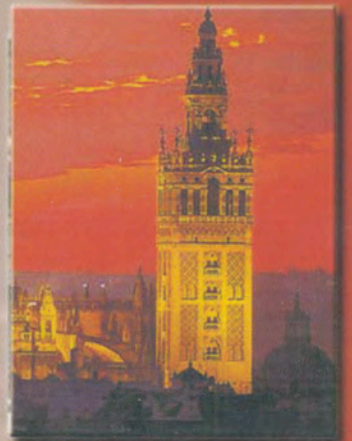

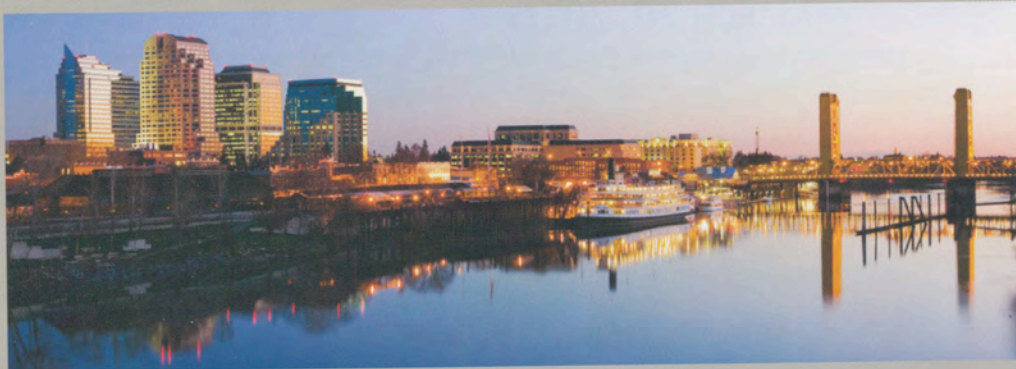

KBFT Stage and Set

KBFT is the student television station here at Christian Brothers High School. The station was founded in 2002, and is currently in its ninth school year of operation. **KBFT** broadcasts a live, closed circuit program to all students and staff as well as to a web audience three times per week. The "KBFT Morning News" is a ten to fifteen minute program that includes school announcements, world news, sports, weather and more. The show is entirely run by students.

The popularity and success of the **KBFT** program is evident in its accomplishments and awards over the years. **KBFT** has received national recognition by STN, the Student Television Network, and has been ranked as the #1 high school news broadcast in the nation in 2003, 2004, 2005, and 2006. **KBFT** was also awarded the number one live sports broadcast in the nation in 2007 and number one student broadcasting program in 2009. Several graduates of Christian Brothers High School who participated in **KBFT** have pursued careers in both television news and news media. Graduates have worked at local Sacramento stations KOVR, KCRA, Fox 40, KTXL, and the San Diego station KFMB.



As the number of participating students rise, the need for a permanent stage and set becomes more prevalent with each season. With your help, we can provide a state of the art green screen, stage and set backdrop for students to use in producing the award-winning news productions.

Make our performing arts students shine on stage with a new Leprecon two scene dimmer control board. The control board will allow the performing arts department to run stage lighting more efficiently and add more spotlights for better visual effects in their stage production.



In stage productions, lighting design helps to create the environment in which the action takes place while enhancing the style of the piece. Spotlights in stage productions are controlled by a dimmer system or lighting control board. The control boards regulate the intensity of the light, the focus of the spots, and special effects such as colored filters or patterns.



The Leprecon twelve channel LP-612 console, with full size fader knobs, quick action bump buttons, and big bright LED's, was designed and built to deliver professional results at an affordable price.
