Look through your eyes, and grasp the present you have been working for.




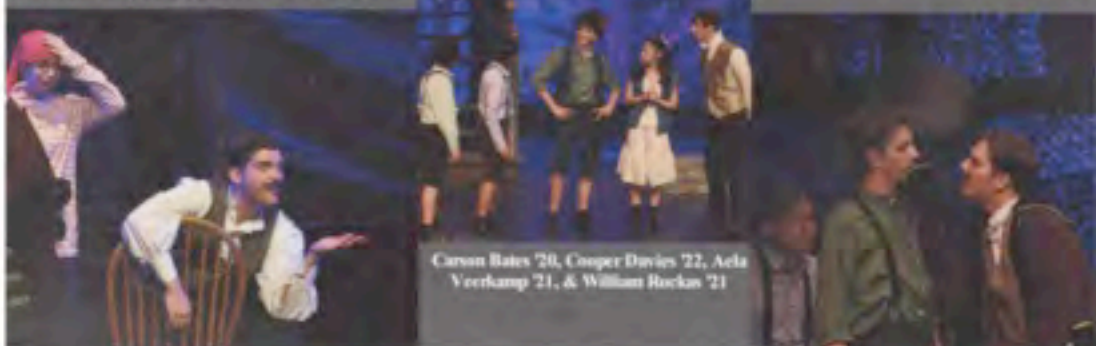

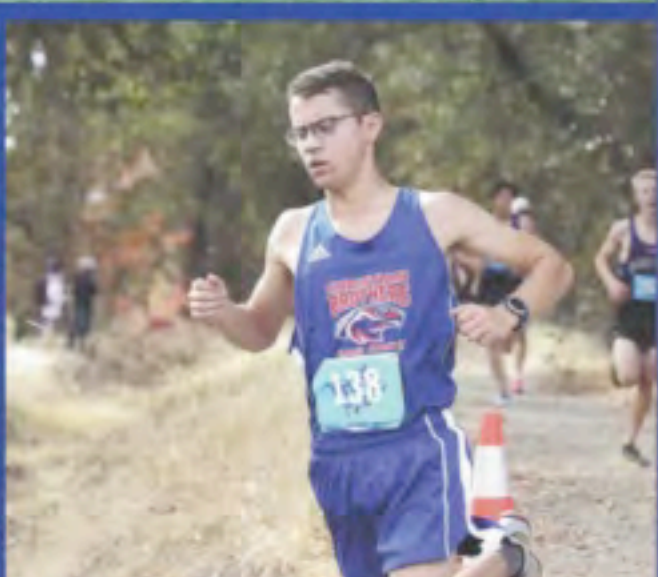

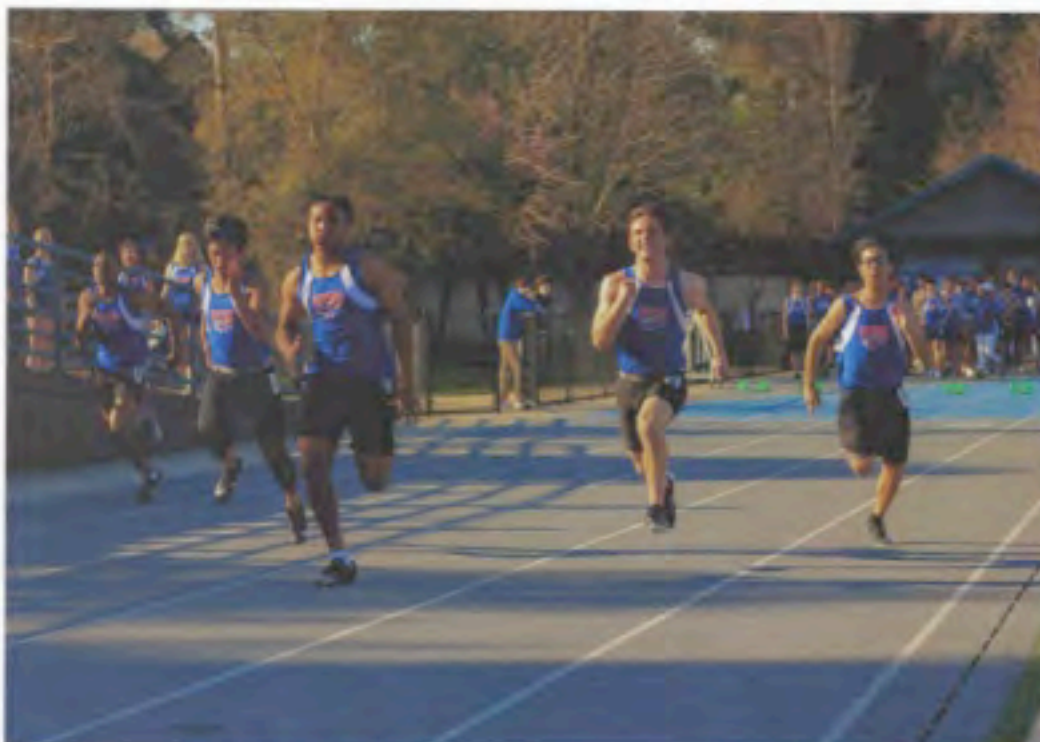

A YEAR IN REVIEW 2019-2020

HEADLINE NEWS

FIRST ALL-FEMALE SPACEWALK

NASA astronauts Christina Koch and Jessica Meir made history on Oct. 18 as the first women to participate in an all-female spacewalk. Koch and Meir braved a stroll outside the International Space Station to replace a power controller. The walk lasted 7 hours and 17 minutes as they spoke to NASA, shared their mission through cameras on their helmets and even voiced a call with President Trump.



IMPEACHMENT

The House of Representatives approved 2 articles of impeachment, which means to bring charges in Congress that will form the basis for a trial, against President Donald Trump. This made him the 3rd U.S. president after Andrew Johnson and Bill Clinton to face removal from office by the Senate. On February 5th, 2020, President Trump was acquitted of all charges.



ANCIENT CITY UNCOVERED

The lost city of Mahendraparvati was fully uncovered in Cambodia, after years of archeological investigation. The city, believed to be the first capital of the Khmer Empire during the 9th century, had long-evaded archaeologists due to the thick jungle obscuring the remaining buried urban network. Using research techniques from the ground and sky, researchers were able to fill in many aspects of the cityscape.

CORONAVIRUS PUTS WORLD ON HIGH ALERT

A coronavirus outbreak in Wuhan, China, prompted officials to issue the largest quarantine in human history, putting 16 cities with an estimated 46 million people on lockdown. The virus has spread to 21 countries, including the U.S. The respiratory virus infected thousands in China and claimed lives, causing countries to evacuate their citizens from areas near Wuhan and close their borders.

