Pioneer golf team hits the fairways as girls sports thrive at CB

looked at the scores from this year, and I think we can do it.”

The golfers were hardly the only CB girls to outdo themselves in sports this year. The girls varsity volleyball team was the pride of the campus as it became the first girls team in CB history to win a section championship, defeating nationally ranked Ripon High before heading to the NorCal tournament.

Not to be outdone, the JV and freshman girls volleyball teams posted 13-2 and 13-0 records this fall, respectively, and a youngish girls tennis team defeated rival Loretto while sending freshman star Kelly Leathers to the section semifinals. And there's more to come this year as other girls teams complete their seasons.

Cheering the girls on is Greg Meegan, CB's athletic director. "One of the reasons I came here instead of remaining at Jesuit," he says, "was for the opportunity to become a part of a coeducational environment.

"For many years, there have been limited opportunities for women in high school sports while the boys' programs flourished. Here at CB, we have been able to experience building a quality girls program with absolutely no deterioration in the offerings for boys.

"It is exciting to see girls deeply

Not so many years ago, Sally Sylva was a practically-since-the-cradle golfer from West Sacramento, the only girl on her Woodland High School golf team. The only female golfer in the Delta League.

"It was great to be the only girl," she recalls. "But it would have been really nice to have some other girls around."

Sylva started living that dream this year. So did the 17 players she coached as Christian Brothers launched its first women's varsity golf team, participating in a California Interscholastic Federation-sanctioned program that has given young women the chance to plot a course — the nine-hole variety — of their own.

"It's not just us making history," says Sylva, who is now the mother of two elementary-age children and the

wife of CB alumnus/activist Chuck Sylva. "For all the other (Metro League) schools as well, it's the first official women's golf subsection and section. For everybody, this was a history-making season."

Some schools, like St. Francis and Loretto, have fielded women's golf teams in past years, but "they all played against boys," Sylva says. This year, girls teams played their own season in the fall while the boys will take to the courses this spring.

And how did our pioneers fare? "Our top three players made it to the (Sac-Joaquin) section tournament," says Sylva, and the team took fourth place in the Metro League.

"They exceeded our expectations," the coach says. "My expectation for next year is that we'll make our subsections as a team, versus as individuals. I would expect us to make sections as a team also. I

The annual Alumni Fund Appeal will take place in March. When you receive a letter or call from one of our Board members or a CBHS student, please be kind and generous.

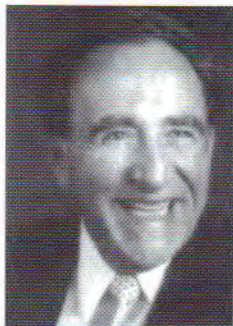

were CBers. In the good ol' days there were enough Rooneys and O'Neils to field complete ball clubs to play each other.

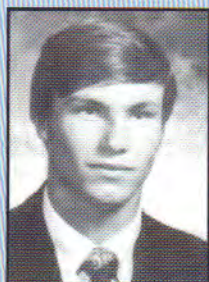

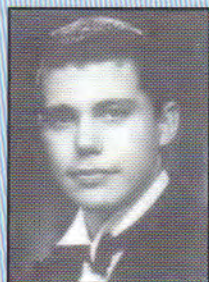

involved in interscholastic sports and successfully competing with some of the best programs in the state. Every year we get more and more girls out for our teams, and every year our entire school population is enriched by the experience."

Jill Bennett, CB's only female PE teacher as well as the girls freshman basketball coach, also takes the girls' successes in pride-filled stride. She has watched — and helped as a teacher, coach and, until about 1995, assistant athletic director — CB girls sports grow since the campus went coed a decade ago.

"I think the (girls sports) evolution, like the transition to coed, has gone a lot more smoothly than anticipated," Bennett says.

In the mid-1990s, she says, "all of a sudden we had our breakthrough. ... Softball was the first program to get a Metro title — that was about four years ago. We've always been in, like, the top three, and we've been very competitive. All of our programs have gone to playoffs. We haven't taken all the Metro titles, but we have gone to playoffs, and we've done very well."

Bennett acknowledges that the biggest headlines, here and elsewhere, are still reserved for high school football games. But she says support is growing among students and alumni for other campus sports, including the girls teams.

"I truly don't feel there are any secondary citizens on this campus," she says, noting that the girls basketball team has drawn bigger crowds this year, partly because of Friday night games. "The girls have gone out and earned respect. ...

