall is the home of the Christian Brothers Guidance and Counseling Department and its importance to CB's success as a college preparatory high school is invaluable. The department, which includes Director Mary Hesser, CB's 2008 Lasallian Educator of the Year, four class-level counselors and the area's only high school wellness counselor, is a cohesive team of highly-educated professionals (each with a Master's degree or higher) dedicated to the academic and personal success of every student. Recent news stories highlighting California's status as having the worst student-to-counselor ratio, with an average of close to 1,000 students per counselor, left many at CB appreciating the school's strong commitment to this important service.

School counseling associations suggest that counselors should be assigned no more than 250 students in order to be effective. CB goes beyond that providing each class with a designated grade-level counselor who remains with the students for all four years in addition to Hesser, whose experience and expertise in the college admissions arena are formidable, and Wellness Counselor, Kent Morrison. Employing a four-year comprehensive model, counselors meet each fall with every student in their assigned class. Their efforts include assisting students with personal development and growth, college planning, course selection, academic support and academic support.

"Every time I've had a question about course selection or about college, Mr. Riley-Portal has made time to meet with me and helped me find an answer," says Matthew McCarthy '09.

"We have already met with Mary Hesser several times regarding my son Chris '09 and his goals for college," says CB parent Sally Sylva. She has been so fantastic about helping Chris identify the colleges that meet his goals in terms of what he would like to study and the type of environment that will help him be happy and successful in college."

"I am so proud of all of our counselors and admire their level of commitment and desire to serve," offers Hesser. "They are all really great educators and they recognize that each of our students is an individual and they treat each of them as such."

Guidance & Counseling Department Works for CB Students

The counselors closely monitor the academic progress of their students and are able to intervene early with students who are having difficulty with their grades. They work closely with the teachers, parents and students to develop a formal, written plan to help the students successfully complete their classes.

"Ms. Bell was such a great counselor. She really helped me when I had any questions or concerns," says Samuel Regalado '07. "Between Ms. Bell and Ms. Hesser, they really kept me on track and helped me so much

with the college admissions process. Without them, I know there is no way that

I would have gotten in to U.C. Berkeley." In addition to individual student meetings with counselors, the department offers nine college planning evenings for parents including one for each grade level (two for juniors and seniors), an NCAA night for college-bound athletes, a college financial aid planning session, an alumni panel and a class on parenting teens. Students and families are also encouraged to utilize a state-of-the-art, web-based college planning program and database called

Naviance Family Connection that provides information and search tools for college admission, detailed timelines, scholarship and much more. Hesser personally writes well over 100 letters of recommendation for seniors each year when they apply to private colleges and universities, each one unique to the individual. She spends a great deal of time working with students on helping them find the right "fit" for college and not just looking at the

famous “brand name” schools but finding universities that meet their individual needs and will provide them an enriching college experience.

“We also hope to get the students to think about some important, challenging issues about the purpose of life, their gifts, and how they might use their God-given potential in the world as they discern their true vocation,” explains Hesser. “As Lasallian educators, we truly see ourselves in the role of shepherds guiding our students, of being big brothers and big sisters to them, and encouraging them as they ‘Enter to learn and leave to serve.’”

To help with the many life challenges facing teens today, Kent Morrison utilizes a four-year curriculum that is geared toward the appropriate developmental level of the students. Topics include drug and alcohol education, information on eating disorders and issues such as depression. He is available to students needing additional support with serious concerns and, when necessary, helps with referrals to outside counseling and treatment.

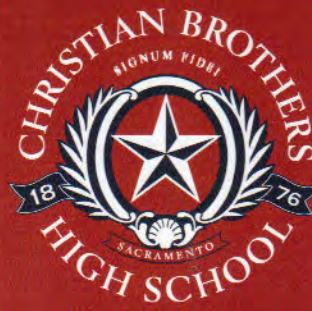
The counselors not only meet frequently with students individually and in classroom groups and with parents in office appointments and at parent information evenings, they also supervise PLAN, PSAT, and SAT/ACT testing, as well as administer over 300 specific needs such as processing grief or encouraging academic motivation, coordinate the Title I tutoring program on campus, and offer extensive advice at Pre-Reg time when students select their classes for the following year.