MILLIONS PROTEST FOR DEMOCRATIC RIGHTS

The world watched as millions took to the streets in different parts of the globe in the name of democratic rights. In Hong Kong, more than a million citizens protested the proposed China extradition bill, causing businesses all over the globe to face difficulties maintaining business relations with China, while supporting democracy in Hong Kong. Other movements erupted in Lebanon, Chile, Iraq and Haiti, calling out issues including economic reform, and the end of government corruption.



AUSTRALIAN BUSHFIRES DRAW INTERNATIONAL SUPPORT

Hundreds of bushfires raged across Australia from June 2019 into early 2020. Affecting the southeast region of the country, the wildfires destroyed an estimated 46 million acres, endangering both people and wildlife. Firefighters from the U.S., Canada, Malaysia, New Zealand and Singapore joined in the efforts to extinguish the fires, while people and organizations from around the world donated millions to aid in the recovery of injured citizens and animals.

TIKTOK - MOST DOWNLOADED APP

Social media app TikTok leaped Facebook and Instagram as the most downloaded app in the world. Downloaded more than 1 billion times across the globe, TikTok allows users to create their own short videos.

NOBEL PRIZE HONOREES

Scientists John B. Goodenough, M. Stanley Whittingham and Akira Yoshino won the 2019 Nobel Prize in Chemistry for developing lithium-ion batteries which are used in cellphones, laptops, electric cars and more. Economists Abhijit Banerjee, Esther Duflo and Michael Kramer won the Nobel's Economic Sciences prize for a new strategy enabling solutions to world poverty through carefully designed questioning and experiments.

