TRAINING ROOM RETROFIT

At tonight's auction, you will have the opportunity to fund an important addition to our athletic training department.

With the construction of the new field house, we have a unique opportunity for our athletic program to expand and meet the needs of our 800 student-athletes. With your contributions, students will no longer need to be sent to other areas to perform rehabilitation exercises and rehab protocols or be sent away due to overcrowding. The training room facility will expand into an 1,100 square foot space to be equipped with additional treatment tables, two taping stations, upgraded ice machine, whirlpool, and the latest rehabilitation equipment. The addition of the upgraded training room facility will help prevent injuries, shorten rehab time, and return our athletes back to their sport in a timely manner.

In addition, our Athletic Trainer, Darci Stark, has developed a student athletic training program that introduces students to the assessment, treatment, rehabilitation, and prevention of athletic injuries. Many of these student athletic trainers plan on pursuing a profession in the medical field. This facility expansion will allow more students to participate in the Student Athletic Training Program.

During the live auction, Jack, our auctioneer, will ask for those of you who will pay \$50 towards the cost of the training room retrofit to hold up your bid card. The amount you indicate will be charged to your auction account and you may pay for your pledge with the rest of your auction purchases at check out. If you wish, you may hold your bid card up at more than one amount during the bidding.

We appreciate your generous help in reaching our goal tonight of covering the entire cost of the training room retrofit.