“We really do try to use every tool, every bell, and every whistle to help our students be successful in reaching their long-term goals,” says Hesser. “I always feel like there is more to learn and more to do.”

“I truly believe that Mary Hesser and our devoted guidance and counseling department are the best there is,” says CB President Lorcan Barnes. “They truly are leaders in the field whom other schools hold up as a model of excellence. Thanks to their seemingly tireless efforts, 99 percent of our graduates go directly into college.”

Mary Hesser Named Lasallian Educator of the Year

For the past 11 years, her warmth, willingness to listen and seemingly tireless dedication to the students of Christian Brothers High School have helped countless students and their parents navigate the often times rough waters of college admissions and high school life. For her efforts, her peers and school administrators selected Mary Hesser as the 2007-08 Lasallian Educator of the Year.

“Mrs. Hesser, you enjoy the respect and affection of our community because you embody the qualities of a model Catholic, Lasallian educator,” said President Lorcan Barnes to a visibly surprised Hesser.

Celebrates 132nd Graduating Class

Coadjutor Bishop Jaime Soto presided over the mass and encouraged the students to remain dedicated to the principles of goodness and service that are the hallmark of a CB education.

The evening's commencement ceremony celebrated the hard work and determination of the school's 132nd graduating class and the friendships and community of which each has been such an important part.

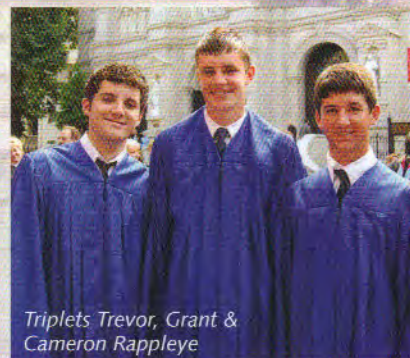
"I will not say that each and every one of us will change the course of history on a world-wide scale. But I can say without any equivocation that every person in this room will dramatically impact the lives of those they know, of those they call friend and family, and of those they love. This, I believe, is a universal potential that we all share," said class valedictorian, Alexander Hall.

Senior Class President, Allison Moser, served as master of ceremonies. Joseph Lipper provided the Salutatory Address. CB President, Lorcan Barnes, joyfully congratulated the group on reaching this important milestone and joining the illustrious ranks of the CBHS Alumni Association – now 260 members stronger.

Of the Class of 2008, 258 are enrolling in college and two are joining the military. They have been offered admission into all of the U.C. campuses, USC, Stanford, West Point, Georgetown University, NYU, Syracuse, Gonzaga, Pomona, Claremont, Santa Clara, University of Chicago, Columbia, Notre Dame, Duke, each of the C.S.U. campuses, and many other selective universities.

"These are some of the finest young men and women that Sacramento has to offer," says Barnes. "As Mr. Hall so eloquently put it, each will dramatically impact the lives of others."

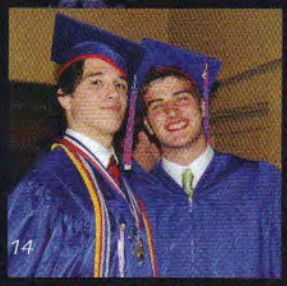

Education Takes to the Skies

Sophia Crawford's '08 love of flying was solidified after her parents were the lucky bidders on a flight over Napa at the CB auction. As the honorary co-pilot, Crawford knew immediately that flying was something she was meant to do.

"I figured that once I graduated from college and had a lot of money, I would learn to fly," explains Crawford. "I remember telling Mrs. Hesser during one of our college planning meetings that I wanted to pursue a career in aeronautical engineering and learn to fly some day. But, I really didn't think much about it after that. It was just something that I would do later in my life."

As fate would have it, the opportunity came much sooner than expected. In the summer prior to Crawford's senior year, John Didier, the father of CB alumnus, C.J. Didier '86, contacted the school wanting to provide an aviation scholarship to a motivated student who had the desire to learn to fly. Hesser immediately thought of Crawford and the "wings" were set in motion.

