

INFORMATION ON FACULTY/STAFF PARKING --- GATE OPERATIONS

The gate near Room 707

The "700 gate" is programmed to automatically open when you drive up to it from either direction. This feature can be turned off when we wish to heighten our security. We intend to do this during vacation periods.

If the gate does not immediately open as you approach it the automatic feature may be turned off. To enter or exit when the automatic feature is off, use the key switches on the **FRONT** of the control boxes. Control boxes are located on both sides of the gates.

Turn the key clockwise to about the 4:00 position. The gate will immediately open and stay open for about 20 seconds.

The SMAT gate

The SMAT gate is programmed to open automatically when you approach it in a vehicle from the inside (to leave).

To open the gate to enter, turn the key switch on the **FRONT** of the control box. The box is mounted on the post located in the planter across from the gate.

Turn the key clockwise to about the 4:00 position. The gate will immediately open and stay open for about 20 seconds.

To place the gates in "Hold Open" mode:

Both gates can be set in the "hold opened" position by using the key switch on the **RIGHT SIDE** of the gate control boxes. Turn the key clockwise. You are actually pushing a button when you turn the key so will you feel resistance as you reach the 4:00 position and actually hear a "click".

The gate will open and remain open until you use the key again on the right side to turn off the "hold open" feature.

The plan is for our security guard to place both gates in the "hold open" mode each morning and afternoon to expedite faculty arrival and departure.

RULE: If you set the gate to "hold open" make sure you reset it to "automatic mode when you leave!!