HEADLINE NEWS

.ORG DOMAIN SOLD

The internet domain .org was sold to private investment firm Ethos Capital. Nonprofits such as the YMCA and Girl Scouts of America, which occupy most of the .org sites, feared the sale would result in yearly price increases, censorship and websites closing. Ethos Capital assured they would keep .org accessible and moderately priced.



YOUTH MARCH AGAINST CLIMATE CHANGE

More than 4 million young people from around the world filled the streets to inspire their leaders to address climate change. The movement calls for action to stop the earth's rising temperatures, which are known to be caused by the burning of fuels and other human activities. 16-year-old Greta Thunberg, who was named Time magazine 2019 Person of the Year, led the weeklong global event while giving important speeches about climate change in meetings of world leaders.

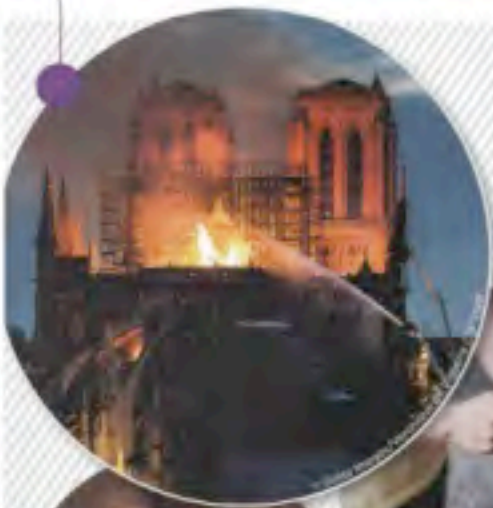


GOOGLE TO OFFER CHECKING ACCOUNTS

Google is planning to offer checking accounts to help people accomplish more online. Competitors Apple and Facebook also offer payment service apps, but Google is teaming with a bank and credit union to offer the accounts, which customers can access through their digital wallet, Google Pay. Google hopes to stand out from its competitors by offering customers useful banking tools and insured accounts.

FIRE IN NOTRE DAME CATHEDRAL

The world watched in disbelief as fires nearly destroyed the historical Notre Dame Cathedral in Paris, France. Though the 850-year-old monument lost its roof and steeple to the blaze, many of its religious artifacts survived, including its trio of round stained-glass windows and famous gargoyles. Restoration of Notre Dame is currently underway, thanks to generous contributions from around the world.



HOLOCAUST ARCHIVE DIGITIZED

The world's largest archive of Holocaust victim records is now available to the public. Ancestry.com, which has retained more than 30 million documents on people who were wronged by World War II's Nazi regime, partnered with Ancestry.com to digitize the records as learning resources for future generations, relatives and researchers.



EBOLA VACCINE APPROVED

The first vaccine for the highly infectious Ebola virus was approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration. The decision allows the vaccine Ervebo to be used more widely in countries at high-risk of the disease. Ervebo has been used on an emergency basis in the Democratic Republic of Congo and Guinea, where outbreaks have threatened the lives of thousands of residents and healthcare workers. The hope is to continue the distribution of Ervebo worldwide.



RESTAURANTS DITCH DINING ROOMS

With the surge in online ordering and food delivery services like Uber Eats and GrubHub, restaurants are increasingly removing their dining rooms to focus on delivery and pickup. New York eatery Chop removed its tables and cash registers in favor of online ordering and payment. Customers then had the option to grab-and-go their order at the restaurant, or have it delivered. Chick-fil-A and Starbucks also opened their first delivery-only kitchens in different U.S. locations.



COLLEGE ADMISSIONS SCANDAL

Over 50 people were arrested in the largest college-admission scam to ever be prosecuted by the U.S. Department of Justice. The case involved NCAA Division I coaches, Hollywood celebrities and other wealthy parents. Unbeknownst to the students, the parents conspired in various schemes to pay an admissions consultant a combined \$25 million to defraud college entrance exams and athletic recruiting to be admitted to elite colleges and universities.

