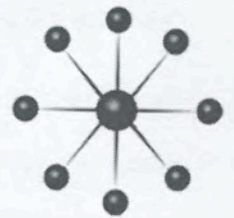
### About the Auctioneer

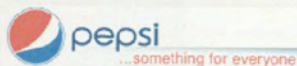