"The pride on campus has evolved, too, with pride in the women's sports as much as the guys' sports. For a lot of alumni, it was difficult (at first) to relate to this as a coed school, so most interest and

discussion was directed toward the guys. Now that we have female alumni and everything (about going coed) is settled, there isn't that distinction. ... It's really inclusive. ...

"We compete. ... And golf is another avenue where we can do that."

Named the most valuable player on CB's pioneering golf team was Vanessa Jorrin, who ranked as the No. 2 individual qualifier in the Metro League tournament and achieved a No. 5 ranking in the Central Sub-Section tournament before heading to Sac-Joaquin sectionals.

"Vanessa was involved in minority golf and the SAY-Golf (Sacramento Area Youth Golf Association) program here in town, but didn't have the



opportunity to play high school golf. With the formation of the girls team, she was able to come and play on a school team," says Sylva.

Others making the most of the new opportunity were the team's No. 2 and 3 players, junior Melissa Lee and senior Rhiannon White, and the most improved player, sophomore Stephanie Reyes. Rounding out the team, which achieved a winning 12-9 overall record in its first season, were Katy Bryant, Megan Burford, Monica Davis, Lindsey Franzoia, Maria Gayton (the No. 4 player, who made it to the Metro League tournament), Jennifer Huls, Sarah Lauer, Sara Lygren, Eagan Patterson, Mary Perez, Michelle Takehara, Erin Tessman and Jennifer Tsuda.

"Some of them had never played golf before. Some didn't have their own equipment," says Sylva. "Some had some experience but hadn't really played any competition. ... But by the end of the season, all of them could play nine holes in about 2^o hours. Most of them were in the 60s for nine holes, but it was a really good start."

Meegan agrees. "The addition of women's golf this year substantiates

all that I have said about our women's interscholastic sports program," he says. A large number of girls came out for the first-year team, he notes,

"and we are already talking about adding a JV team in the near future. One of the reasons we are moving to the Sierra Valley Conference is because of that league's commitment to quality women's teams."

The golfers — who spent two to three hours a day, four days a week at practices and matches, mostly at the Land Park course run by SAY-Golf — weren't the only ones on a new adventure this year. "I actually had never coached before," says Sylva, who was hired as assistant coach for the fall season under the tutelage of boys varsity golf coach Rick Green. She'll have the head coach title in the coming season, as husband Chuck shoulders more of the get-the-kids-to-

soccer role for the family.

"I've always wanted to coach a team but never had an opportunity to," she says. "I approached (principal) Tom Rutten before last year and asked him, 'Have you ever thought of having a girls team?' He said, 'Well, yes, we are — this coming season.' ... I said I'd love to do something, anything, as long as I was involved."

Green showed her the ropes and helped with training, Sylva said, but let her run the team. "He was there to show me the paperwork that needs to be done, the rules, how to relate to the other coaches, how to handle parents and players — to give me his insights and experience in coaching. ... It was really worthwhile."

Starting from scratch, Sylva and Green set their sights on building the program from enthusiasm on up. "The most important thing we did was not cut anyone. We said, 'If you want to be on this team, you'll be on this team,'" says Sylva.

"We didn't approach it saying we're going to have the championship team this year. We said we're going to teach these girls who come out how to play golf, the etiquette of golf, how

to move around a course — and develop a love of the game so that ... they'll continue to come out for the team and we'll slowly build up from that point."

The coaches were impressed by the CB girls' interest. "We weren't sure we were actually going to be able to field a team this year," says Sylva. "We needed four girls to field a team for the Metro League. ... We had signups the previous spring and got seven girls. Then in the fall, we made an announcement in the bulletin and had 26 girls show up. From that, 17 stuck around for the team."

"Just having that many interested is going to be a great benefit. ... I don't think we're going to have any problems building a team."

The girls' high spirits extended well past the signup sheet. "The group overall is very cohesive," says Sylva. "They just gelled really well. One of the players made them each a swing counter out of beads — little things like that. I didn't tell them to do it, they just did it."

Such team spirit gratifies the woman who remembers being the only girl on the Woodland High team. "I think there is a certain camaraderie you get on a team that is all girls versus a girl playing on a boys team," says Sylva.

Team parents pitched in, too. "We would be out at matches, and we'd probably have three or four parents gallerying — walking the course and watching the

players. It was the most of any team in the Metro League. It was really heartening to see that."