NEW SYSTEM DETECTS TINY TUMORS

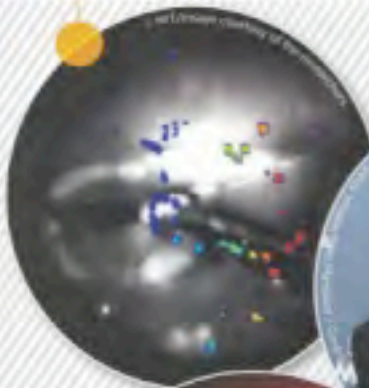
Researchers at MIT have developed a new optical imaging system that can locate tiny tumors deep inside the body. The technique, called DOLPHIN, uses near-infrared light wavelengths to penetrate body tissue and locate tumors as small as 200 cells, then duplicate the image and analyze it using a process called hyperspectral imaging. The researchers believe DOLPHIN will help with the earlier detection of cancers.

HIGHS AND LOWS

In addition to being the first to dive into the deepest points of the earth's five oceans, Victor Vescovo is also the only person to visit the very top (Mt. Everest) and the bottom of the world, a record for covering the greatest vertical distance without leaving earth. During each dive, Vescovo discovered new species and encountered a number of interesting ocean creatures including a rarely seen spoon worm at almost 23,000 feet and a snailfish.

FLYING CARS BECOMING A REALITY

Porsche and Boeing have teamed up to build flying cars. The vehicles are electric and allow riders to soar over congested cities. The cars will require expensive equipment like landing pads and charging stations, making them impractical for most buyers. Other global automotive groups like TataFutur, Inc. and AeroMobil are also preparing to launch their own flying cars.



GIANT FOSSIL DISCOVERED

Scientists digging in North Dakota found a giant fossil that revealed what happened after a meteorite struck the Earth 66 million years ago. The fossil showed that fish, trees and even a triceratops had to contend with falling debris and massive tsunamis caused by the meteorite's impact. This important finding may lead to explaining how dinosaurs and other life became extinct.

BEES NAMED MOST IMPORTANT SPECIES

Bees were named the most valuable living being in the world, recognizing their importance to the ecosystems that support life on earth. The pollination of bees is critical to around 250,000 species of flowering plants, from which animals feed and many everyday medicines are created. Significant efforts are being made to ensure the survival of these busy bees.

SCIENCE & DISCOVERY

METRIC SYSTEM CHANGED

History was made when a unanimous agreement was reached to overhaul the International System of Units, also known as the metric system. Scientists agreed to change the principles on which the system is based upon from physical objects to constants in nature. This distinction will achieve more accurate measurements.



NATURAL REMEDY FOR SKUNK ODOR

Researchers have uncovered a fungi that can neutralize the pungent odor of a skunk's spray. The fungi, *Toxopneadum*, creates a natural chemical called pericosine, which scientists tested against two compounds found in skunk spray. The results showed that it was able to remove the odor from the compounds. After slightly modifying the pericosine further, they were able to create a remedy for skunk stench that would be safe and effective on skin.



