## Andre Johansen

### The Ron Limeberger Coach of the Year

While 2009 marks Andre Johansen's fifth season at the helm of the Falcons, his presence and impact were felt immediately when he took a team that won only one game the previous year all the way to the play-offs and a second place finish in the Sierra Valley Conference (SVC) in just his first year of coaching.

Prior to coming to CB, Johansen served for two years as the defensive coordinator at Sunset High School in Hayward, and for six years as the defensive coordinator at his alma mater, Washington High School in Fremont.

"Coaching at Christian Brothers is a joy," says Johansen. "I have incredibly dedicated coaches and varsity, junior varsity, and freshmen players who are committed to building and strengthening the program. Further, the young men who choose to attend CB are not just quality athletes, they are quality young men and wonderful human beings."

In 2008, Johansen led the Falcons to a 7-4 record, capturing the SVC co-championship. He was named the SVC co-coach of the year and was selected to serve as the Optimist All-Star Football Game coach for the south team. The 2009 season is off to a fantastic start with a decisive 21-6 victory in the Holy Bowl.

"It is an honor to be in the company of these great coaches of the past," explains Johansen. "Although I never had the opportunity to meet Ron Limeberger, receiving an award named for a gentleman who played such a significant role in the history of Christian Brothers High School means the world to me."

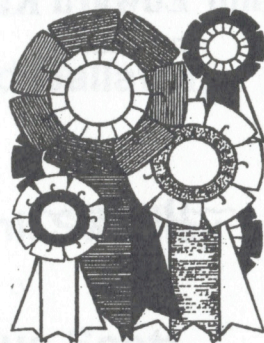

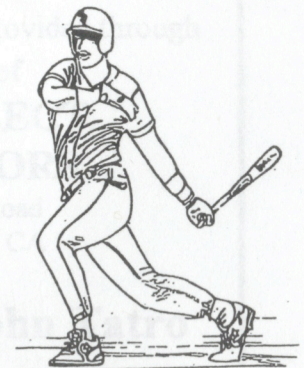