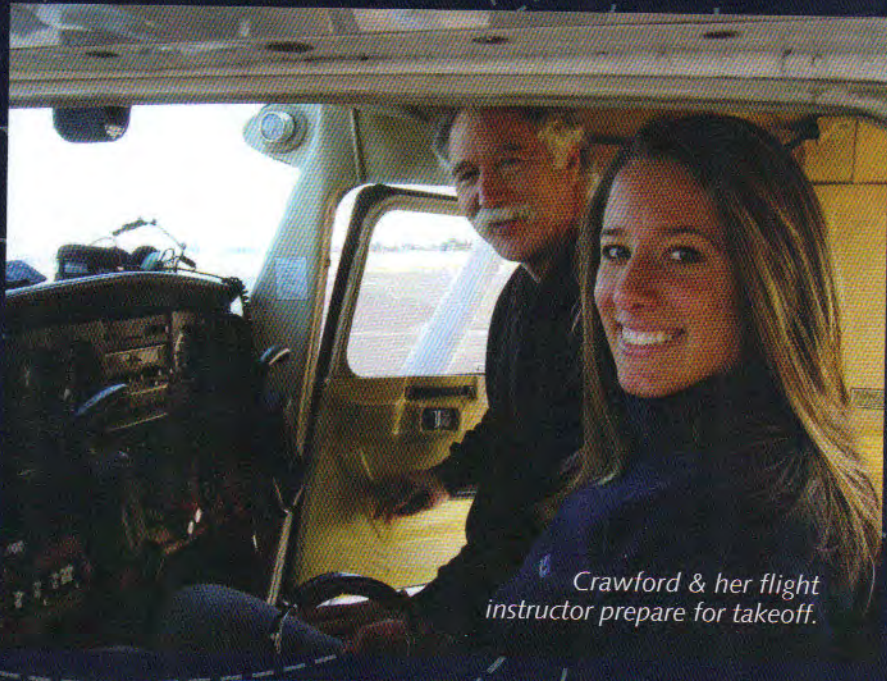
As luck would have it, although Crawford did not know it at the time, she was cut from the volleyball team. With her schedule unexpectedly open, Crawford was able to seize the opportunity.

"I am so lucky that I was cut from the team," explains Crawford. "It really freed me up to take advantage of an amazing opportunity that I never dreamed I would have. I started flying lessons in October of 2007."

A naturally gifted and dedicated student, Crawford accomplished her first solo flight two short months later, and just weeks after graduation she earned her pilot's license. Her flight instructor tells CB that in twenty years of teaching, Sophia is one of the two best students he has ever had. Profoundly grateful for the opportunity, Sophia is also more determined than ever to work in the field of aeronautical engineering as she prepares for college in the fall at U.C. Santa Barbara.

"To me, this entire endeavor really captures the special connections we have as part of the CB community," says CB President Lorcan Barnes. "Generosity may take different forms, but ultimately, truly makes a difference in the lives of our students."

For Barnes, who jokes that he also hopes to learn to fly one day when he has a lot of money, the opportunity to fly with Crawford before she left town for college in Santa Barbara stands out as one of his proudest moments since arriving in Sacramento. "To see this young lady embrace this opportunity, work so hard, and accomplish so much in such a short period of time, well, that is just the icing on the cake!"

