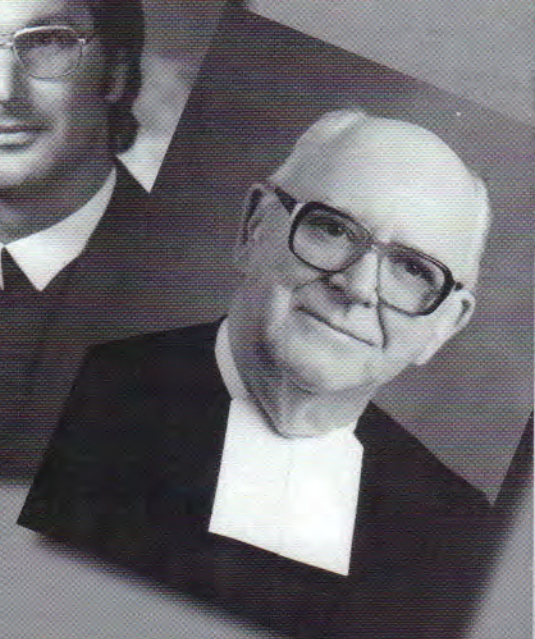

Message from the President

Fall 2011

Dear Alumni, Parents and Friends:

Each year, the fall issue of *Connection* includes an Annual Report of Gifts (page 24). Gathering and categorizing the data is a methodical process that takes weeks of work on the part of our development staff. In the end, lists are compiled and put together in such a way that we hope allows readers to easily find the names or categories they are looking for. To me, though, every name on every list represents a vital partner in our efforts to continue the 135-year legacy of the Christian Brothers in Sacramento, vital partners like Rich and Connie Koppes who recently made a generous donation to the Visual & Performing Arts building effort (page 20), Steve Radman '60 who provided for the school in his estate plan (page 43), and Nolan Wallner '09 who sent in \$100 to support tuition assistance. Every gift matters.

Trends in Catholic education nationally and locally show reductions in the number of students attending Catholic schools. Our mission to serve young men and women, however, remains vital, particularly in these challenging economic times. The school has weathered the two World Wars, the Great Depression, numerous recessions and has emerged stronger. We are aware of the challenges and opportunities before us and will remain centered in our Catholic, Lasallian mission to challenge students with a curriculum that prepares them with the knowledge, skills and integrity to succeed in college and beyond. We will provide the facilities, opportunities and nurturing community essential to developing the whole child. We will care for students whose families are suffering economically. And, our admissions staff will redouble its efforts and outreach as they enumerate the many areas in which CB is distinctive and our students excel.

In terms of excelling, the Class of 2011 was exceptional. In what was reportedly the nation's toughest college admissions year, these young men and women enjoyed tremendous success with acceptances from each of the eight Ivy League schools (Brown, Columbia, Cornell, Dartmouth, Harvard, Princeton, Penn and Yale), Stanford University (3 students), University of Notre Dame (7 students), Georgetown University (2 students), the United States Military Academy at West Point, the United States Air Force Academy, the United States Naval Academy, all of the UC campuses, and many more.

As the school welcomes 281 new members into the illustrious ranks of alumni, we must build our base of graduates who support the school financially. Currently, only 8.7 percent of CB's graduates give. We know that Christian Brothers High School is beloved by its graduates as evidenced by the largest-ever Alumni Wine, Beer & Food Extravaganza (page 44). We hear time and again from former students who are grateful for the education they received and for having had the opportunity to be a part of the CB community. In order to sustain our mission, we need more of these men and women to join us in providing tuition assistance to students from low- and modest-income families and stabilizing tuition for others.

I am grateful to all of the alumni, families and friends of the school who generously share of their resources to ensure that Christian Brothers High School continues to thrive. Please know that we are careful stewards of your gifts and continue in our commitment to fiscal responsibility while maintaining the CB tradition of excellent, value-centered, Catholic, Lasallian education.

Ask Rose Ann Holmes what she enjoys most about her job, her instantaneous and enthusiastic response is “The kids!”

Her enthusiasm and love for the students permeates the courses she teaches (leadership and statistics) and drives her to enhance the CB experience for all in her role as student activities director. It also earned her CB’s most prestigious award, the Lasallian Educator of the Year Award at the 2011 St. La Salle Liturgy in May.

