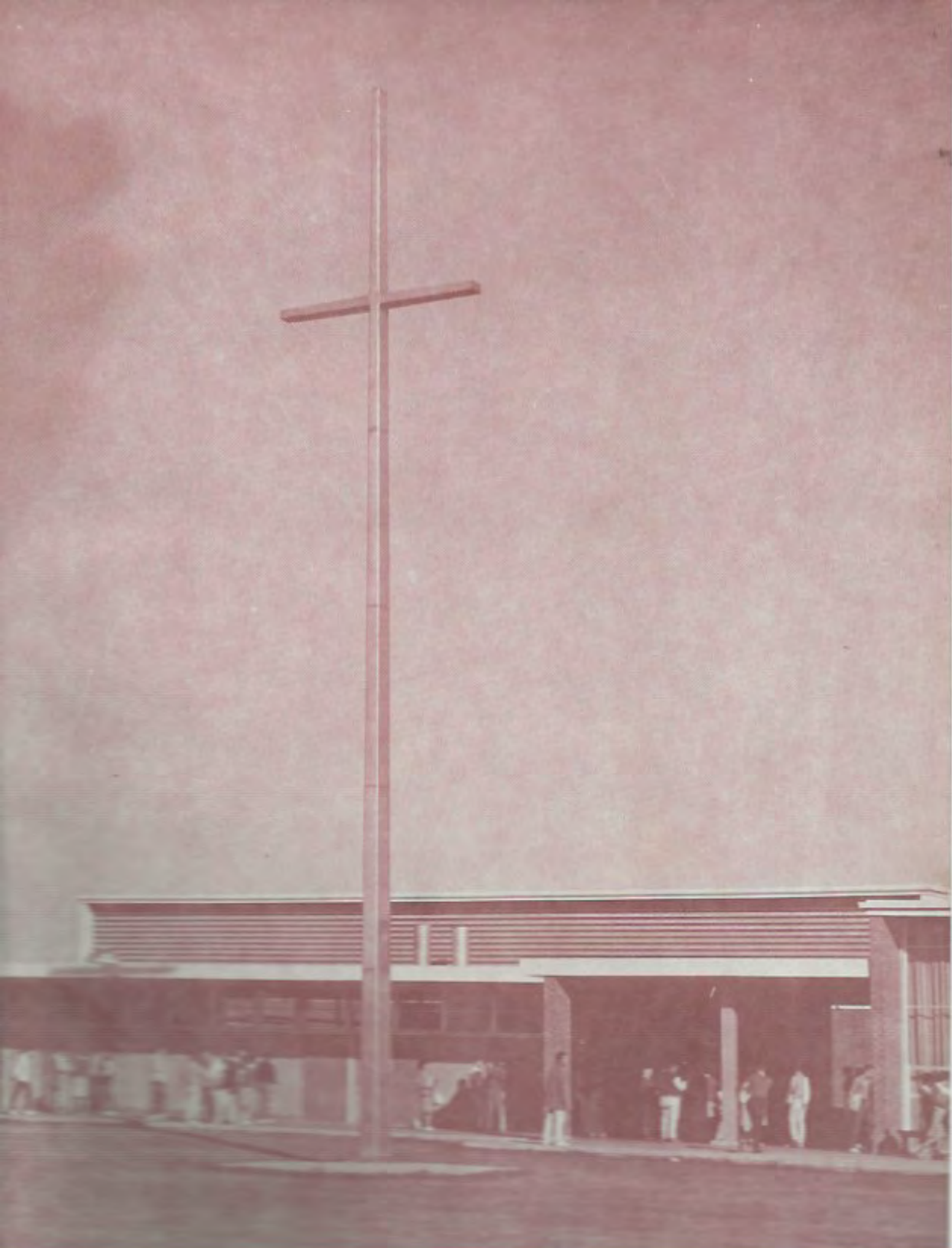



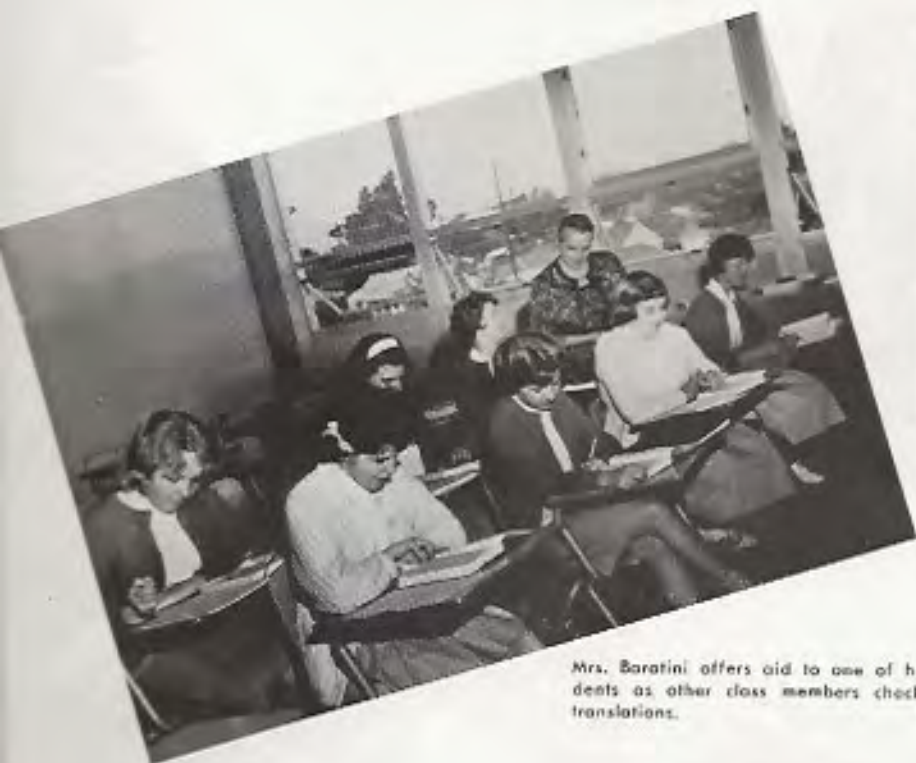
A school without students,

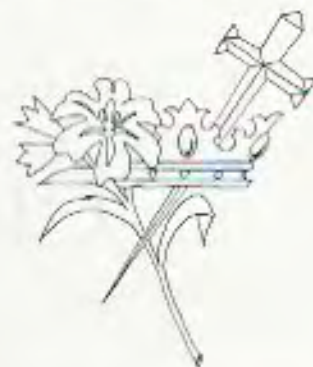
