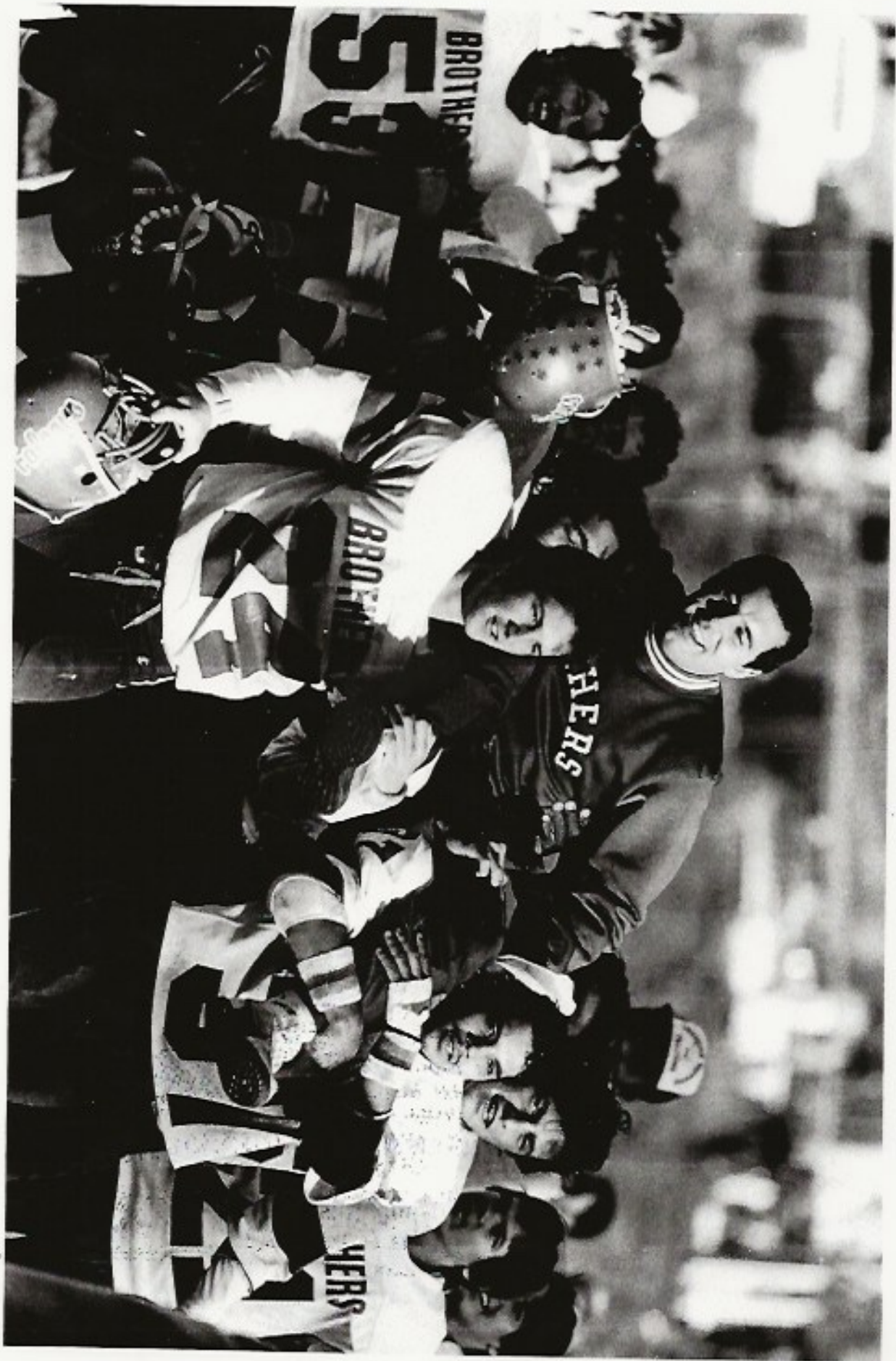

# CBS' 4th-Quarter Surge Edges Vintage

## Barros' OT Boot Game-Winner

Steve Barros' claim to fame at Christian Brothers High School was always as a soccer player.

Just a month ago, he was playing forward for the Falcon team which won the Sac-Joaquin Section soccer championship. A week later, he was named to the All-Metro team.

If he thought that was a good feeling, he hadn't seen anything yet.

Barros, who at 5-foot-4 and 140 pounds can easily get lost in a CBS zuddle, booted a 22-yard field goal in overtime Friday night, lifting the Falcons to a 15-12 victory over Vintage to win the section AAA football championship. It was CBS' second section crown in three years and allowed the Falcons to finish the season 13-1.

The game at Hughes Stadium drew 8,500 fans.

For Barros, the kick was an act of redemption. Earlier in the game, Barros had one extra-point kick blocked and shanked another that would have won the game for the Falcons in regulation.
