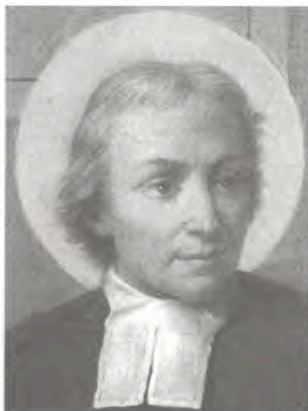

### BILL '68 AND ELAINE '68 SCHAEGLER

Friends introduced Bill Schaedler to Elaine Panattoni in 1966, early in their junior year of high school. To hear them say it, they've been dating ever since. Married for 35 years, the couple raised three children (Lori, Tim and Joanna), launched a successful dental practice, and through it all, remained connected and supportive of the schools they say prepared them for success in college and in life.

Elaine, a member of the first graduating class of Bishop Manogue High School, fondly remembers coming over to Bishop Armstrong each day for science class. "Back then, while we were waiting for the Bishop Manogue High School campus to be finished, we would attend classes at St. Joseph's Academy and then go to Bishop Armstrong for science during the last class of the day," explains Elaine. "I really became attached to the school and the campus in those classes."

Bill remembers the camaraderie and friendships that continue to this day; and, the dedication of the teachers who were, and are, inspirations in his life. "I will never forget coming back to a CB football game about 10 years after I graduated and hearing Ron Limeberger '53 yelling my name across the parking lot," recalls Bill. "Jack Witry did the same thing. It's remarkable and unique to be associated with a school that has such longevity and tradition."

The tradition runs deep in both of their families as well. Their fathers, uncles, brothers and approximately 20 Schaedler and Panattoni cousins attended CB, including two of Elaine's uncles who actually went to school at the original campus on 12<sup>th</sup> and K streets.

Six years ago, at the urging of former President, Mark Warren, and friends, Rick '79 and Bobbi Pires '76, Bill joined the CB Alumni Association Board of Directors.

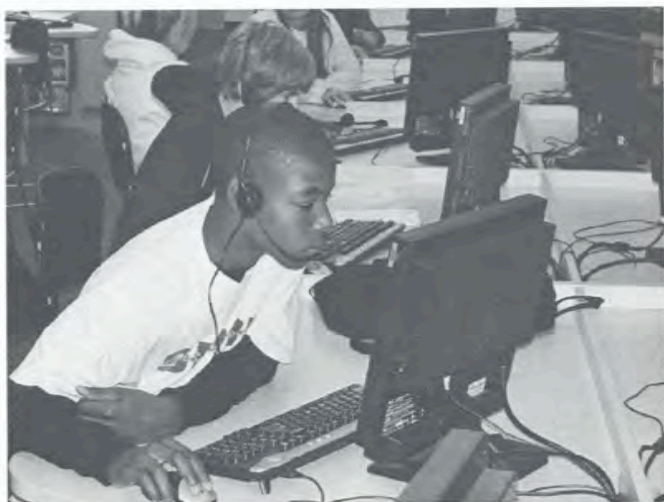

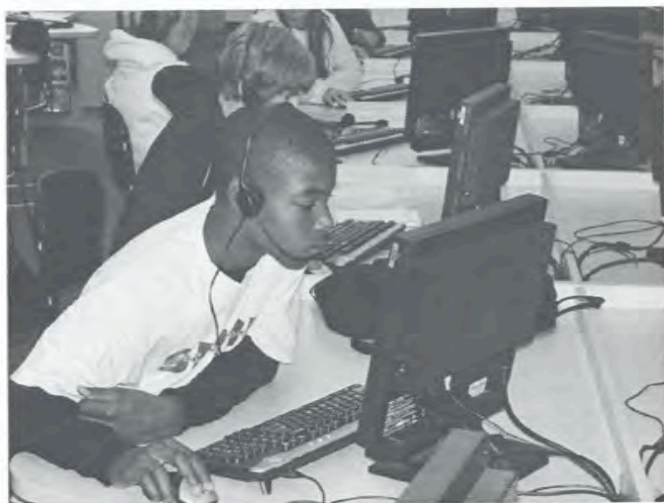