Sylva also credits SAY-Golf, which let the CB team use its Land Park facilities free of charge and even lent two instructors in the early weeks, for helping the girls get in the swing. "They have some wonderful putting greens that are nice and big — that you can put 17 girls on and not run everybody else off."

Beyond building toward team championships in coming years, Sylva sees a broader purpose in her new career as a girls golf coach: "I have always felt that sports is a great way for girls to gain in self-confidence, poise and self-esteem. It gives them a good feeling about themselves when they can succeed in something — in the classroom but also out of the classroom.

"Golf is something the girls are going to continue to play all their lives — it's a sport they

can play until they're in their 80s and enjoy. Hopefully they will remember their time on the team here and be willing to give back in the future."

Meegan also sees girls golf fitting into bigger goals — for the school as well as the players. "Sports at our school favors no gender, and that is the way things are supposed to be," he says. "It is a real plus for our school community to be the only Catholic high school in the Sacramento metropolitan area that truly represents our society as it exists.

"We live in a mixed-gender society, and here at CB, we support that reality rather than shy away from its existence." ♦

CLASS OF 1930 IN MEMORIAM

Jim Flynn, '30, one of Christian Brothers' most illustrious alumni and one of Sacramento's best loved sports figures, died July 31. He was 86.

"The Coach," a three-sport athlete as a high schooler, returned to his alma mater in 1935, with a brand new degree from Saint Mary's College, and took over what had become a moribund football program.

He immediately turned things around, beating powerhouse Sacramento High; which had been running up monumental scores against CBHS, that year by a 7-0 margin. (To prove it was no fluke, his Gaels, as they then were known, did a repeat in 1936, doubling the score to 14 and holding the Dragons scoreless once again.)

The city schools, deciding they couldn't beat the smiling Irishman, hired him, for the Sacramento High faculty, where he coached and served as chairman of the athletic department—with time out for wartime service as a Navy Officer — until his retirement in 1973.

Jim is survived by his wife, Alyce; a son, Dr. Michael Flynn, '60, a Sacramento dentist; daughter, Colleen Anderson, '62, History Department chairperson at Del Campo High, and four grandchildren.

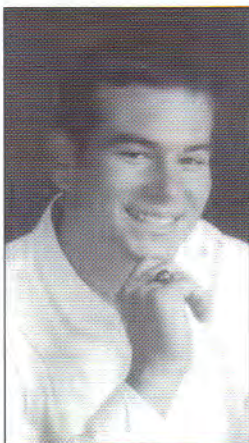

The Tenacious Life and Times of Thomas A. Bass

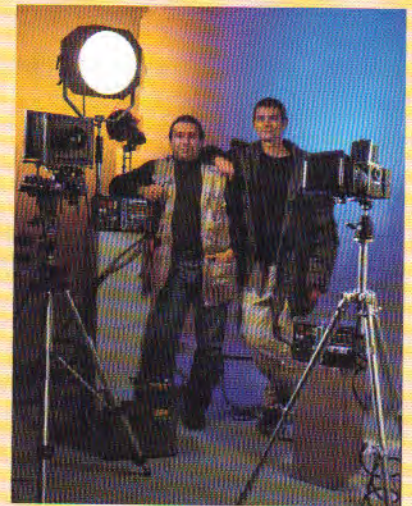

has suffered from Alzheimer's disease since 1995, the life of a professional photographer requires, "a great deal of tenacity, when sometimes talent is not enough."

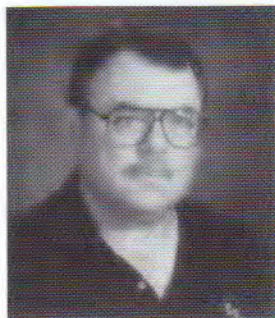

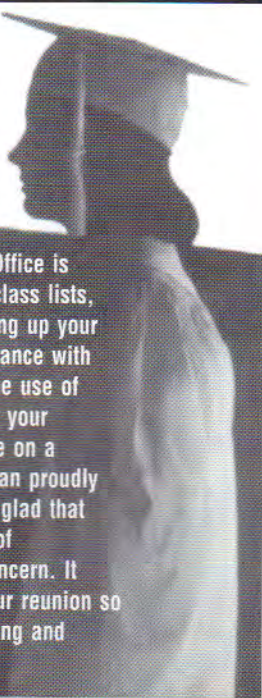