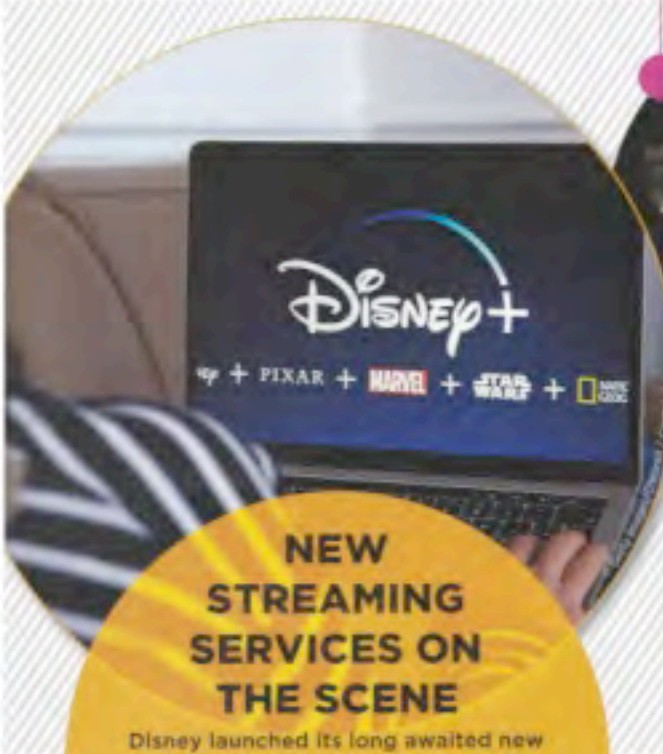
BLACK HOLE PHOTOGRAPHED

For the first time in history, a black hole was photographed in space by a group of international radio telescopes called the Event Horizon Telescope. The enormous black hole is 55 million light-years from Earth. Black holes have long been a mystery to scientists seeking to understand the phenomenon. This picture is the culmination of more than a century of work by scientists and confirms the existence of black holes that was first theorized by Albert Einstein.

TOP TECH

REVOLUTIONARY PILL

Scientists are developing a pill that can detect gut problems that lead to serious ailments like colon cancer and Crohn's disease. Once swallowed, the pill is designed to find symptoms using pictures that are seen by doctors in real time. The pill can also be halted to study drugs, then pulled after the diagnosis is complete. This has significantly reduced the impact of diagnostic procedures that previously required invasive measures.



NEW STREAMING SERVICES ON THE SCENE

Disney launched its long-awaited new streaming service Disney+. The online streaming service launched with many of its classic movies and TV shows, along with its new critically acclaimed live-action movies. Other services announced and released their own new streaming services this year, including AppleTV+ and AT&T TV.



EARTH-FRIENDLY IPHONE 11

Apple released its new iPhone 11, which used recycled rare earth elements in key components. These recycled materials were used to create the glass button pane on the front of the phone. As part of its annual environmental responsibility report, Apple reported recovering 32 kg of earth elements from every 100,000 iPhones recycled this year. Apple has pledged to continue reducing its carbon footprint, furthering progress of decreasing its environmental impact.

BIONIC EYE FOR THE BLIND

Second Sight, a California-based company, developed a groundbreaking bionic eye called Orion to help those who have lost their vision to recognize movement, light and darkness. The system, which is implanted into the brain, works with a tiny camera mounted on sunglasses to convert images of what is occurring in front of the person. This has helped people cross the street safely, sense car headlights at night and even blow out birthday candles.

SHOES FOR MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS

Nike designed a new shoe to support medical workers who are on their feet all day. Developed and tested with actual hospital staff, the new Air Zoom Pulse is easy to wipe off and clean, and the outer rubber soles have extra traction to prevent slipping. The shoe also offers the comfort of an enhanced mid-sole and heel, ideal for the continuous standing and walking medical workers must perform daily.



CAR SAFETY FEATURE DETECTS KIDS AND PETS

Scientists at the University of Waterloo have developed an affordable new car safety feature that can detect whether children or animals have been left inside. The small disc-shaped sensor, which attaches to a vehicle's rear view mirror or ceiling, uses radar technology and artificial intelligence to sense breathing movements in the car. If detected, the system prevents the car from locking and releases an alarm to alert bystanders.

OCEAN CLEANUP BEGINS

The Ocean Cleanup's mechanism designed to collect plastic from the Great Pacific Garbage Patch reached success. The system was invented by Boyan Slat when he was 16 years old and is designed to collect plastic pollution by working with the natural forces of the ocean. Along with large plastics, the system has also been able to catch abandoned fishing nets and plastics as small as 1 mm, known as microplastics.

DRONES FOR DELIVERIES

United Parcel Service (UPS) won the Federal Aviation Administration's approval to use drones to deliver packages around the U.S. Beginning with hospital deliveries, the tiny aircraft will be allowed to carry packages over 55 lbs. both at night and out of view of the remote operator.

U.S. WOMEN'S TEAM WINS WORLD CUP

The U.S. Women's National Soccer Team won the 2019 FIFA Women's World Cup Final against the Netherlands, in France. The 2-0 victory came after a scoreless 1st half, when U.S. co-captain Megan Rapinoe accomplished the 1st goal by penalty kick. Midfielder Rose Lavelle later cemented their victory.