La Salle Club Hosts 54th Annual Baseball Hall of Fame Dinner

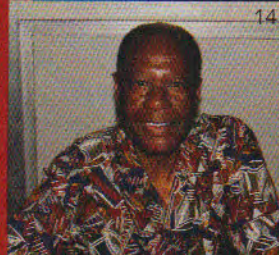

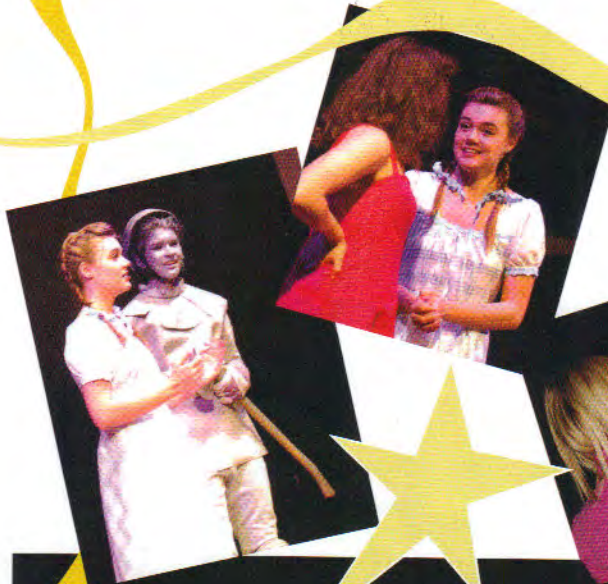
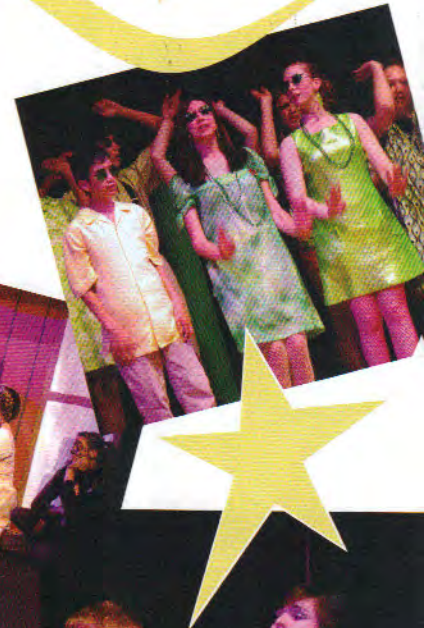

CB Celebrates 16th Annual La Salle Art Exhibit

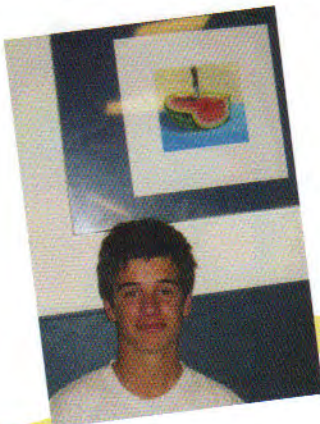

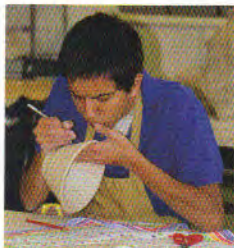
The school's efforts, spearheaded by art/ceramics teacher Robert Boriskin included early morning visits to area television stations, radio interviews and even hosting a "Bowl-a-thon." Students, who usually enjoy late-start Thursdays, began arriving at CB at 5:45 a.m. to create, decorate and paint bowls. Boriskin made sure they had plenty of bagels and orange juice to maintain their energy and creativity.

Emily DeRodeff '08, who had to wake up at 4 a.m. to promote the event at KCRA and 5 a.m. for the Bowl-a-thon, says she was happy to help. "Before the event, I knew that hunger was an issue, but I didn't know how extensive it is and how quickly it is growing. Getting up early is no big deal when it helps people."

Bryan Perrin '08 was also surprised to learn about the growing numbers of people in the community affected by hunger. "I was really surprised to learn how much hunger is growing among the working poor. I'm not very good at art but this was a fun way to give back to a really important cause."