“I was so surprised and humbled to hear my name called,” says Holmes. “To even think that someone would nominate me is amazing. I really feel it’s a privilege for me to be able to serve as student activities director and to teach here. To receive an award for that is more than I could ask for.”

“Rose Ann Holmes embodies the principles of our Founder, St. John Baptist de La Salle, to educate students while caring for them as an older brother or sister would,” says Rolf Schumann, assistant principal for student life. “Like an enthusiastic big sister, I have seen her participate in upside down zip lining, white water rafting, and even a 7 a.m. polar bear plunge in Lake Tahoe. I have also seen her advocate tirelessly for the student council in Principal’s Advisory Council meetings. What I admire most and the one the Founder holds so highly is the love she shows the students.”

“Over the past ten years, Rose Ann has built a phenomenal student activities program for our students,” says Mary Hesser, principal. “She truly works year-round to orchestrate and facilitate leadership camps, Freshmen Lock-In, multi-cultural week, school rallies, dances and more. She devotes countless hours to preparation and is one of the kindest, most energetic, hardworking, student-centered individuals that I have ever had the pleasure to work with.”

“Mrs. Holmes is so dedicated to making all that we want

I also get to work with some of the most energetic and enthusiastic co-workers who support CB events, attend leadership camp, stay up late at dances and even dress up for prom.”

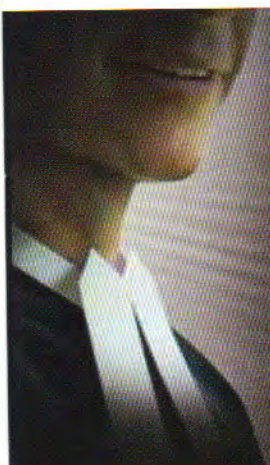

Fighting Cancer, the Bald Way

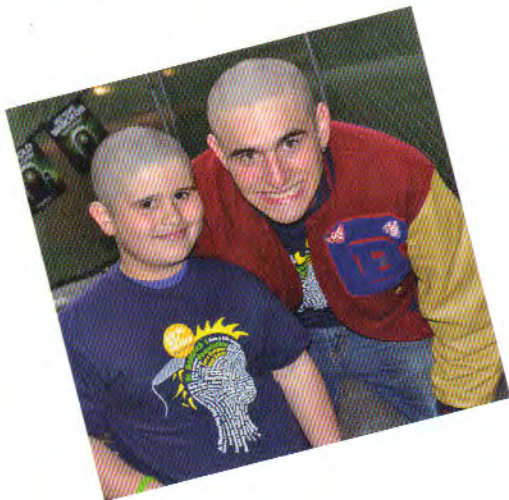
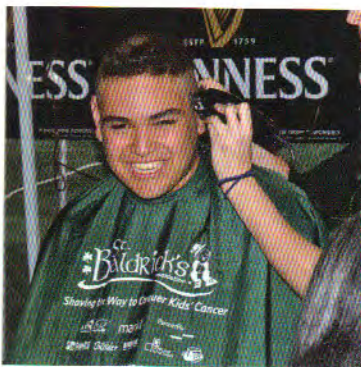
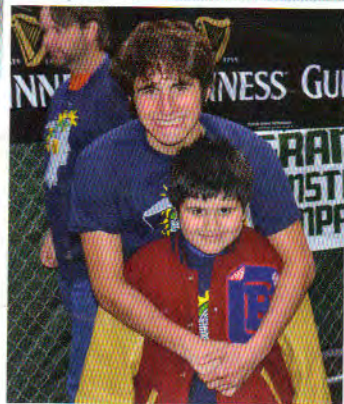

Women's Soccer Wins Back-to-Back League Titles

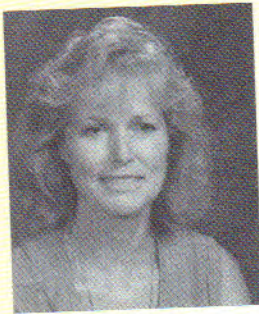
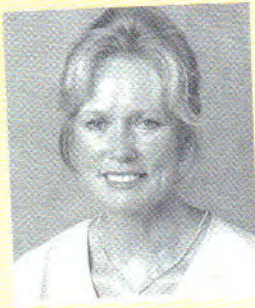

