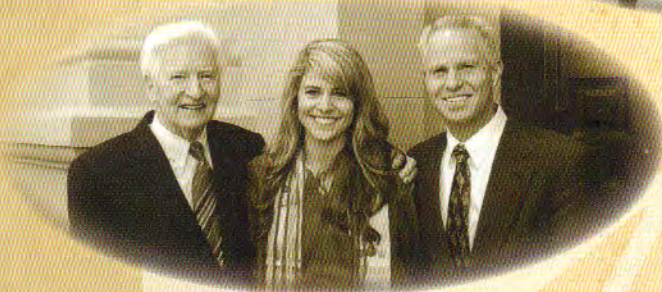

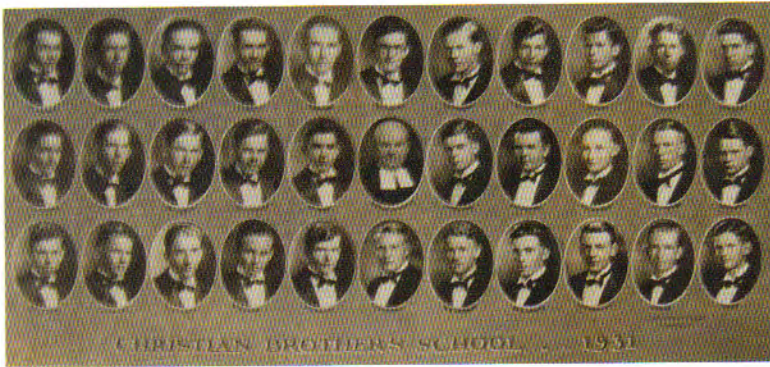

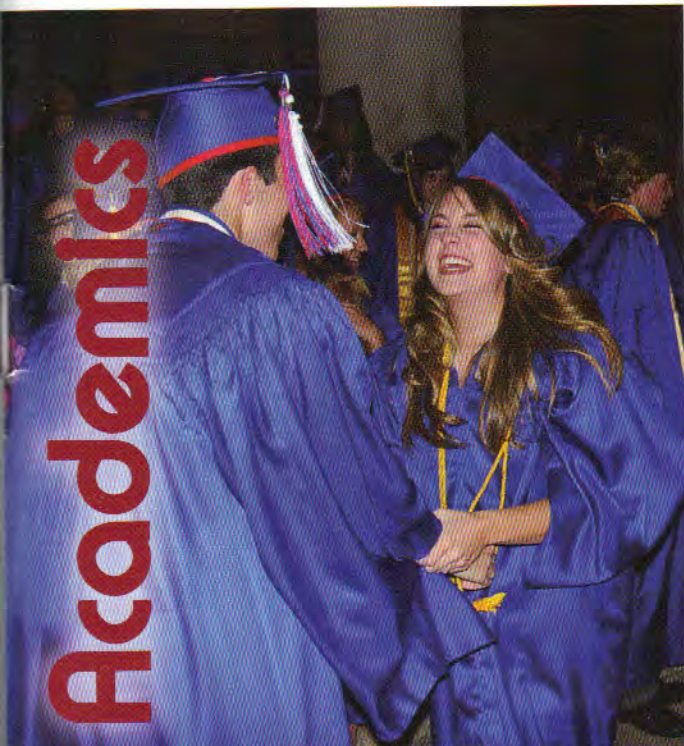

Dear Alumni, Parents and Friends:

Abby Williams '11 Selected as Girls Nation Representative

As one of almost 500 young women selected to participate in the American Legion Auxiliary's Girls State 2010, Abby Williams '11 enjoyed meeting students from across California and learning more about the duties, privileges, rights and responsibilities of American citizenship. Forming a mock government of Whigs and Tories, the young women engaged in debates, held mock elections, and learned more about the governmental process in California at the city, county and state level.

"It was so much fun," says Williams. "I met so many bright, highly successful, motivated girls. Four of us even launched a third-party movement. We called it the Fissure Party and our focus was on integrating environmental

concerns into every component of political issues. Although our party didn't succeed, we did end up introducing a proposition that addressed our concerns. It passed with a vote of 383 to 87 and I was told that was the first time in seven years that a proposition was successfully placed on the ballot."

At the culmination of the week, Williams was surprised to learn that she was one of two young women selected to represent California as senators in Washington, D.C. at the 64th Annual Girls Nation Congress.