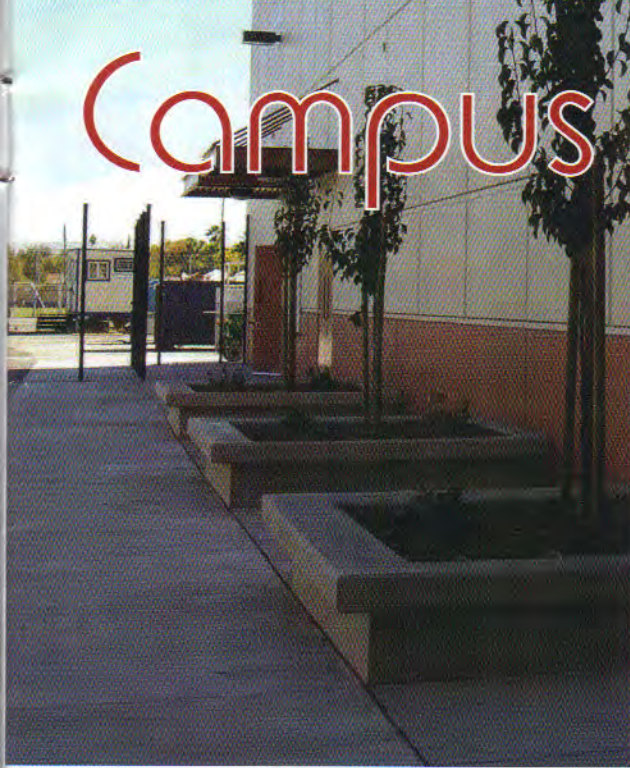

CB's teachers and students can take the heat

thanks to the completion of phase two of the air conditioning project. Last summer's phase one replaced the old single-pane windows with energy-efficient dual pane windows and added air conditioning to the second floor classrooms in the school's original wings. This summer finalized installation in the lower classrooms and the cafeteria. The upgrades allow for more comfortable conditions on hot days and make it possible to completely stop using the antiquated and inefficient boiler system.

With the new field house nearing completion, construction crews were able to redesign and improve the school's rear parking area to allow for a much more efficient flow of traffic and additional parking spaces.

Following the war, Babich finished his undergraduate work at Standord University and earned a law degree from the University of San Francisco.

As the son of devoutly Catholic, Croatian immigrants, Babich attended Mass every day and lived his life in a way that honored his upbringing and the community. Dear Alumni, Parents and Friends:

These are challenging economic times nationally, statewide and in our homes. At times like these, we are profoundly grateful to the individuals who are able to share of themselves to support the students and mission of Christian Brothers High School. We are mindful that the number of students who will need our support is only going to increase. In February of 2008, the Board of Trustees approved \$1 million in tuition assistance for the 2008-09 school year. While this is a bold move in relatively calm economic conditions, it is even more so given today's climate. Each year, we have seen the need for tuition assistance increase. During the 2007-08 school year, 158 students received tuition assistance. In 2008-09, we are helping 171 students.

Maintaining our steadfast commitment to ensuring a Christian Brothers education is accessible to families who would otherwise not be able to afford it remains a priority. Doing so means that we are depending on our alumni and friends who are in a position to give, continue doing so. A great example of this is the Class of '55 (see page 3) who have committed to sponsoring a student scholarship annually.

A good friend of the school once said that giving to CB is "like making an investment in your values." The longer that I am here, the more I know this is true. In times of economic uncertainty, charitable donations often lose their place on one's list of priorities. I sincerely hope that you will make the students of Christian Brothers one of your priorities in 2008-09.

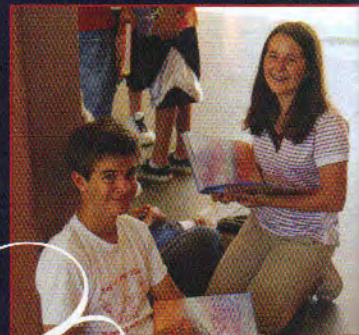
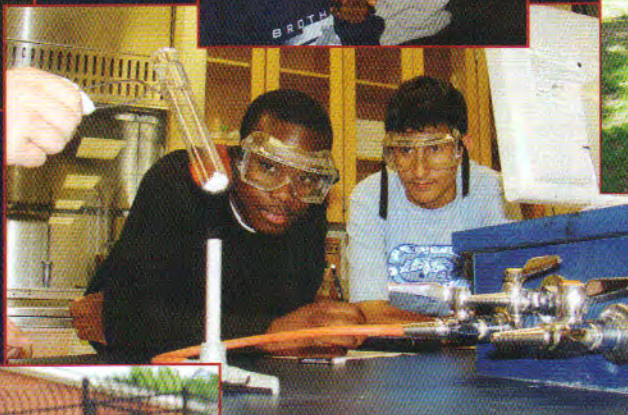
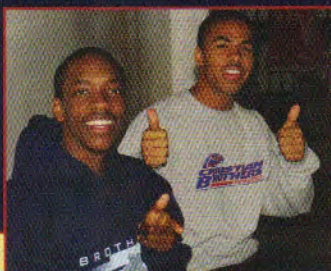

Joe Genshlea '56 has written and is performing a one-man show about his experiences growing up in the state capital at 8:00 PM on Saturday, Oct. 25.

