Verse 2: So my pain is pain for You, in Your joy is my joy too; all is brought together in the Lord.

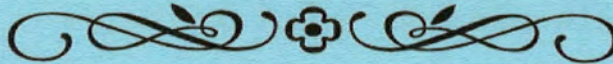

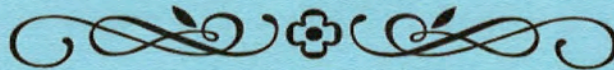

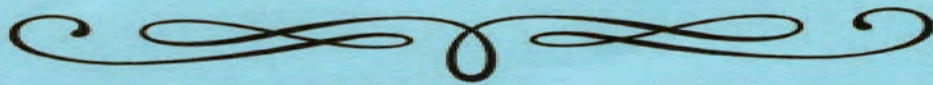