As a senator, Williams helped plan a political convention, introduced a senate bill and debated the role of government in assisting immigrant families. Throughout each endeavor, she was grateful for her teachers at CB.

"Thanks to Mr. Meegan's A.P. U.S. History Class, I was able to hold my own in a debate about the constitutionality of religious benedictions at public high school graduations," says Williams. "Thanks to Ms. Safford's class, I could speak on environmental issues. Thanks to volunteering with our Oak Ridge Elementary School Big Brothers Club, I could speak about some of the needs of immigrant families because I worked directly with children of immigrants and saw, firsthand, some of the issues. Really, all of my classes and teachers helped me hold my own among some of the brightest, most ambitious young women I have ever met."

As a representative of California, Williams was able to visit Congresswoman Doris Matsui's office, where she met Sam Stefanki '00 who worked there as a Legislative Analyst. She also met Senator Barbara Boxer and toured the White House where she was part of a group selected to meet President Barack Obama.

"If you had asked me last spring about my summer plans, meeting President Obama was not even a possibility. Girls Nation was such an amazing, unexpected adventure," says Williams.

If you had asked Williams last spring about her college plans, she would have had a more definitive answer as she verbally committed to play Division I soccer for Lafayette College in Pennsylvania.

Susannah Nelson

Named CBHS 2010 Lasallian Educator of the Year

David and Susannah Nelson, joined by Nelson's son, Daniel Green, and girlfriend, Leigh Ann Powell, who were surprise guests at the St. La Salle Liturgy.

Susannah Nelson is a woman on a mission – a Lasallian mission. As director of campus ministry, she facilitates CB's prayer life, leads the campus ministry team, assists students in planning liturgies and prayer services, acts as campus Lasallian animator, and coordinates a four-year retreat program. Her enthusiasm for all things Lasallian is infectious as is her devotion to students throughout their educational and faith journey.

In recognition of her efforts, Nelson was named CB's 2010 Lasallian Educator of the Year. The award, presented at the St. La Salle liturgy on May 15, is given to the faculty member who most exemplifies the spirit and dedication of St. John Baptist de La Salle and his ministry to educate young people. Recipients are nominated by CB faculty and staff and selected by the management team.

Ask Nelson what led her to CB, and her answer might surprise you – sheets and pillows. Nelson joined the CB community in 2000 as a summer school English teacher. Already a full-time teacher at Loretto High School, she sought out the summer position after realizing that her carefully planned college budget for her son, Daniel, did not include dorm room necessities like sheets and pillows.

"I planned tuition, books, room and board. I simply forgot some of the basics. Although I



didn't know it at the time, I believe God was really calling me to CB," explains Nelson. "I had been to the campus before for athletic events and dinners and I knew it was nice. But, once I began teaching here, I loved it! There is just something very special and wonderful about this community. And, the co-education felt really right. It was a joy to have young men and women together in the classroom. Also, I met my husband, David, here. Again, the call of God."

In the fall of 2000, she joined the CB faculty as a part-time religious studies teacher and assistant director of campus ministry.

"I was not looking for a job. I loved working at Loretto High School. I just felt it was my vocation to be here. I was blessed to work in campus ministry for a year with Brother Richard Herliny," says Nelson. "He was a wonderful teacher and mentor and provided me with an inspiring introduction into the Lasallian charism."

Since that time, Nelson has immersed herself in the study of St. John Baptist de La Salle. She spent several weeks participating in Vandu Paaru - a Lasallian service trip to the Boys' Town orphanage and school run by the Christian Brothers in southern India.

She is also a graduate of the Lasallian Leadership Institute, a three-year formation program.

As campus Lasallian animator, Nelson shares her enthusiasm and knowledge with the faculty and staff and students at CB. Working with students, whom she lovingly refers to as the "children of God," is always the best part of her day.

"I love working with the kids," explains Nelson. "I really believe that the joys and challenges of these students reinforce, for me, the presence of God on this campus and in them. The faith they display so honestly and openly is inspiring."

The feeling is definitely reciprocated.

"Mrs. Nelson was always a great source of love and understanding on CB's campus," says Ryan Lutz '09. "Whenever I had a stressful day, I could go into campus ministry, sit down and simply talk about it with her. From freshman retreats to Kairos, Mrs. Nelson has a way of impacting lives for the better. Words really can't do justice to what she is to CB's community."