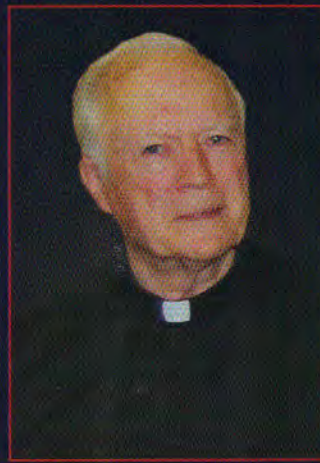
"A Sense of Place: Reflections, Recollections And Ruminations on a Sacramento Life", will be directed by Peggy Shannon, STC's artistic director and current CB parent. It will be performed at the Wells Fargo Pavilion, the summer home of the Music Circus, at 1419 H Street in Sacramento.

Genshlea said the show is intended to reflect his love for his hometown — and also to tell stories about its colorful characters. "It covers everyone from Pat Melarkey '49 to Earl Warren, Eleanor McClatchy to Max Baer '55, and Edmonds Field to Christian Brothers High School and its old rivals Sacramento High School and McClatchy High School," he said. "Everyone has a story. This is mine: a somewhat straightforward account of a Sacramento life, salted with rumor and humor."

"The script was adapted, though barely, from a series of taping sessions I held with Joe," said local columnist and playwright Ed Goldman. "The irony, wit and stories are pure Joe. I just added a semi-colon now and then to feel like I was contributing."

Genshlea is a founding shareholder of the law firm of Weintraub Genshlea Chediak. He received his undergraduate degree from Stanford University in 1960 and his law degree from Hastings College of the Law in 1964. He has lectured for the Business Litigation Section of the State Bar of California and has served on numerous community boards.

Ed Haefliger '61 joined the U.S. Coast Guard six days after graduating from high school. He then worked a variety of jobs including commercial fishing, a cannon and machine gun technician at McClellan Air Force Base and then as a firefighter with the Sacramento Fire Department. He left Sacramento for Shelton, Washington where he worked as a firefighter until he was injured when a ceiling collapsed. After that he started a shellfish farm and helped grow Taylor Shellfish Co. Inc. into the world's largest shellfish farm. For the past 10 years, Ed has volunteered as a stock (horse and mule) packer for the Olympic National Park rangers and trail crews to assist in their efforts to keep the trails open. Ed also enjoys spending time with his wife, Sue, and their grandchildren.



When **Msgr. James Church '50** graduated from Christian Brothers High School, he says he was more of an athlete than he was a spiritual person. "I played three years of baseball, two years of basketball and a year of football. It wasn't until a retreat during my senior year that I really even thought about becoming a priest. I talked with a Franciscan priest and told him that I had been thinking a bit about a religious vocation. He told me that I better get

serious and think about it. I talked with the Brothers at school and decided to give it a try."

Shortly after graduation, Church moved to St. Joseph's Seminary in Mountain View where he studied for two years. "I got to the Seminary with my athlete's frame-of-mind, thinking wow, isn't the Seminary lucky to get me?"

About six weeks into it, I realized that I was the lucky one to be there. I realized that I was not the hot shot, God is!

Following six more years of studying at the St. Patrick's Seminary at Menlo Park, Church was ordained a priest. "About a year before I was ordained, they really encouraged us to thoughtfully consider whether or not we were really willing to live for others rather than living for ourselves."

Fifty years later, Church is decidedly content with his choice. "The most enjoyable part of my religious life is that I have been able to be a part of other people's lives. I've shared weddings, baptisms, 50th anniversaries and so many other special moments. I worked as a teacher and school administrator for 23 years and I've served the community in the parishes. In fact, a number of his teaching years brought him back to Christian Brothers. "I taught math, religion and science. As the oldest of 14 siblings, one of my brothers and my sister were at the school (Bishop Armstrong) during the time that I was. I even got to teach my younger brother, Bernie, in my book keeping class."

In June, the Diocese of Sacramento honored Church for 50 years of service. His family celebrated with a mass at Immaculate Conception. Although he was officially required to retire at age 75, Church has definitely not slowed down in his retired life. "I am the acting pastor at St. Rose Church and St. Patrick's School. I officiate at Mass between ten and twelve times each week and when needed, I'm available to help our parishioners with their needs."

Church is also back for a stint on the Christian Brothers Board of Trustees. "I'm thrilled to be back again. The spirit of the school, which I believe comes directly from the Christian Brothers, is as special today as it ever was."

