The Board of Trustees at Christian Brothers High School is comprised of 11 volunteers dedicated to safeguarding and advancing the school's Catholic, Lasallian mission. Before joining the Board of Trustees, candidates undergo training on Lasallian charism (history, spirituality and philosophy of education) and Policy Governance – a model used by Lasallian schools throughout the District of San Francisco. The Policy Governance model includes an inclusive, written set of goals for the school, called Ends Policies which guide the board in monitoring the performance of the school and its President/CEO. In the spring, a committee comprised of current and former trustees and members of the school's faculty and administration, met to review and suggest revisions to the Ends Policies. In October, the committee met with the full Board of Trustees to review and finalize the recommended changes to ensure that Christian Brothers High School adheres to the vision of the Brothers of the Christian Schools of the District of San Francisco.