"Mrs. Nelson is definitely one of the people at CB from whom I learned the most," offers Kayla Giese '09. "She is one of the most inspirational, and good-hearted people I know. Definitely someone who lives her faith."

"Susannah Nelson is the guardian angel and big sister St. John Baptist de La Salle inspires his teachers to be," says Julie Greene, religious studies teacher. "As the campus minister, as our Lasallian animator, and as our colleague, friend and minister, Susannah Nelson generously supports all of us in our learning and teaching vocations."

"Susannah Nelson's dedication to her faith and serving the students, faculty and staff of Christian Brothers have earned her the respect of her peers and the love of our students," says CB President, Lorcan Barnes. "She has a gift of connecting with teenagers. She exemplifies the mission of the Founder to see the light in every child, and she inspires the young men and women with whom she works as a role model of faith and service. We are honored to recognize her as the 2010 Lasallian Educator of the Year."

"I have been blessed to work with many, many dedicated and gifted educators throughout my 35 years in Catholic education, especially the ten years here at Christian Brothers High School," says Nelson. "I have gained so much wisdom and so many spiritual graces from my interactions here. My heart is filled with gratitude and I am so honored to receive this award."

Mary Hesser Serving as Principal

After Principal, Raymond Burnell, announced to the school community that he would not be returning for the 2010-11 school year, President Lorcan Barnes did not have to look far to find a talented replacement.

Fortunately, Mary Hesser, CB's director of guidance, agreed to serve as Interim Principal for the 2010-11 school year. Hesser brings considerable experience and talent to the position. She has served the community for the past 13 years as a classroom teacher and guidance counselor. She was honored as CB Lasallian Educator of the Year in 2008 and as a United States Regional Distinguished Lasallian Educator in 2009. Prior to joining CB she worked as a classroom teacher for 18 years at both the high school and primary grade levels.

In terms of the Guidance Department, Mr. Kirk Purdy agreed to step in as Director for 2010-11. Purdy was the counselor for the Class of 2011 and he looks forward to working with the students as they embark upon the college application process.

"I am confident that with Mrs. Hesser at the helm of day-to-day operations, assisted by our experienced, mission-centered leadership team, faculty and staff, Christian Brothers High School will continue its 135-year tradition of excellent, college-preparatory education in the Catholic, Lasallian tradition," says President Barnes.

A comprehensive search for a new Principal will begin this fall.

CB's Joe Guilherme Receives Highest Lasallian Honor “Affiliation”

The highest honor that the Brothers of the Christian Schools can bestow upon an individual, who is not a Christian Brother, is that of Affiliation. On Saturday, May 8, Christian Brothers from as far away as Washington and Los Angeles, and throughout Northern California gathered with CB's facility manager, Joe Guilherme, and his family and friends for a celebratory mass and presentation of the Letter of Affiliation.

The honor, which can only be given with the approval of the Generalate in Rome, is a symbol of deep appreciation for the shared beliefs and values of religious faith, love for young people, enthusiasm for Christian and human education, sensitivity for the needs of the poor and a commitment to the ideals of St. John Baptist de La Salle.

“Joe Guilherme has served our community for 45 years,” says Br. Donald Johanson, FSC. “In that time, he has worked faithfully and tirelessly to support the works of the Brothers and to promote the



ideals of St. John Baptist de La Salle.”

“It was love at first sight,” says a smiling Joe Guilherme, when asked about his first day of work at Christian Brothers High School. “My cousin worked at the school and told me about a part-time job. I walked on to campus and fell in love. I didn't want to leave.”

More than 45 years later, Guilherme still feels the same way.

“I love coming to work. My favorite time of the day is the morning,” says Guilherme. “At about 6:30, I start my walk and begin unlocking doors. The campus is so quiet. I get to look around and just enjoy it.”

“Though Joe is not a classroom teacher, the work he does is essential to every facet of our students' experience,” says Lorcan Barnes, President. “Joe's efforts have a direct impact on every classroom, athletic event, and extra-curricular activity on this campus. He is the man behind the magic curtain.”

To put his years of service into perspective, Guilherme has worked at CB longer than any currently serving faculty or staff member. He has served under 13 principals, six of whom were Christian Brothers, and three presidents. His years at the school are surpassed only by assistant men's basketball coach and former CB teacher/administrator, Jack Witry.