Although it's been said that his classroom doodling landed him in detention at CB, **Eric Decetis '70** has built quite a name for himself as a cartoonist. His works, which feature his own offbeat brand of humor, can be found on greeting cards, mouse pads, clocks, magnets, T-shirts and notepads. Decetis also keeps his day job with the state of California.

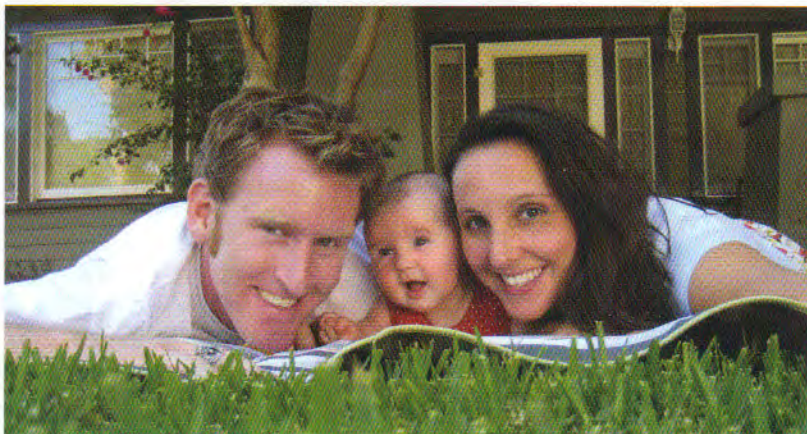

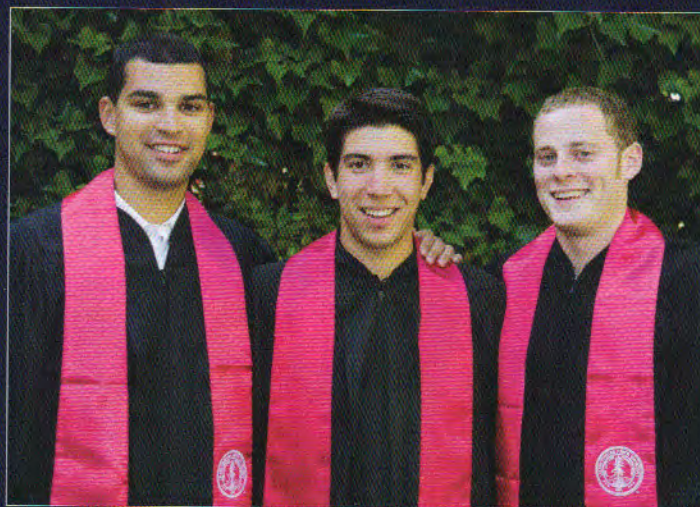

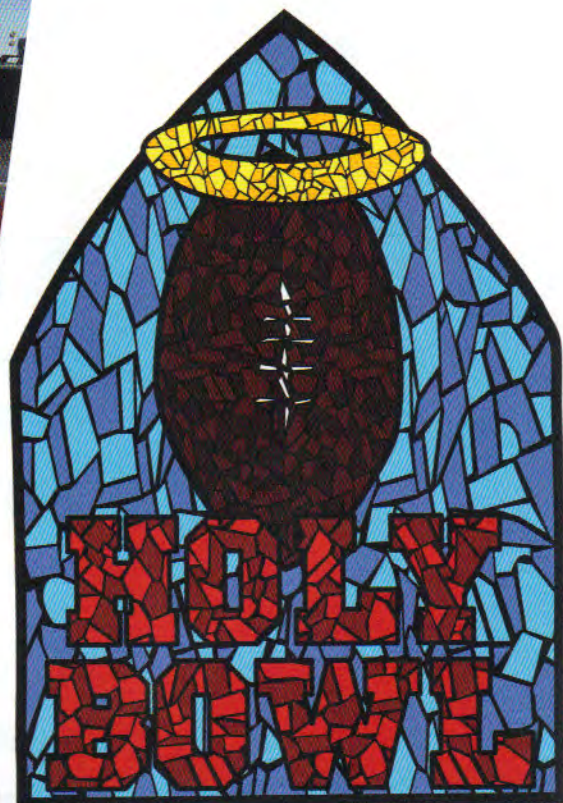
