# Brothers, Jesuit Tangle In Fifth Annual

Tonight's Holy Bowl clash will probably be another in the topsy-turvey, unpredictable series where being the favorite team has proven to be a decided disadvantage. In three of the four past games the favorite team has fallen.

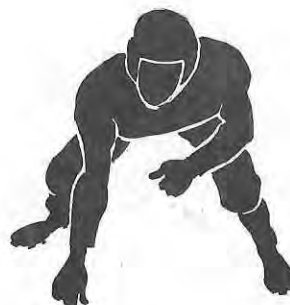
Tonight's game pits the Metro champs, Christian Brothers, fresh off their satisfying 20-12 victory over the tough Sac Dragons, against the Jesuit eleven, second place finisher in the Golden Empire league.

Three factors may be in Jesuit's favor tonight. First, Brothers may be looking past the Marauders to the playoffs. Next weekend Brothers play El Camino with the winner going against the winner of the Grant-Norte contest the following Friday for the top spot in Northern California.

Secondly, Brothers will encounter a tough defense in Jesuit. Jesuit held potent Norte to a single touchdown while scoring 35 when they trounced the North Metro finalists earlier this season in a non-league match. Third, Jesuit comes into this contest a definite underdog to the front-running Falcons . . . and that has to be a plus for the Marauders.

Brothers, however, is no stranger to handling the tough ones and they do not plan to forget the sobering lesson that Larry McGovern and company taught them last year in the fog at State's field.

Included in Brothers 8 win - 1 loss record are victories over three of the area's top squads,



including playoff-bound El Camino [33-6] and Vacaville [34-20].

Leading the balanced Brothers attack is quarterback Jeff Tisdel whose passing and running rank him as a leader in passing and total yardage in the Sacramento area. Joining Jeff are hard-running Chris Gandy and clever Junior Joe Greco who lead the CB runners. Tisdel has excellent receivers in All-League Dan Farrell, speedy Bob Bingham and strong Eason Ramson. Defensively the Marauders will have to contend with All-Everything Brica Ragster, Linebacker Bill Boughton, Kurt Schirmer and a gang-tackling group of Falcons.

Dan Barrett, who scored two touchdowns in last year's game, will be leading Jesuit. If his ankle is right, watch Carlton Adams a speedy Marauder back. And strong running back Steve Wright should prove difficult for the Falcons to contain. If the game is settled by the foot, watch for Mike Jahnke, the Jesuit expert at the field goal and extra point. Defensively, Jesuit ranks in the top ten in the Metropolitan area. The match between Dave Michaelmore [6-4, 210] and the Falcon's Brica Ragster should give a clue to who's going to win tonight's game.

All in all, it looks like a good night for the fans to take in what is fast becoming the biggest annual game in Northern California.

## CHRISTIAN BROTHERS OFFENSE

**Tight End - Eason Ramson (6-2, 185)**  
Solid Blocker and good receiver. From Immaculate Conception.

**Left Tackle - Brica Ragster (5-11, 215)**  
Three time all Metro League; one of the best linemen in the state. From All Hallows.

**Left Guard - Bill Boughton (5-10, 187)**  
Three year offensive starter. Great pulling guard. From St. Charles.

**Center - Mark Franzoia (5-10, 175)**  
Learned position quickly after soph starter Lindy Smith was sidelined for season. From St. Mary's.

**Right Guard - Steve Hennessy (5-9, 165)**  
Very intelligent player; quite quick. From St. Roberts.

**Right Tackle - John Hurtzig (6-1, 200)**  
Started at guard last year but moved to tackle by necessity and has done fine job. From Sacred Heart.

**Split End - Dan Farrell (6-2, 180)**  
Only a junior but already holds school career receiving records after all league soph season. From St. Anne's.

**Quarterback - Jeff Tisdell (6-0, 176)**  
Holds all time CB single year and career passing records. From St. Charles.

**Fullback - Joe Greco (5-7, 160)**  
Combines with Gandy to give CB great 1-2 rushing punch. Fine blocker. From St. Charles.

**Left Half - Chris Gandy (6-3, 204)**  
Big strong running back from St. Anne's. Best Falcon rusher since 1961.

**Right Half - Bob Bingham (6-0, 175)**  
Fastest man on Falcon squad; combines with Farrell to give CB best wide receivers in the city. Caught 25 passes in '72.

**Possible Center starter - Doug Osbourne (6-2, 190)**  
Switched to center when Lindy Smith was hurt and has done good job. From St. Charles.

## CHRISTIAN BROTHERS DEFENSE

**Left End - Dennis Gauthier (5-6, 140)**  
The smallest Falcon regular but hits as hard as a bigger man. From St. Lawrence parish.

**Left Tackle - John Hurtzig**  
Strength and quickness are John's defensive assets.

**Middle Guard - Brica Ragster**  
Leads area linemen in tackles.

**Right Tackle - Steve Hennessy**  
Outweighed by every opponent this year, he still ranks among area leaders in tackles.

**Right End - Kurt Schirmer (6-2, 178)**  
Two year regular who uses quickness and great speed to advantage at his position. From Holy Family parish.