"If you look around our campus, the history of change and progress abound," says Br. Donald. "Joe has been an instrumental part of that growth. His imprint is indelibly etched upon all aspects of the buildings and grounds and will live on for generations."

"I have known Joe for many years," says longtime friend and CB teacher, Danny Delgado '79. "I admire his loyalty which extends far beyond school. Everything he does is done well and professionally. He is also a man of his word and I really value that."

"Joe's dedication and service extend beyond the CB campus to other District of San Francisco schools and the Brothers Community at Mont La Salle in Napa," says Br. Donald.

Susanne Currie, bookstore manager and facilities coordinator, has worked with Joe for the past eight years.

"Joe really goes out of his way to make people happy," says Currie. "He has dedicated his life to this school and the Christian Brothers. Serving the Brothers truly supersedes any other priorities he may have for the day."

"Affiliation is the Brothers' way of recognizing and acknowledging persons who have not only supported us in our work through outstanding gifts and services, but who have also supported us

through the personal and fraternal relationship they have with us," says Br. Donald. "Affiliation is a recognition of our relationship with these persons and the beliefs and values we share: religion, faith, love for young people, enthusiasm for Christian and human education, sensitivity for the needs of the poor, and a commitment to Christ and His Gospel. The names of Affiliates are inscribed officially in the archives at our international center in Rome. Affiliates share in all of our prayers, good works, and in the general spiritual treasury of the Institute."

When asked about receiving the award, ever humble Guilherme responded simply, "It was the greatest honor of my life."

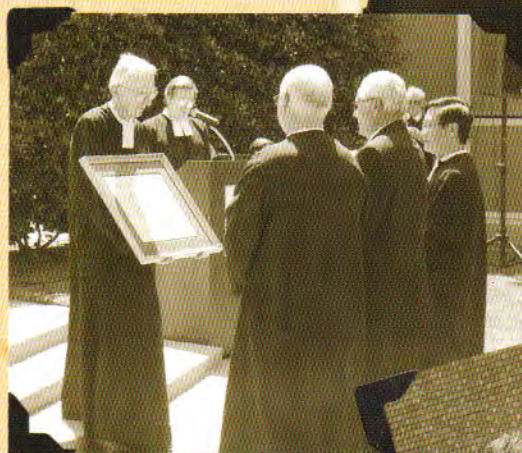
As for talk of retirement, "I plan on being here until I can't come to work anymore," laughs Guilherme.