FEMALE ATHLETES BREAK WORLD RECORDS

Simone Biles won her 25th world medal, the most of any gymnast to date. Cori "Coco" Gauff became the youngest to win a Women's Tennis Association title and Alysa Liu became the youngest-ever U.S. National Figure Skating Champion. Sprinter Allyson Felix broke the world record for most gold medals, previously held by Usain Bolt. Brazilian soccer player Marta became the first athlete to score 17 World Cup goals, while Kanyan Bridget Kotzger beat the women's marathon record.



GOODBYE TO NBA LEGEND

A helicopter crash in Calabasas, Calif., claimed the life of basketball legend Kobe Bryant and 8 others on Jan. 26, 2020. Bryant was one of the most celebrated National Basketball Association players of all time, and spent 20 years playing for the Los Angeles Lakers. He left behind a legacy of extraordinary scoring abilities that led to 5 NBA championship titles and 18 honors as an NBA All-Star player.

TORONTO RAPTORS TAKE HOME NBA CHAMPIONSHIP

The Toronto Raptors became National Basketball Championship winners for the first time after defeating the Golden State Warriors, 114-110. The victory was achieved during game 6 as the Raptors battled the 2-time-defending champions into the final seconds of the game. Kawhi Leonard was named MVP with 22 points, 8 rebounds and 3 assists.

NATIONALS TAKE WORLD SERIES TITLE

The Washington Nationals defeated the Houston Astros 6-2 in Game 7, winning their first World Series title and breaking Major League Baseball record by being the first road team to win all 7 games. Stephen Strasburg was named MVP of the series.

ALL STARS

MYSTICS WIN FIRST-EVER WNBA CHAMPIONSHIP

The Washington Mystics won their first Women's National Basketball Championship title after defeating the Connecticut Sun team, 89-75. The triumph unfolded during game 5 of the WNBA Finals, following a suspenseful 9 lead changes and 15 ties in the game. Emma Meesseman, who scored a game-changing 22 points, was named Most Valuable Player of the Finals.



BLUES WIN STANLEY CUP

The St. Louis Blues National Hockey team won their first-ever Stanley Cup Final after defeating the Boston Bruins. The 4-1 triumph came during Game 7 of the championship series. The victory was 52 years in the making, since the Bruins had defeated the Blues during the Blues' last Stanley Cup appearance in 1970.



KANSAS CITY CHIEFS WIN SUPER BOWL LIV

The Kansas City Chiefs won their first Super Bowl championship in over 50 years after defeating the San Francisco 49ers 31-20 in Miami Gardens, Fla. The victory came after the Chiefs seized the lead in the 4th quarter, scoring 3 touchdowns during the final 6 minutes of the game. Chiefs quarterback Patrick Mahomes made history as the youngest player to be named Super Bowl Most Valuable Player.

"OLD TOWN ROAD" BREAKS RECORD

"Old Town Road", the rap-meets-country remix hit by Lil Nas X and Billy Ray Cyrus, became the longest-standing No. 1 song in history after topping the Billboard Hot 100 Chart for a whopping 17 weeks. The song won multiple awards, including Song of the Year at the MTV Video Music Awards and Choice R&B/Hip-Hop Song at the Teen Choice Awards.



AVENGERS: ENDGAME

Avengers: Endgame made one super impression for moviegoers worldwide, as the fastest movie to exceed \$2 billion at the box office and the top grossing film of all time. Selling the most tickets in just 11 days, the Marvel blockbuster broke the record previously held by *Avatar*, which took 47 days to pass the \$2 billion mark.



KIDS' CHOICE AWARDS

Zendaya, Jace Norman and Jazs Siewe took home top honors at the 2019 Nickelodeon Kids' Choice Awards. Zendaya was awarded Favorite Female TV Star for her role as K.C. Cooper in *K.C. Undercover*, while Norman was named Favorite Male TV Star for his Henry Danger character, Henry Hart/Kid Danger. Siewe was voted Favorite Social Music Star and performed an energized mash-up of her most boomer songs.

FROZEN II

Frozen II set a world record after achieving the highest grossing opening weekend and highest gross earnings for an animated film at the global box office. As of 2019, the long-awaited sequel had earned more than \$450 million. *Frozen II* also made history on the Billboard 200 albums chart as the first new full-length soundtrack to reach No. 1.