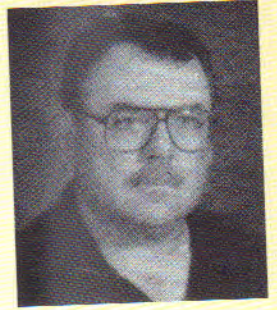


Men's Tennis Captures 1st League Title in 24 Years

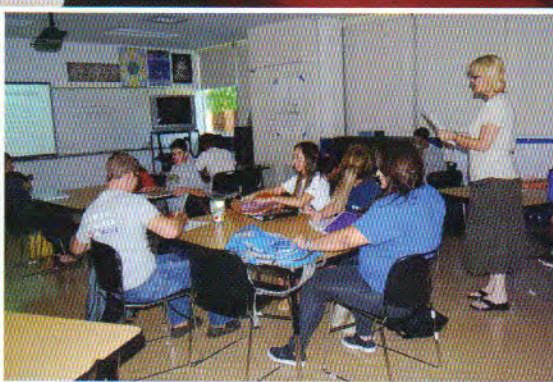

It's important that we provide healthy options and that students are able to complete the purchase quickly and have adequate time to enjoy their lunches. This transition allows us to focus on our mission to educate while leaving the food planning, ordering and preparation to the professionals.

Two familiar faces have returned, with longtime CB employees John Bonilla and Margaret Abu-Hijleh, joining the Sodexo crew.

Student Life Center Open for Fun!

With more than 40 student clubs, active and involved student government and class councils, a vibrant Campus Ministry Program and energized Christian service volunteers, CB provides numerous opportunities for students to pursue their interests and become engaged in campus life outside of the classroom.

Over the summer, construction crews removed the wall between classrooms 105 and 106 in the original south wing, added three offices and created what is now the school's Student Life Center. The new space serves as a classroom for Religious Studies Instructor and Christian Service Director, Jennifer Lystrup and for Statistics and Leadership teacher and Student Activities Director, Rose Ann Holmes. It also provides open space for club meetings, student council activities and Christian service planning. When construction begins on the Visual & Performing Arts Center, Campus Ministry will also move into the space.





More than 350 alumni, faculty, staff members, students and friends of Christian Brothers High School gathered to pay tribute to the Christian Brothers who have served the Catholic community and city of Sacramento since 1876. Marking 135 years of excellent education in a faith-filled, nurturing environment, the event celebrated the 378 Brothers who have been treasured members of the school community, dedicated and innovative teachers, and true pioneers in bringing Catholic education to Sacramento.

135 Years of Dedicated Service Deserves a Party!

A new addition to our campus, this beautiful statue of St. John Baptist de La Salle was blessed in front of the student body at the St. La Salle Liturgy on May 18th. It is prominently located at the primary student entrance to campus as a tribute to the Founder and lasting symbol of gratitude to the Brothers of the Christian Schools for 135 years of service in Sacramento.



The tribute, held on Sunday, May 15, began with Mass concelebrated by the Most Reverend Bishop Emeritus William K. Weigand, Most Reverend Bishop Richard Garcia of Monterey and 14 local clergy. Following Mass, attendees enjoyed a special program that featured keynote speakers (Br. Stanislaus Campbell, FSC, Brother Visitor of the District of San Francisco; Br. John Montgomery '81, FSC; and CB President Lorcan Barnes) and a festive luncheon.

Br. Stanislaus shared a brief history of the school, paying tribute to a number of Brothers who have been integral to CB's continued success including Brother Cianin Griffin, FSC, and the six Brothers who responded to the zealous appeal of the Archbishop of San Francisco to establish a school in Sacramento. The St. Patrick's Institute at 12th and K Streets opened its doors in July of 1876. Since that time, the school has changed its location three times and has been known by six different names. What remains unchanged is the Catholic, Lasallian spirit and tradition of teaching and caring for young people in a community steadfastly dedicated to the intellectual growth and spiritual well-being of its students.

The tribute also marked the imminent closure of the Brothers' residential community in Sacramento. In November of 2010, Br. Stanislaus announced that a number of Christian Brothers' residential communities in the District of San Francisco, including Sacramento, were to be consolidated in July. This change, part of a long process of turning over school leadership to Lay Partners, allows for larger living communities for the Brothers which is a vital component of their vocation to pursue their works "together and by association."