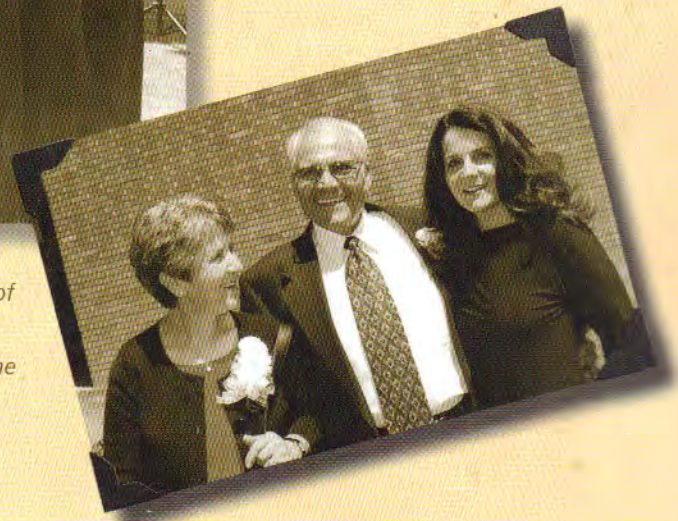

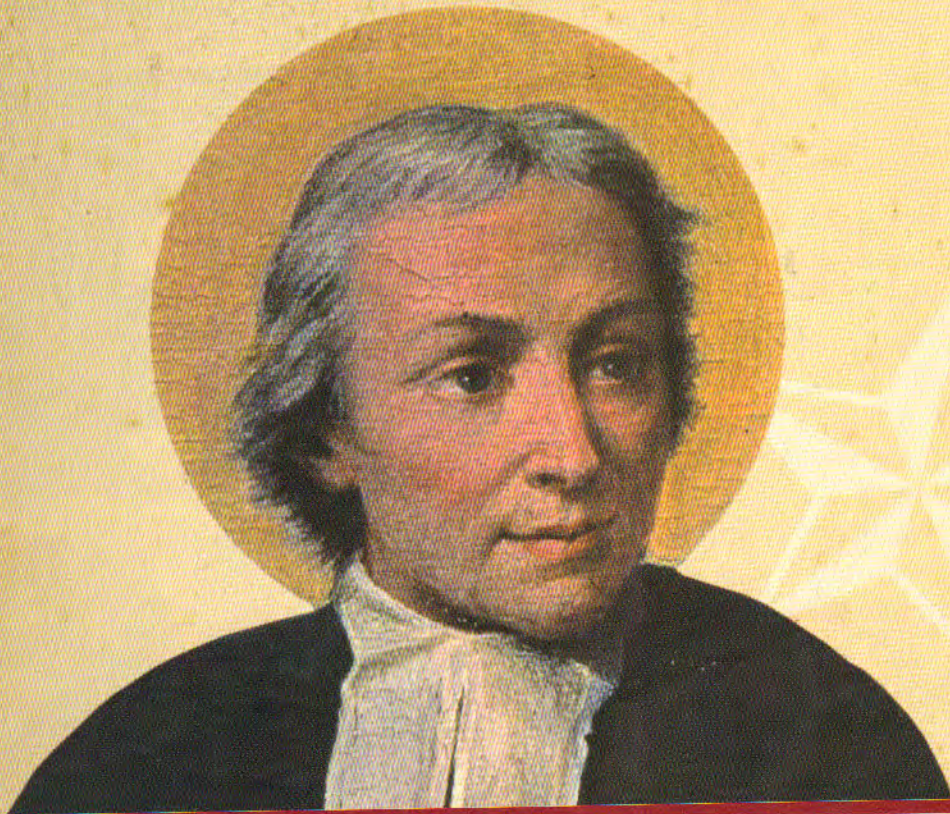

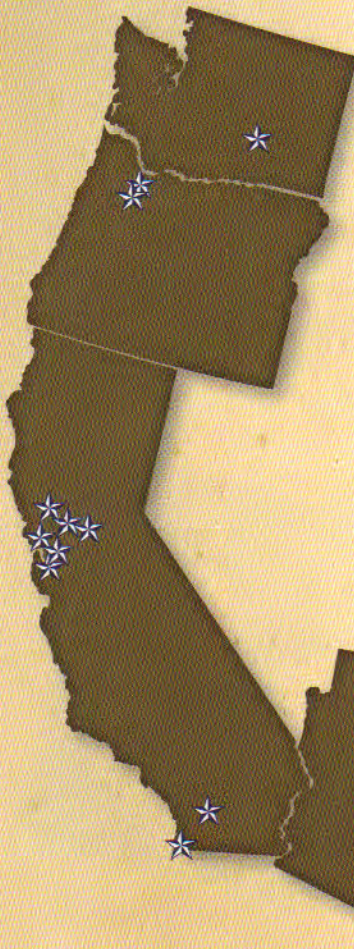
Take a walk on the Christian Brothers High School campus and the feeling of community among the Brothers, students, teachers and staff is palpable. Now in its 135th year in Sacramento, the school has changed location three times and been known by six different names. What remains unchanged is the inimitable spirit -- the Lasallian spirit and tradition of teaching and caring for young people in a community steadfastly dedicated to the intellectual growth and spiritual well-being of its students.

This rich tradition of Lasallian education dates back to 1680 when St. John Baptist de La Salle, a prominent French priest, founded the Brothers of the Christian Schools "to give a human and Christian education to the young, especially the poor." In 1868, the De La Salle Christian Brothers brought that legacy to California following ten years of pleading by the Archbishop of San Francisco who implored them to take over the struggling little college he had founded -- St. Mary's. Thanks to their dynamic leadership, innovation, and persistence, St. Mary's College continues to thrive today.

Wanting that same educational vision and commitment for the young men of Sacramento, members of the Catholic community raised money to bring the Christian Brothers to Sacramento. In 1876, they opened the St. Patrick Institute at 12th and K streets, which has since evolved into what is now Christian Brothers High School.

Today, 1,022 young men and women enter its doors each day and each, in his or her own way, continues the legacy of learning, service and inclusive community that are at the very heart of a CBHS education.

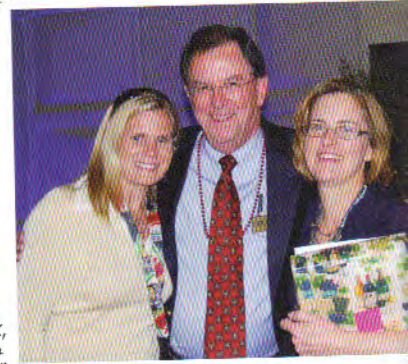
Auction Raises Record Funds!

