
Welcome aboard the S.S. Falcon for an exciting cruise and auction.





Fund-An-Item

At tonight's auction you will have the opportunity to help us fund items in three diverse program areas for our school: athletics, music and video production.

Christian Brothers **sports facilities** have greatly improved in the past few years, with a renovated gym and the use of the home field for football games. However, the physical education program is in great need of upgrading the weight room for conditioning. Needed equipment includes Olympic sets, a treadmill and stationary bike. The upgrade of the weight room would benefit all students in the physical education classes and athletic programs.

Cost of Upgrades: \$3,000

Our **band program** has grown tremendously over the past few years. This year alone, we have two seniors who have been nationally recognized for their abilities. Christian Brothers hopes to offer the gift of music to all of our incoming freshman, including those who cannot afford their own instruments. Therefore, we have begun an effort to increase the number of school owned instruments to accommodate the large number of students who desire instrumental education.

Cost of additional instruments: \$1,000

Last month, Christian Brothers was once again honored by receiving the 2006 National Student Television 1st place award for a high school broadcast! This annual competition consists of over 300 high school entries. KBFT has been setting the standard nationwide and other schools use CB as an example for their own programs. As KBFT approaches the end of its' 4th year, there is a need to update or replace some of the technology necessary for the continued success of the program. Video editing is an essential part of broadcasting and it is this need for an updated system that we hope to address so that KBFT can remain the flagship of the nation and a jewel in CB's crown.

Cost of new video editing equipment: \$3,500

Total amount needed to fund all 3 items: \$7,500
