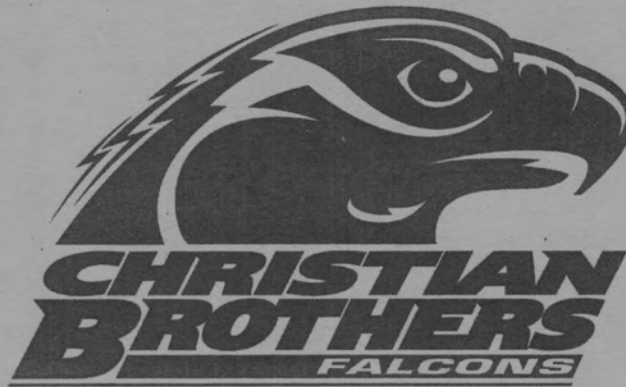

Goals: Participate in campus multi-cultural activities/liturgies, incorporate this culture into the CB community.

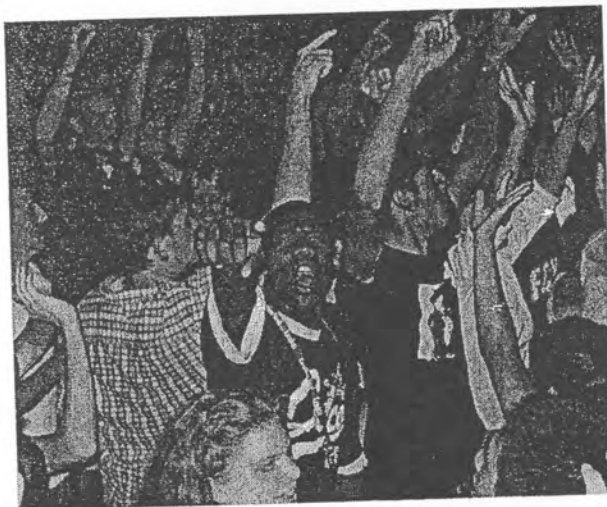
Maya Club