Most days as school lets out, student athletes report for practice, melodies filter out of the band room as the jazz band perfects its latest number, student actors run through lines as they rehearse for an upcoming production, and the video production class is hard at work on a story for KBFT. All of these activities present opportunities for growth not found in the classroom.

In November of 2008, Christian Brothers High School publicly announced its Building on the Tradition Campaign – Phase II for the purpose of expanding and enhancing the campus to better serve students. Since then, CB athletes have claimed section titles and league championships. Physical education classes optimize the availability of two practice facilities and the weight room is used year-round.

Students of the 21st century at CB are truly “renaissance” as they have the opportunity to excel in academics, athletics and the arts. While the completion of the field house marks a significant component of Phase II, there is still much to be done. In order to further ensure that CB provides its young women and men with the necessary resources and facilities to discover and foster their gifts, the campus greatly needs a venue to showcase the talents of its visual and performing artists.

Studies show that students who participate in the arts demonstrate improved academic performance. At CB, more than 50 percent of our students participate in visual and performing arts classes. The performing arts facility phase of construction would also include significant upgrades to our chapel. Further, Phase II allocates funds to the tuition assistance endowment.

To date, the campaign has generated \$8.9 million in gifts and pledges. 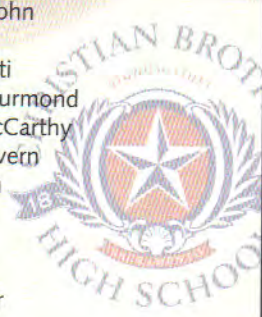

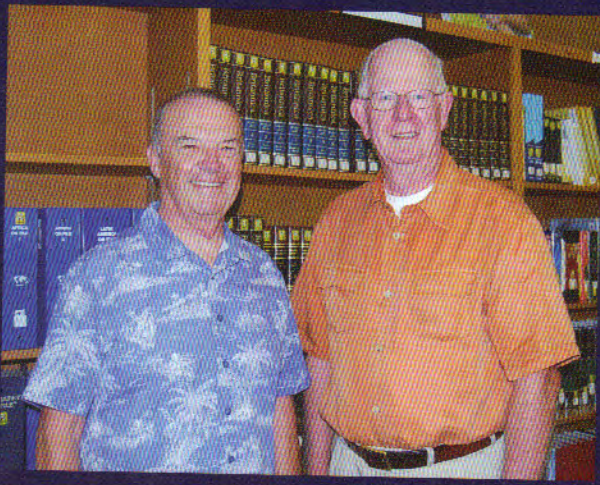

Class Sponsorship Program Gaining Momentum

Ken Harris '54 and Bob Granucci '55

The Class of 1955 wanted to “give back” to Christian Brothers High School. That simple, yet important and generous concept, materialized into what today is an important part of the school’s annual giving program.

Bob Granucci '55 and a group of five classmates (Terry Dorsey '55, John Giordano '55, Dick Giusti '55, Leo Granucci '55, and Jerry Williams '55) met to discuss strategies for giving. Collectively, they embraced the idea of trying to sponsor a needy student at CB. All members from the Class of '55 were then asked to consider a gift of some amount. Every gift, large or small, was important to their efforts. The goal was to raise as much as possible, and if the class was successful, they hoped to raise enough to sponsor a student. The program was launched in July, 2008.

Soon after, Ken Harris '54, Granucci's brother-in-law, shared the idea with two of his classmates, Larry Lynch '54 and Frank Silvey '54. Shortly thereafter, the Class of '54 hit the ground running.

After sending several letters and making a few telephone calls, both classes successfully raised over \$11,600 -- fully covering the tuition and fees for two students whose families could not afford to send them to CB without assistance.

One year later, 14 classes and the women of Bishop Manogue have now embraced the program. The classes of 1954, 1955 and 1960 have raised more than \$11,825 each in 2009-10. In addition, three new classes have already signed on for the 2010-2011 school year.

