300 YEAR**

This year **Christian Brothers** around the world celebrate the 300th anniversary of the founding of their religious order.

The celebration was officially begun May 15, the feast day of the French founder, **St. John Baptist de la Salle**, and will continue until May 15, 1981.

The **Christian Brothers** — formally named the Institute of the Brothers of the **Christian Schools** — were founded in 1680 in Rheims, France, to provide Christian education mainly, though not exclusively, for children of the poor and working class.

Education in the days of the order's founding saint was a luxury only the rich could afford. Children of nobility were tutored on a one-to-one basis. **De La Salle** radically changed the system by innovating the present multi-student classroom structure.

Today, **Christian Brothers** number 10,200 and work in 1,420 houses in 80 countries.

The order consists exclusively of non-ordained **Brothers**. In addition to their religious vows of poverty, chastity and obedience, they take vows to persevere in their vocation and to teach without personal recompense.

In the United States there are 1,650 **Brothers** divided into eight provinces. They operate more than 230 institutions, including colleges, high schools, elementary schools, community centers and retreat houses.

In Sacramento the **Brothers** have conducted a school for 104 years, coming here in 1876 at the invitation of Father Scanlon. Except for temporary quarters in transition periods, the school has had three locations: 12 & K

Streets, 21st and Broadway and currently at Sacramento Boulevard. From 1957-1964 the **Brothers** had the 9th and 10th grades with elementary classes at the 21st and Broadway site while the juniors and seniors shared the Sacramento Blvd. building with girls from St. Joseph and St. Francis high schools in a co-instructional school — Bishop Armstrong High School. In 1965 the latter property became a four year high school for boys and the name **Christian Brothers High School** was re-adopted in 1968.

Throughout the province, each **Christian Brothers** institution will hold individual tercentenary celebrations during the coming year. As a province, the **Brothers** will have a two-day convocation at St. Mary's College, Moraga, December 29-30, to discuss the spirituality of their founder, his charism and its application in society today.

Superior General Brother Pablo Basterrechea is slated to come to California March 7-11, 1981, to participate in a civic celebration and liturgy at St. Mary's Cathedral, San Francisco.

St. Mary's College alumni Association will sponsor a civic banquet at the Fairmont Hotel, San Francisco, October 24 to honor the tricentennial of the founding of the **Brothers**.

In Sacramento, the **Christian Brothers High School** Alumni Association will dedicate its Annual Alumni Dinner, November 21, to the 300th anniversary of the **Brothers**, having as its principal speaker an alumnus, **Brother Norman James Cook**, '47, currently the Provincial of the West Coast Province.

HISTORY OF THE

Today's **Holy Bowl** marks the 10th contest in this series between **Christian Brothers** and **Jesuit**. It has rapidly established itself as the premier football attraction of the local prep season.

The title "**Holy Bowl**" was a creation of Sacramento Union sports writer Steve Heath prior to the initial, 1969 contest. In that year, **Christian Brothers** won 21-13. **Brothers** was sparked by the running of back **Dennis Bertacchi** and **Danny Galvez** who gained 100 yards each.

The second classic in 1979 brought together two league champions, **Brothers** was paced by **Jim Sarti**, **Dan Carmazzi**, **John Blachard**, **Stan Olsufka** and **Tom O'Neil**. **Jesuit** won it on a wild two point conversion scrambled by sophomore quarterback **Dano McGinn**, in for his only play of the game, in the

last minute of play, ruining an undefeated season for **Brothers**.

Holy Bowl III saw running back **Mark Gabrielli** of **Brothers** gain 202 yards and lead them to a 40 to 7 win.

In 1972 behind the fine passing combo of **Larry McGovern** to **Marty Kloser**, **Jesuit** won 20 to 0.

In 1973 in a driving rain storm **Brothers** and **Jesuit** fought to a 0-0 tie.

Passing had not been much of a factor in any games except in 1972, but it sure was in **Holy Bowl VI**. The **Falcons** rode 10 brilliant catches by All American end **Dan Farrell** and 450 total offensive yards (309 on passes) into a 53-28 rout of **Jesuit**.

In 1975 the **Jesuit Marauders** put it all together, a picture-perfect 99 yard drive in the second quarter, then utilized a

strong defensive effort to stop **Brothers** with a 7-6 win.

The eighth game was somewhat like the '73 and '75 games, the rains came. **The Marauders** sloshed to a 13-6 triumph.

The series was cancelled in '77 and '78 due to conflicts with City football playoffs.

In 1979 the series started again. **Mark Murphy** passed for three touchdowns and **Dave Perreira** carried the ball eight times for 108 yards and scored three times, to lead **Brothers** to a 53-14 win.

Tonight's game should truly be listed as a toss-up, each team has won four games with one tie. As usual the form book can be thrown out the window. You can bet the thrills will be there. 1980??