"When I graduated from CB in 1981, there were about 200 Brothers in our province," said Br. John Montgomery, FSC. "Today, we have about 90 Brothers, and, like other religious orders, we're not

getting any younger. The life we Brothers share in community is very dear to our hearts and our identity. We are Brothers, not bachelors...and need to live together in community."

"The vocation of the Christian Brothers is teaching. As such, they have been extraordinary teachers in sharing their mission, vision and values," says CB President, Lorcan Barnes. "Throughout my career, I have been blessed to work with a number of religious orders. None have been as intentional or as forward-thinking about sharing their charism and mission as the De La Salle Christian Brothers. Their willingness to so generously impart the Founder's mission allows Lasallian education to thrive worldwide."

"On the part of the Brothers, this is

truly a vote of confidence," says Br. Donald Johanson, FSC, director of the Brothers community in Sacramento, and Brother Visitor-Elect. "We have confidence in the administration, faculty and staff, and know that we are leaving the school in good hands."

With considerable foresight, the District of San Francisco has invested extensive human and financial resources over the last 16 years to provide Lasallian formation opportunities to trustees, faculty and staff. Sacramento's campus community includes a number of Lasallian Leadership Institute and Buttimer Institute of Lasallian Studies graduates who have benefitted from these multi-year training programs. Other faculty members and staff have participated in Lasallian immersion activities nationally

“At CB, day-to-day operations will remain the same,” says President Lorcan Barnes. “CB is still owned by the Christian Brothers District of San Francisco and the school is wholeheartedly committed to our Catholic, Lasallian mission. We are financially secure. I have confidence that our faculty and staff are well prepared and proud to carry on the school’s 135-year tradition of excellence in education while

inspiring the hearts and minds of our students.”

In his message to the Brothers, Barnes shared his gratitude for the 378 Christian Brothers who have served in Sacramento over the years. “Your influence does not end now,” said Barnes. “Your spirit, the spirit you inherited from St. John Baptist de La Salle, will continue to touch the hearts of young people. With faith and zeal, we accept the opportunity to carry forth our shared Catholic, Lasallian educational mission in Sacramento for as long as the good Lord wishes.”

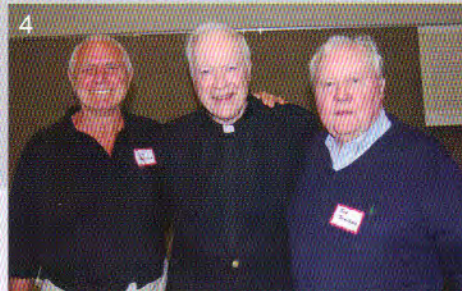
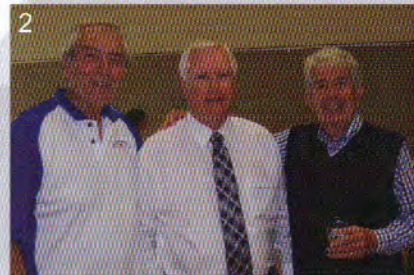
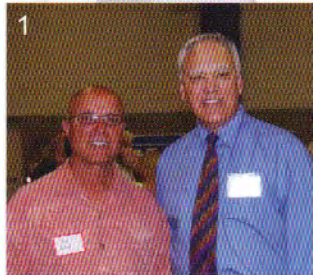

CB History Book Available

Let Us Remember, written by CB alumnus, Bill Iliff '76, begins with the Archbishop of San Francisco's 15-year campaign to persuade the Church to send the Brothers of the Christian Schools to California. It touches on the school's three locations, six names, reflections from the Brothers, notable alumni and some of the many traditions that have shaped campus life and welcomed generations of young men and women.

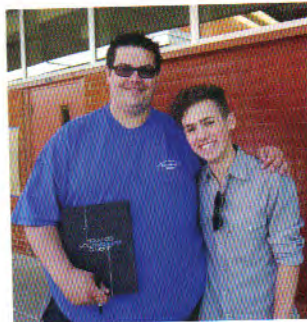
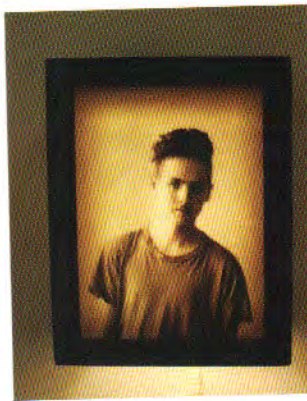
"I allowed Michelle to do a lot that I would have never thought she could do," says Meunch. "Our styles were very complementary and she was an absolute joy to work with."