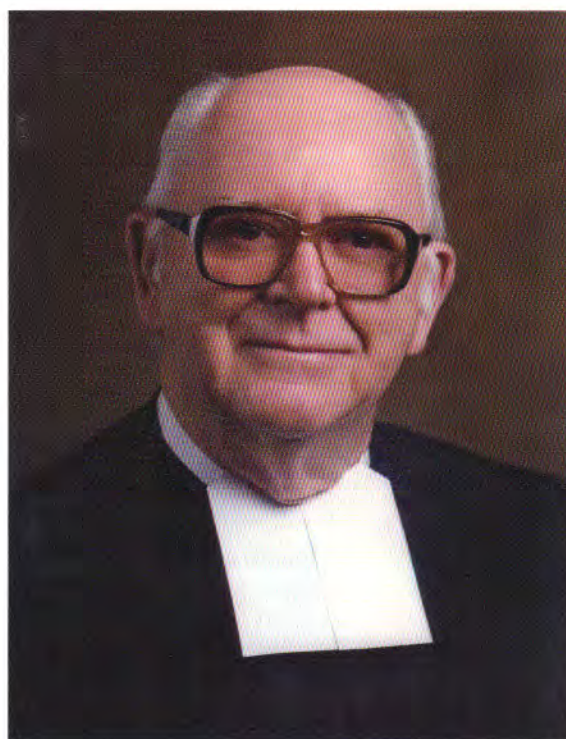

Alumni WINE, BEER & FOOD *Extravaganza* Fun for Good Cause

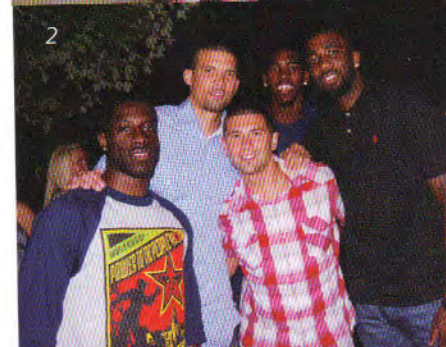

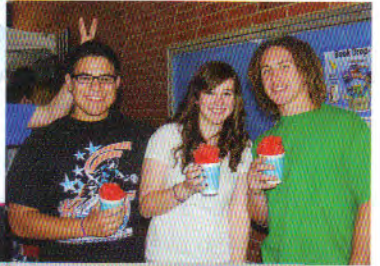
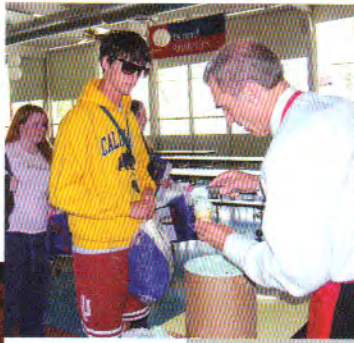
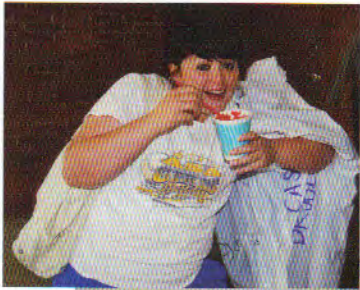
School Spirit

Egre's work will soon be on display in the locker rooms, gymnasium, field house and weight room as well with plans underway to add a touch of Falcon pride to each of the facilities.

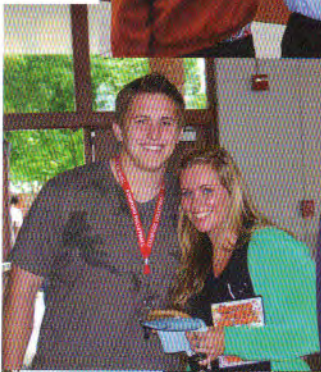

The thumbs up, waves, fist pumps, claps and honks of appreciation helped every day. It was also a grim reminder that breast cancer is a part of so many people's lives. It seemed as though as we stopped and talked, each person was in some way affected, a friend, a family member, or a patient themselves. Everyone knows someone with breast cancer."

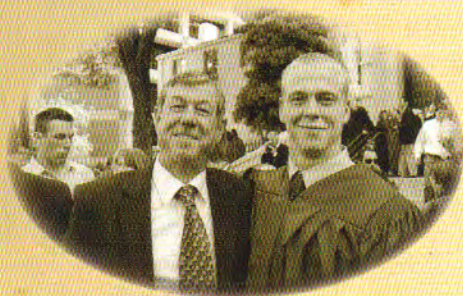


A Message from the Alumni Association