**Linebacker - Chris Gandy**  
All league in 1972; opponents generally run away from his side.

**Linebacker - Bill Boughton**  
Leading tackler in area; great form and lateral agility.

**Linebacker - Joe Greco**  
Plays his outside position intelligently; good form.

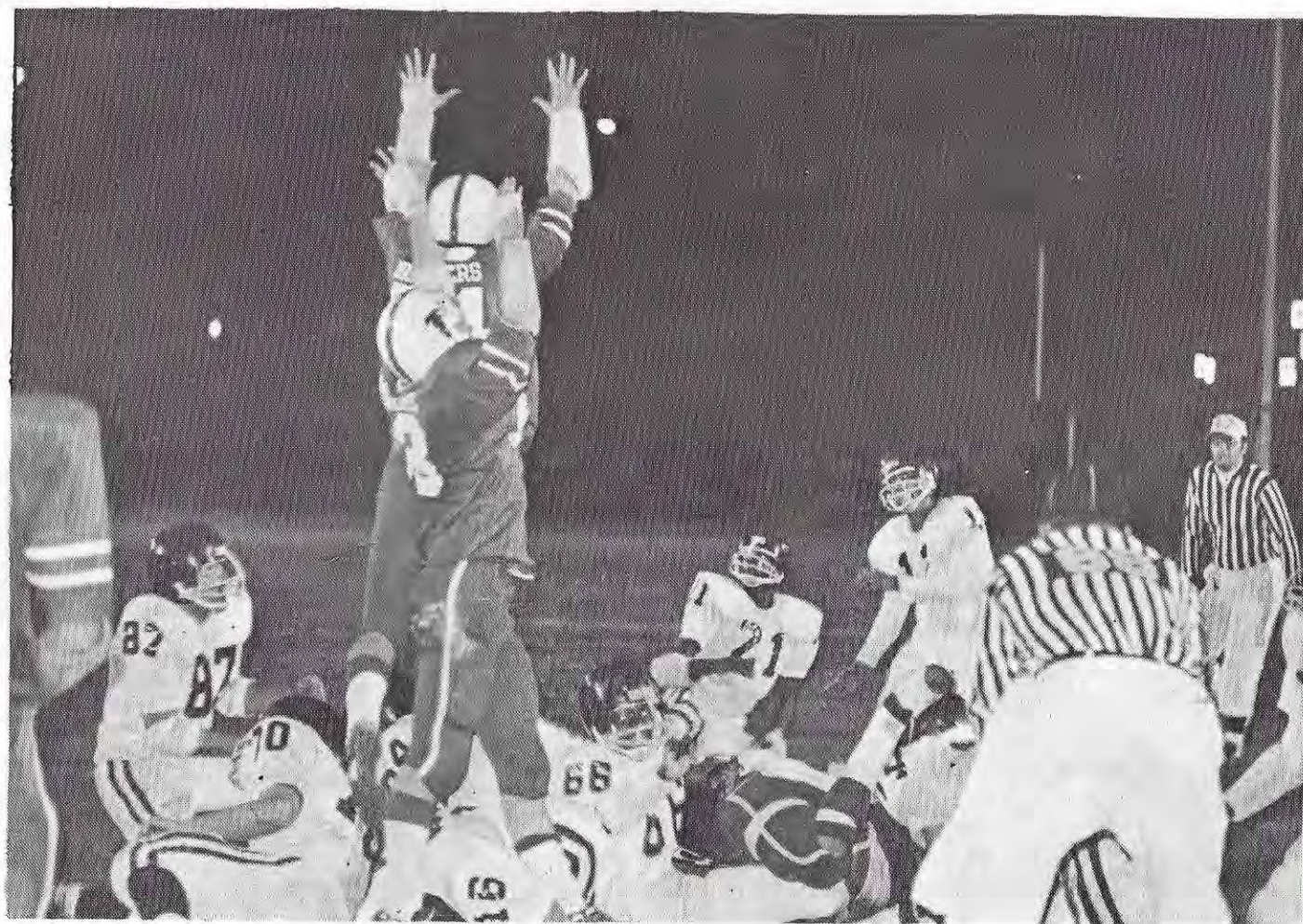
**Safety - Bob Bingham**

# History of the Holy Bowl

The first Holy Bowl was played on November 22, 1969. Both teams entered the game with excellent season records, CB with an 8-2 record and Jesuit at 7-2-1. Christian Brothers won this one by a score of 20-13.

Both teams stayed mainly on the ground. Jesuit's Joe Mangiscina rushed for 128 yards while Christian Brothers had Dennis Bertacchi with 96 yards and Danny Galvez with 100 yards. Scoring touchdowns for Christian Brothers were Dennis Bertacchi with 2 and Rick Cobral with 1. Scoring for Jesuit were Kirt Foley and Joe Mangiscina each with a single score. Winning the JV game was Christian Brothers by a score of 20-0.

## II

The second Holy Bowl saw Jesuit pulling off a close victory. Jesuit scored with 1:27 to go in the game and convert 2 extra points to slip by Brothers, 8-7. Scoring the winning touchdown for Jesuit was Joe Raterman with Mark Russell going across for CB.