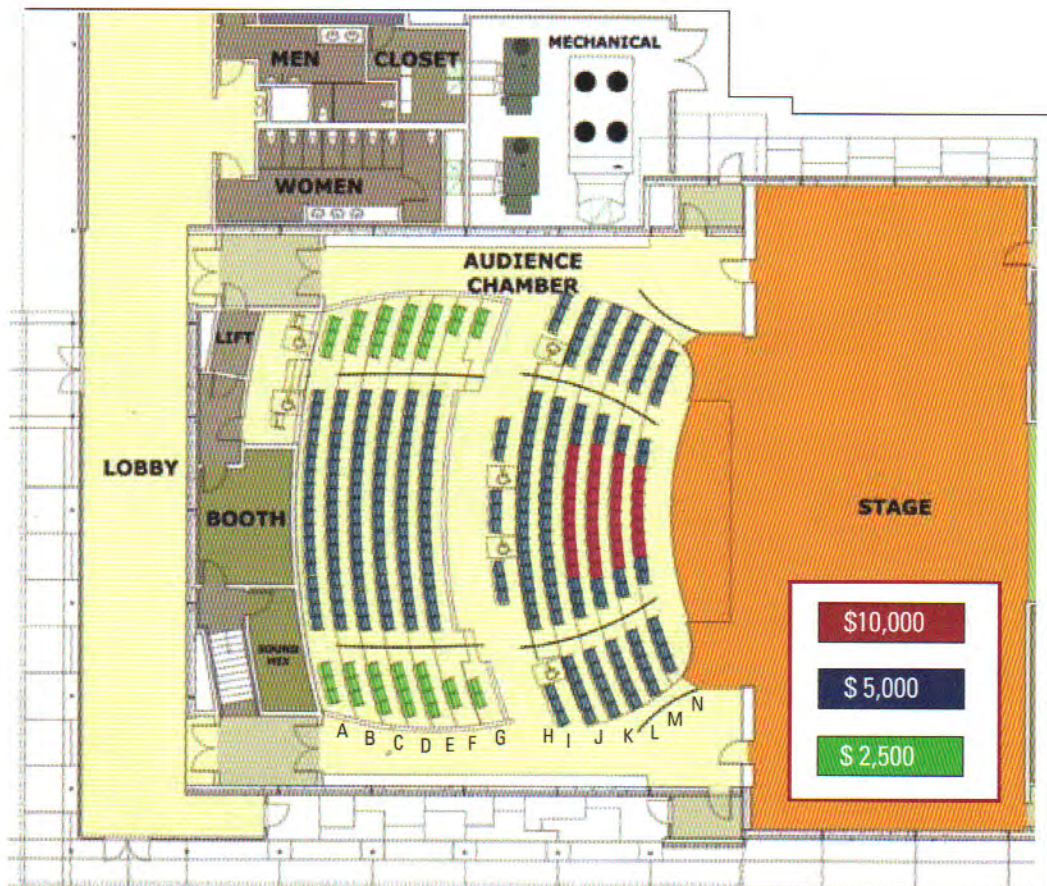

Cruises to Success

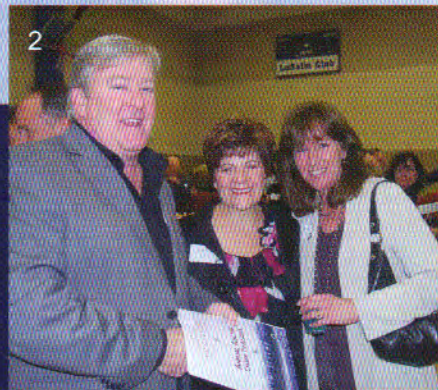

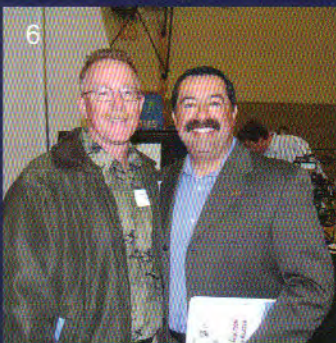
impact it's had, and still has, on the community, and they want to be a part. Thanks to them, it was an incredible evening."