Gaining the yardage were Mark Russell, 36 yards, and Jesse Hernandez, 45 yards, for Brothers. For Jesuit it was Joe Raterman, 59 yards and Mike Smith with 72. Dan Carmazzi went 6 for 13 for 84 yards in the passing department.

## III

Holy Bowl III was not one of the more exciting games of the past, Christian Brothers winning easily, 40-7. Big man on the Christian Brothers team was Mark Gabrielli with 177 yards and one touchdown. Also scoring for Brothers were Steve Kitlas with two TD's, Mark Santiago also with two and Frank Aiello with one. Putting the lone points on the board for Jesuit was Mark Costi. The CB JV team also pulled off a big victory, 39-17.

Last year, Jesuit came into the game two point underdogs and came out on top by three touchdowns. Contributing to Jesuit's victory were Larry McGovern who went 13 for 31 and 175 yards and Dan Barret with two touchdowns. On the ground, CB gained 44 yards with Jesuit getting 61. Helping Brothers was Jeff Tisdell who went 11 for 13 and 120 yards. Again this year, Christian Brothers pulled off a victory in the sophomore contest, 14-0.

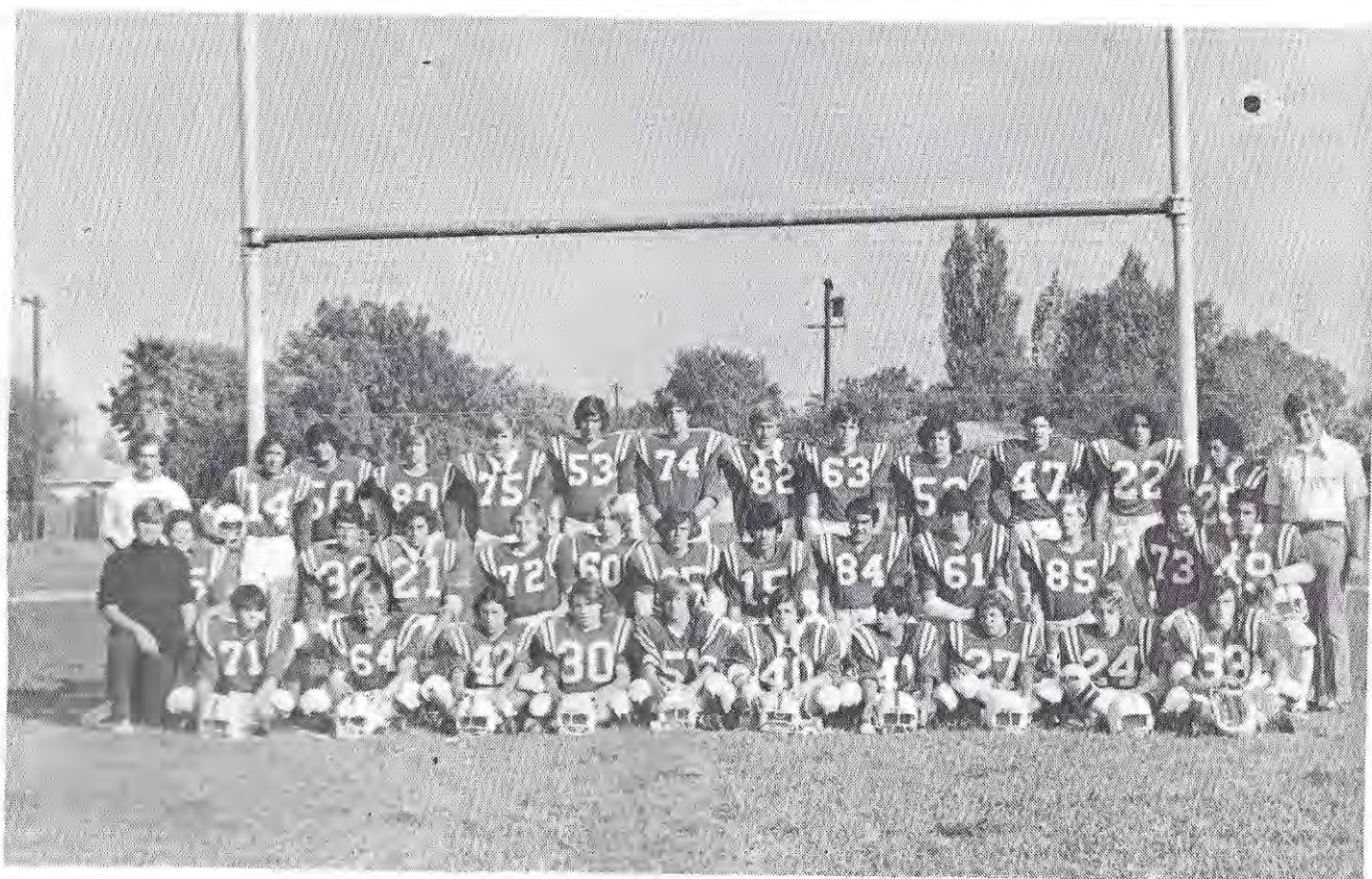