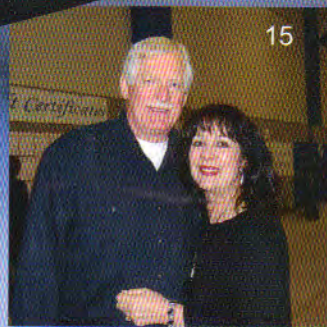

Steve Radman '60 – A Generous Bequest from a Generous Man

When Steve Radman '60, Bernice (Deal) Rowe '60 and Tom Lynch '60 met at age 13, the three became fast friends. They were often called The Three Musketeers and remained close throughout the years, traveling, going to the theater, and supporting one another through life's many adventures.

"Steve was special," says Rowe. "He was such a fun person. He worked as a right-of-way agent for Cal Trans for 39 years and had so many interests, including the theater and the fine arts. We loved going to see Tom, an actor, perform in his shows. Steve was also generous in his support of charities. He would clip coupons so he could buy food and essentials for Open Hands, St. Anthony's and St. Francis. The coupons helped him buy more."

"When Steve became ill, we talked a lot about how much we valued our time in Catholic school. Steve and Tom's families were not wealthy. I lived with my grandparents who didn't struggle quite as much. All three of us were so thankful to attend a school with values. No one was ever mean to us. At that time, if you received tuition assistance you would work at school. Steve and Tom helped as custodians. Not once did anyone give them a hard time."

Before his death, Radman was providing one-half of a scholarship to a student at Christian Brothers and he had recently sponsored a seat for the Visual & Performing Arts campaign.

"Steve loved attending Christian Brothers and Bishop Armstrong," says Rowe. "He encouraged all of our classmates to support the school because he knew it provided a place where abilities are recognized and nurtured, and where young people are given a sense of purpose in life and encouraged to be their best. Several weeks before he died, Steve told me that he wanted to transfer one of his annuities over to the school. It meant so much to him to be able to help. I was worried that he hadn't had the time. I was so relieved that I cried when I found out that he had done it."

"We are so grateful to Steve for his generosity and friendship over the years," says Paul Rieschick, director of advancement. "His generosity leaves a legacy that will benefit students for generations to come. His \$130,000 annuity bequest will be directed to the Visual & Performing Arts building and will establish an endowed tuition assistance scholarship. Like Br. Bertram, Steve knew firsthand that the gift of education lasts a lifetime and that the gift of a Catholic, Lasallian education is priceless."

The Brother Bertram Society was founded in 1994 in honor of Brother Bertram Coleman, FSC. Brother Bert, as he was affectionately known, was one of the most well known and respected religious leaders in Northern California. The society includes persons and couples who made provisions for Christian Brothers High School in their estate plans and is a vital component in CB's future endeavors. Trip-of-a-Lifetime for Daniel Cox '09

Daniel Cox '09 enjoyed the trip-of-a-lifetime in May as he traveled to Tanzania with the Drake University football team as a player in the first official *American football* game ever played on the continent of Africa.



Drake played, and ultimately beat, an all-star team from Mexico, the CONADEIP All-Stars, representing the CONADEIP Conference, in the inaugural Global Kilimanjaro Bowl on May 21, 2011.

After the historic game, players from both schools participated in community service projects in and around the town of Moshi. The primary project focused on building a girls' dormitory at the Kitaa Hope Orphanage, which houses children between 4 and 12 years old who have been orphaned by HIV/AIDS.

"It was amazing to see how happy and resilient the children are, despite the challenges they've had in their lives. It felt good to help and I definitely plan to do more for them in the future."

As for experiencing Tanzania, Cox was initially surprised by the high level of security. "We were told that that before we arrived, the city was swept for Somali extremists who had threatened our hotel. At all times, we had at least two guards with machine guns with us wherever we went. But, the people were incredible."

During the final phase of the trip, players and coaches from both teams plan to climb the imposing 19,340-foot Mount Kilimanjaro -- the tallest mountain in Africa. The teams ascended Mount Kilimanjaro by different routes, culminating their climbs by meeting at the summit and hoisting their respective *university* and national flags.

"Climbing that mountain was a life-achievement," says Cox. "It was by far the hardest physical and mental challenge that I have ever faced. I'm so glad I had this experience."


